

MAY DAY – 1994

"A JOYOUS DAY FOR THE HUMAN SPIRIT": NELSON MANDELA ...

The dawning of May Day, 1994 was acclaimed by Nelson Mandela as a "joyous day for the human spirit". He spoke well and truly. Not only was it the anniversary of the internationally acclaimed day of demonstrations and international solidarity to advance the rights of working people, Mandela was acclaiming the immense victory of the peoples of Africa over three hundred years of imperialist oppression and terror. The inhuman obscenity of "apartheid" ended in South Africa with almost two-thirds of the people voting for the eightytwo year old African National Congress. Truly, it was a day for international joy and uplift of the "human spirit".

Not to be forgotten, in the euphoria, tears and smiles of joy, are the tens, hundreds of thousands, the millions who groaned, died, were martyred in the bloody hells of international corporate bloodletting and bondage under Apartheid and exploitation. Mandela himself, with 27 of his 75 years, shattered and entombed on the dreaded "end-ofthe-world" Robbens Island prison, is a symbol of dauntless courage in the bankers' and industrialists' horror story of colonialism, wage slavery and apartheid. So, too, is the murdered Chris Hani, and Steve Biko, along with countless



others. It is no wonder that in the very bones and being of the South African people, there burns an unquenchable fire for human dignity, for freedom, for an end to monstrous crimes committed against

them and their forebears. It burns as well, so that the children of the apartheid snakepit should have education and literacy, medical care, housing, stability, freedom from "pass laws", crime and the soul-searing indignity of second class citizenship or of being citizens without any rights. The working people everywhere on the century-old celebration of May Day, in struggles against capitalist and monopoly imposed war, unemployment, poverty, disease, illiteracy and in an endless quest for "joyous" days in which to live our lives, must now greet this May Day 1994 in a triumphant spirit.

That May Day was itself born in the crucibles of struggle by workers to gain the right to limit the sale of their ability to work to eight hours a day, on the North American continent, more than a hundred years ago, in fact underlines the never-ending "oneness" of workers of all countries when seen in conjunction with the triumph of South Africa's working people, and the struggles everywhere of working people.

And it mut be recalled that another event, even more worldshaking in its scope and impact, was the victory of the Russian working class in 1917 when they set out to build a new society - Socialism. They cleansed their house of foreign exploiters and curbed and removed the influence of their own capitalists. They built their country - the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics. They defended it with their blood and their lives, and sent the first human orbiting in space. They became in fact, the world's leading power in area after area of human endeavour. That they have failed temporarily, and today, confront yet another form of Imperialist assault, engineered from the outside and effected by internal

pro-monopoly capitalist hyenas and jackals of the Yeltsin stripe, is not the result of the failure of Socialism, but of the abject failure and hideous betrayal of the real development of the science of the working class, Marxist-Leninist socialism. And while that is a matter, for the most part, for the peoples of the former Soviets to sort out and correct, people everywhere must also address and take up that task.

It should be emphasized here that while the immense obstacles confronting the peoples of South Africa are in their very nature similar to those confronted seventy years ago by the proletarian (workers-led) revolution of the U.S.S.R. and its people, the very nature of the triumph of the peoples in South Africa is historically different in its class, political, and social aims and immediate results, and differs from the proletarian revolution of Russia and the 1917-1922 revolts and struggles.

Whether or not there may ensue further internal upheavals in South Africa, or movement in the direction of Socialist development in the direction of Socialist development, possible internal strife and even war, are not yet decided questions. But the class struggle may well sharpen as the people and Mandela impose democratic reform. That the external forces of transnational corporate power, coupled with the South African internal corporate powers will seek new forms to continue their domination and exploitation in one or another form, hardly needs to be said.

Already, scant hours and days after the electoral victory of the people, the A.N.C, Mandela, (and it must be added, the international working class) there has come a growing journalistic and political fire mainly centred on Mandela.

