New York Branch Hosts Successful Spring Membership Event



The Projected Palace of Soviets

The Palace of the Soviets (Russian: Дворец Советов, Dvorets Sovetov) was a project to construct an administrative center and a congress hall in Moscow, USSR near the Kremlin, on the site of the demolished Cathedral of Christ the Saviour.

The architectural contest for the Palace of the **Soviets (1931–1933)** was won by Boris lofan's neoclassical concept, subsequently revised by lofan, Vladimir Shchuko and Vladimir Gelfreikh nto a supertall skyscraper, If built, it would have become the world's tallest structure of its time. Construction started in 1937, and was terminated by the German invasion in 1941. In 1941–1942, its steel frame was disassembled for use in fortifications and bridges, Construction was never resumed. In 1958, the foundations of the Palace were converted into what would become the world's largest open-air swimming pool. lofan's original draft was crowned with a relatively small statue of "The Free Proletarian". In August 1932, a taller tower and Lenin's statue replaced the former statue.

Credo of U.S. Friends of the Soviet People

Pew Research Center Shows East Europeans Still Support 'Real' Socialism

In an analysis of recent poll results, Pew Research Center found that populations in the former Eastern European countries are generally positive in their evaluation of 20th Century communism. According to a survey carried out in several Central and East European countries in 2009 by the US-based Pew Research Center, the proportion of people in former socialist nations who take the view that life under capitalism is worse than it was during the period of communist power is as follows:

Poland: 35%, Czechoslovakia: 82%, Lithuania: 42%, Russia: 45% Bulgaria: 62%, Ukraine: 62%, and Hungary: 72%. Particularly significant in the results of the 2010 poll in Romania is that, as they acquire more experience of life under the 'market economy' people are becoming more negative about capitalism and positive about communism. In the previous poll in 2006, 53% expressed a favorable opinion about communism; the 2010 survey showed that 61% are favorable towards communism. The survey findings are not altogether surprising in view of what has taken place since capitalism was reintroduced-increased poverty, the rise of unemployment and insecurity. Romania's health system is currently in crisis, and public sector workers have recently had their pay cut by 25%.