The Toronto Globe & Mail (soon to have a new publisher from the U.S. transnational crowd) in a Saturday, May 7th, feature says "The problem isn't simply cronyism, rule bending and poor judgement. The new leader (Mandela) wields little effective control over his followers" and goes on to decry his (Mandela's) attitude toward the former apartheid leader and President, de Klerk, who, forced by necessity, led the White Supremacists out of the failures of their self-made "apartheid", systemic crisis and impasse.

A book review (page 94) in the April edition of the "prestigeous" magazine, "Canadian Business" says Stefan Kemfer's, The Last Empire: De Beers, Diamonds and the World -"provides ... a valuable background guide for those who wish to follow ... news that will emerge from South Africa in the months and YEARS ahead. (our emphasis - Ed.) Although the Oppenheimers have been employers of Black labour in huge numbers ... they have always been in the vanguard of improved working conditions - albeit out of enlightened self-interest - although traditionally, not in favour of 'one man, one vote'." The book goes on to say that these same Oppenheimers are a family "whose style speaks of grander times ... when Imperialism was a profession and not a curse ... the times ... of Cecil Rhodes, the politician-plutocrat and founder of De Beers ... who presented his Oueen (Victoria of England) with diamonds. Ernest Oppenheimer was a worthy successor to Rhodes (and) built monopoly Anglo-American Co. with the help of J.P. Morgan of the U.S.A. ... In the 1920's. (Oppenheimer) took over the Rhodes Company, De Beers. Relationships between Blacks and ... Anglo Whites ... developed in a peculiar way ... this led to the compound system of

walled work camps (and) such practices as purging the workers to make sure they hadn't swallowed any precious stones ..."

That such an "inspired book" should appear on the eve of the "one-vote-one-person" elections can hardly be accidental, and should be seen in terms of an ongoing transnational and domestic corporate drive to obstruct and defeat the magnificent and dearly won victory by South Africans over the forces who, in the first place, imposed apartheid on the majority population with guns, corruption, jails, bloodthirsty and implacable ferocity, and the "purging" of the working class!

But for May Day, 1994, we hail from the housetops the victory of the people of South Africa. It has opened wider the door to historic world-wide defeats of transnational corporate power - Imperialism! Other peoples of the oppressed and exploited world will see in this great new beginning, lessons that can be applied and effected in situation after situation, whether in Cape Town, Durban, Moscow, Kiev, Toronto, Sept. Isles, Sudbury, Panama City or wherever the TNC boot rests heavily on the peoples' necks. The victory over Apartheid is a forebearer of unity in the worldwide anti-Imperialist, anti-TNC, anti-fascist struggles. Above all, these are lessons of tenacity, courage and unity, in the face of seemingly insuperable odds.

We hail the burning intensity of the "freedom-beacon" of light in South Africa that has driven "apartheid" from their land. Together with all working and progressive people, we reach out our hands in international friendship and solidarity so their victory will be strengthened and consolidated. United, the people will win.



THE BLIND ALLEY OF COUNTERREVOLUTION

The ideologues of anticommunism never get tired in trying to convince people of the futility and irrationality of the socialist revolution, all the blame they try to put on the people that were victorious in October Revolution of 1917.

But, starting in 1985, in the Soviet Union, "perestroika" events showed us something very different. Sure, the October Revolution, and moreover, the Civil War started by the remnants of capitalist class and Kulaks with foreign intervention, devastated our country, its industry and agriculture. With our country starting on the road building socialism, there took place a slowing down of production until such time that we were able to get on our feet, rebuild what was already built at the time, and take steps to give our economy an upsurge.

Looking at the present bourgeois counter-revolution, we find something radically different. The dislocation, the absolute chaos in production, planning and consumer goods is in such a state that it makes the hardships of 1920's seem easy compared to this complete anarchy, robbery and sell-out of the gains of Soviet people.

Socialist revolution, in spite of its momentary problems, is a system that quickens the social progress of people, by healing the wounds of previous conflicts, disruption and devastation. Socialism resolves conflicts and makes it a crime for any inter-ethnic strife, by eliminating the causes of nationalism and racism, that permeated people for centuries.

In 1993, due to the policies of the present regime, more than 150 thousand people died in ethnic conflicts, which is ten times more than the Soviet losses in Afghanistan. Experts predict that in the immediate future (unless there is a drastic change) there will be over 12 ethnic conflicts and the country might be turned into a zone of "ethnic banditry"! It is predicted that more than 500,000 people will lose their lives and more than 20 million Russians will have to flee as refugees.

In 1994, the Russian people and all other former peoples of the USSR are undergoing total crisis by the restoration of capitalism. This crisis is not only affecting Soviet people, but it is a crisis for the whole of the human race. The International Monetary Fund, the "shock therapy" inflicted on our Motherland

by the West is not producing the desired results for the "investors and backers" as they themselves had surmised.

It was popular for people to discuss during the Great Patriotic War, as to what kind of sentence will be imposed on Hitler. Now, you can hear the same discussions by people on public transport as to what kind of sentence will be metted out to Yeltsin after he's defeated! Of course, the lackeys and lawyers for Yeltsin do not hear these sayings of the people, since they do not stand in lines for food, or do not use public transport – instead, they ride around in Mercedes-Benzes.

Does Yeltsin ever listen to the people? No, he keeps on preparing his memorandums on "peace and understanding" between the robbers and the robbed. In this regard, he gets help from Rutskoi, Khasbulatov, the new Duma, Rybkin and Shumejko, Zyuganov and Shenin and from other former bureaucrats of the CPSU. They are all who are demanding that we forget about the "class struggle" and in a civilized manner, try to save the crisis-ridden restoration of capitalism. As we all know, in a class oriented society, there is a class struggle, and it does not depend upon the wishes or plans of "internal or foreign interests" or for that matter, on the "elected parliamentarians" who do not represent the majority of the people.

At the beginning of this century, the scholars knew this, basing themselves on the lessons of the French Revolution. Unfortunately, today, the professors and graduates of the Higher Party Schools and universities of the CPSU forgot it completely.

PLANNING FUTURE STORM TROOPERS

Appeals to the workers to

abandon the classic struggles by the "pseudo-democrats" who "do" not "hide" the fact that the new forthcoming "manifests" and "memorandums" being prepared by Yeltsin and his clique ... that any opposition to these laws will be considered as "civil disobedience to be put down by force". Yeltsin's appeals for peace and understanding is a mask under which there is a rapid drive towards reaction and plans for a civil war with the participation of foreign troops. Just last week, the Government and their lackeys in Leningrad appealed over the radio for young men to join the "people detachments" under the Ministry of Internal Affairs. This Ministry of Internal Affairs is headed by the butcher Yerin, who was made a hero by Yeltsin after the White House carnage. Up to this moment, there are already in Leningrad 16,000 such volunteers. They are not "patriotic" at all, they are being well paid by the authorities and the Astrobank, one of the biggest private banks in Russia. Are not these "druzheniki" being modelled on Hitler's "Storm Troopers" of Germany in the 1930's?

The adventurist policies of Yeltsin's "memorandum" was helped by the decision to give "amnesty" to the defenders of the "White House", to the ones that were killed (over 1,500 - Editors) and at the same time, the perpetrators and the butchers who killed these innocent people got amnesty and medals. What kind of amnesty is this? To give amnesty to elected representatives that were defending the Constitution and defending the elected Parliament! This is demagogic. This amnesty says that these people were guilty, but because of the good graces of Yeltsin, they were given "amnesty"! Besides all this, the jails were cleared in order for "new tenants"

in future struggles will find themselves there.

The present rulers utilize the inner feelings of Soviet people that "let there be no more wars or tragedies". This was the rallying cry in the Second World War, because people rose in the mighty struggle under the leadership of the Government, to once for all, finish with wars and conflicts. This is imbedded into our minds through our Mother's milk. People decided that it was better to die standing up than to live on bended knees. More and more of our people are realizing this cardinal truth and are fighting to reverse the death throes of our country. This awakening is being helped by the counterrevolution, since it has come into a blind alley itself.

The blind alley of the counterrevolution was foreseen, there was no other way. The policy of deindustrialization has stopped more than 50% of the industry. The inflation has made the ruble practically worthless. The "hidden" unemployment cannot be hidden, since there is more than 50% unemployment in Russia alone. The agricultural policy of Yeltsin's clique has had catastrophic results on the agriculture. Ten percent of sown land produces only less than 1% of products. More than 3/4% of areable lands cannot produce now their full potential because there is no fertilizer to put into the land.

All buying of grain now is in the hands of private enterpreneurs who gouge the people and thus, the prices of items such as bread is unbelievable.

There is starvation in our country. Workers are not getting paid, there is no money for pensions or stipends for students. In the Krasnoyarsk region of Russia, women working as geologists did not receive pay for over 6 months, thus forcing them to feed their children combined mixture of seed that is used to feed animals, so that the children would not die from starvation. These women declared a hunger strike.

In the Nizhegordskoj Territory, Siberia, there were many deaths due to starvation and freezing to death, since it takes two cords of wood to heat a home and the cost is 300,000 rubles per cord for wood. The pensions of the average collective farmer is only 15,000-25,000 rubles per month. Tragedies of these kinds were never heard of in Russia ever. The land is all covered with forests, but now, it is all in private hands, foreign and internal capitalists. It's a definite policy of the Yeltsin's regime to get rid of older people, thus making the country be peopled by a younger generation, and in this way, making them more mobile. The death rate is overtaking the birth rate dramatically, thus putting at risk the future of our people.

CHANGING TACTICS

1993 saw the forced movement of the counter-revolution to throw away the "barbaric capitalism" and put on the clean, more "civilized cloak". The growth of corporations as opposed to private entrepreneurship, the growth of syndicates and monopoly, has taken on a rapid mobilization of aspects of multinational corporations

having tull control of the new Russian capitalists corporations. Thus, the head of a corporation "Galant" Mr. Zavidia, appearing on TV during the former elections to the Duma, gave all his financial support to Zhirinovsky. This Mr. Zavidia controls more than 50,000 businesses in Russia and also owns some of the biggest banks in Russia. Even the presidents of Western transnational corporations are very jealous of his success. These giant monopolists did not just happen out of thin air ... nowhere is there such outright robbery of the people's wealth as is now practiced in Russia and other former Soviet Republics! Some of these robbers have control of over 40% of the former peoples' industry which was allowed and promoted by Yeltsin and company. But, we must remember that the cornerstone to this robbery was laid by Gorbachev and his mentor, Alexander Yakovlev!

The rapid growth of statemonopoly capital must be seen as the direct results of the sell-out of the former "communists" who were able to get the finances of former CPSU and now, these former "party leaders" are on the boards of directors of the monopolies, and together with transnational corporations, are cementing the take-over of the former socialist industry. These developments as they proceeded under Gorbachev, were not fully realized or understood by the leadership in the CPSU, since they were well hidden.


The rapid rate of monopoly capital, tied in with the transnational corporation, did not give rise to the middle class. Thus, the neobourgeoisie are not happy and the people are beginning to see the whole truth of what has transpired under the guise of "perestroika and glasnost"!

The elections "in blood" for the Duma and the referendum on the Constitution did not solve the problem but made the step quicker for the state-monopoly capitalists to tie themselves even closer with the transnational monopolists. Through trickery and manipulations, the election results gave Yeltsin a "semblence" of victory. This was only accomplished by the leader of the Communist Party of the Russian Federation, G. Zyuganov, who, by breaking the unity of the Communist movement, gave Yeltsin 13% of voters. Voting for the Constitution by only 1/5 of the electors coming to vote, gave Yeltsin the votes cast for Zhirinovsky, who now brags about his personal friendship for Yeltsin.

game, becuase the future of Zhirinovsky is not to be taken for granted, his utterances and the daily publicity is not done by the West because they admire his clownish behaviour. This is a dangerous situation that could prove disasterous for everyone.

"NATIONALISM" A CLOAK

In order to mask the ambitions, the present regime had to cloak their ambitions on the bourgeois-patriotic feelings. This is prevalent in all the former Soviet Republics. Nationalism is now the key word, married together with "patriotism". Anti-communism is now losing its affectiveness, no longer does it get the results that the perpetrators would want; therefore, a change in



The ambition of the present regime should be seen in reality, even though the present economic and political chaos prevents them from inspiring at this time, to "regain all former Russian imperial lands". You can see the policy of "spheres of influence" and the 28 Russian war bases all over the former USSR. This has to be seen the masquerading under "independence" of the former Soviet Republics. Global ambitions are there to be seen by the policies that Yeltsin is pursuing in Yugoslavia. There is no need to believe that Yeltsin's policies is for Russian-Serbian brotherhood. The game of playing this charade is a must now for Yeltsin, since he depends on the West. But this is just a waiting

tactics - nationalism and patriotism.

The Gorbachev "think-tank" advocates try desperately to marry the planned economy with the private economy, but are having a terrible time, since these two ideologies do not mix well and cannot produce the desired offspring of "peace, harmony".

This policy is the central plank in the policies of Zyuganov, who came up with the "national-state ideology" in his words that it "should be good for the masses and the businessmen", which he feels should replace the old decrepit, "Marxism-Leninism"!

This observation by Zyuganov, leader of the Communist Party of the Russian Federation, so impressed and fascinated the ex-president

Nixon of USA who visited Russia early this year, that he immediately went to see Zyuganov and they became friends in thought and deed, because Zyuganov said to Richard Nixon that "we do not want to change the present situation in Russia with force". Zyuganov, feeling very smug and proud, said in Krasnoyarsk that, "with the help of Americans, his party (CPRF) will come into power and will establish people's government".

Why not? Why should not America help the present regime, and why not help this neo-Gorbachev, as Zyuganov helped Gorbachev before, and now he helps Yeltsin. Money is available in the safes of the USA, as our "democrats" say, chickens do not crow!

More and more, the present deputies and the government debate the question of national capitalism versus monopoly capitalism and the agreement is now propogated over the controlled mass media that there must be established an authoritarian regime to deal with the crisis. President, (now as he likes to call himself, "leader of the nation"), pretends to be above all conflicts, but in actual fact, there are moves afoot to stop all "pluralism" in thought and action.

ARE WE FACED WITH FASCISM?

The road is being prepared for fascism. This is done because the Yeltsin's gang cannot see any other way out of this blind alley. You can already see some sort of "successes". In Turkmenia, the former first secretary of the CPSU has declared himself the "father of the nation". Niyazov has become the "Sacred Khan" which he promotes as the disciple of Allah on earth. (And this is the faithful servant of Gorbachev-Yeltsin-former Communist – Editors)

Or take Shevernadze in Georgia, the right hand man of Gorbachev and Yeltsin, now a bloody tyrant with thousands of people's blood on his hands. In the Ukraine, the self-styled "father of the nation" Krawchuk is following the same path, while his right-hand man, fascist Chernovil does his bidding. In Russia, the aspirants to dictatorship is Yeltsin, and awaiting his cue is Zhirinovsky.

The future of our country is in grave danger. There are too many hotspots, too many problems that are burning the minds of the people. This is the "cause" of the former leaders of the CPSU, who brought its demise especially so that the USSR would be immobilized and thus, served up on a platter to the Western interests.

These are the same traitors who now want to "unite" all communist and socialist parties again into the CPSU based on "membership". This same CPSU which, for the last 8 years, has split and liquidated the CPSU and its dedicated membership. The unity of the Communist Parties should proceed from the bottom up, and not from the top down. Unity should be judged on the work and program of daily struggles of the communists. Daily struggles will show the membership which communists are truly dedicated Marxists-Leninists and once this is done, the unity of ideals and practice will cement the communists into one mighty force which will make a strong Communist Party. To do it the other way around, to unite the now existing Communist parties who have different positions, platforms and interpretations of Marxism-

Leninism, would mean putting the plough before the horse, which, in the end, would compromise the policies and effectiveness of the new Communist Party.

CANADA'S ELECTION ACT AMENDMENT RESTRICTS VOTE

In 1939, Stanley B., Ryerson, in his work, "1837, The Birth of Canadian Democracy," observes that: "Democracy today, here as in the rest of the world, is beset with danger. Faced with an awakening consciousness on the part of the masses of the people, the entrenched powers or organized greed, are doing all in their power to curtail or crush the democratic rights of freedom of speech, organization and assembly."

In 1837, a heroic period in Canada's history, the peoples of English and French Canada, led by William Lyon McKenzie in Upper Canada (Ontario), and Louis Joseph Papineau in Lower Canada (Quebec), routed the Family Compact, the aristocratic rulers of the two Canada's of that time and laid the basis of democracy in our country.

Since that time, the Canadian people, both French and English, have been engaged in a struggle to maintain and extend democracy.

The principal examples of reaction's efforts to destroy democratic rights in Canada are seen as the use of the War Measures Act, passed during World War I, later used to crush the alleged insurrection of the FLQ (Front de Liberation du Quebec), in October, 1970. Section 98 of the Criminal Code was introduced as a weapon to crush the Winnipeg General Strike in 1919, and to outlaw the Communist Party of Canada in 1931. In the same period, the infamous Padlock Law was passed in Quebec to curtail the use of halls and theatres by the Quebec people, during a period of mass unemployed and trade union struggles. During the 1930's, Sections 41 and 42 of the Immigration Act were used to deport British and European unemployed workers who struggled against poverty and hunger during the capitalist crisis of 1930-1939.

The most recent attack on democracy in Canada is more subtle. In fact, the majority of Canadians are not aware that it is happening. This recent effort to subvert democracy takes the form of an amendment to the Canada Election Act. This amendment, Section 31 of the act, provides that a political party running in a federal election must receive 15% of the vote cast, or lose its status as a registered political party. The act as amended, provides further that such a party or parties must

not only cease to function as a political party in elections, but must surrender its assets, including all money, property, even including its office equipment, to the custody of Elections Canada. This measure, passed by the Mulroney Conservative Government and quietly incorporated into law on June 27, 1993, continues on the statute books of Canada, under the present Liberal Government of Jean Chretien.

It is a law, calculated to deprive the working people of Canada of all participation in political affairs, to remove all small parties from the political scene, to concentrate all power in the hands of the parties of big business, and create a two-party political system as in the United States, in accordance with the wishes of the transnational corporations. This is the political concept of the level playing field, in which the lowering of the living standards of Canadians is the game being played.

It is to be noted that this vicious anti-democratic legislation was passed with the full support of all political parties in parliament at the time.

It is with extreme regret that we must point out that even the New Democratic Party caucus voted for this anti-Canadian, anti-democratic legislation.

It has been said that the best way to perpetuate injustice is to stand by and allow it to happen.

One is reminded of the lament of the German submarine commander – Protestant churchman,

Martin Niemoeller, who found himself in a Nazi prison in 1938 Germany. He said of his Nazi captors: "First, they came for the Communists, but I was not a Communist, so I did nothing. Then they came for the social democrats, but I was not a social democrat, so I did nothing. Then they came for the trade unionists, but I was not a trade unionist, so I did nothing. Then they came for the Catholics and the Jews, but I was neither a Catholic nor a Jew, and so I did nothing. THEN THEY CAME FOR ME. But by that time, there was nobody left to do anything.

Fascism is no respector of persons, and this measure of the Canadian Government in restricting Canadians' voting rights could affect all Canadians. The passing of Section 31 is a step on the road to fascism. Fascism does not come to a country overnight. It is a process which develops while some people stand and allow it to happen, while 'others' who profess a belief in democracy, such as the NDP, vote for it.

The great lesson of history is that just as the people of Canada, through their unity and organized struggle in the past, forced the repeal of the War Measures Act, Section 98, the Padlock Law and anti-democratic sections of the Immigration Act, so Canada and its people must now act to safeguard Canadian freedom, by bringing an end to this latest assault on Canadian democracy.

Please print this letter in your "Northstar Compass". I hope that some newspaper or magazine in the USA will reprint it.

Mr. Brzezinski, I am writing to you in this open letter, in the hope that I will receive a letter from you that will be published either in the American or Soviet press.

We are with you, people of one planet and of the same generation.

The only difference is that I was born in the Soviet Union, was brought up on communist ideals, to which I remain dedicated and devoted to this day, not looking at the victory, that you and your kind have accomplished during and after the Cold War against my country, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.

You were born in a capitalist country, you were brought up in an atmosphere of hate towards everything that was Soviet. This hate and hatred you have chosen to be your profession, and you achieved great success in your career. And now – the long awaited victory of the Cold War, like a garland is hanging around your neck as recognition for your dedication.

So, you are a winner. I am the loser. Let us then publicly get to

know each other, in order that you would get to know me more closely. Let your cohorts and people of this planet realize the actual worth of your victory.

I was born as a citizen of the USSR. In 1942, mobilization took place in my country for all able bodied men in order to defend the Motherland against the fascist hordes. I was accompanying my father to the recruiting station in the womb of my mother. I was born as a second child in our family. As soon as the Soviet Army liberated the Donbass Region, mother and we two children were sent, together with thousands of others, for safety to the Far East, to the city of Stalino – to our family.

Our family was lucky. My father returned alive from the war.

To live in the ruined city was extremely hard. There were not enough living quarters for everyone. Young people from all over the Soviet Union came to build up the ruined Donbass region. My parents decided to go to Kalma near Magandansk Region. Four of us went together. There, I went to school, my brother was born there – now we were 5 in the family. We had to move from this region, since the climate did not agree with my mother and brother ... they were always sick.

This time, we decided to settle in the region of Rostov-on-the-Don, where my parents bought a small house. There, I spent my childhood. As with most young people, these years were the happiest and most memorable of my life. We were not crowded in our Motherland. On our earnings, we were able to live in peace, to have things that were necessary for life, and with our savings, were able to travel all over the USSR, to vacations, to family visits and to sanatoriums. And we proudly sang:

"Wide is my my land so dear.

Many forests, fields and rivers abound,
I do not know of any other country,
Where with such freedom breaths
man."

And I really breathed and felt free!

In the Moscow Institute of Culture, I studied and received high qualification as a Worker of Culture. There were students from all nationalities, all religions and from many foreign countries. There, we were equal, we were friends, we fell in love, we married. We were destined to teach and to bring out the talents of the people, their creativity, their love of the arts.

All the visits to museums, clubs, sports facilities, lectures, all this was free to the Soviet people. We did not have "public houses" (bordelos) and I was not afraid to walk the streets at night. I did not have to be afraid, because this was our country, not like some other "civilized" countries where it isn't safe to walk the streets.

We lived behind our "iron curtain" with our own problems and successes. We were building, we sowed, we reaped, we grew and we grew in industry, culture and love of our Motherland. We did not have greedy eyes towards other territories or resources, we did not attack other countries or dropped Atomic bombs on civilian population. We did not napalm people, as some other "civilized countries" did!

With my savings, I was able to buy a cooperative apartment. When I got settled and felt content, I went to an Orphan Children's Home and adopted a son, seven years old. I took the most sickly lad and, in the years that followed, I brought him up, looked after him, saw many Doctors and arranged for many operations in order to make my son healthy. All this was free to our people. Finally, we were able to

celebrate the day when my son became completely healthy. He was going to school and became a technical specialist after finishing University.

I spent much energy and health in order to make sure that my adopted son was healthy. I thought that in his teenage years, we shall be friends and enjoy life in the days ahead. I believed that I will help him to bring up his children in the spirit of socialism.

I did not know at that time that in the USA, there is living Mr. Brezhinski, whose life ambition was to destroy the Soviet Union. This was in keeping with the plan of "realization of American Defence Policy towards the USSR", which was the brainchild of A. Dulles and his transnational corporation bosses even as early as 1945. The CIA's main task and aim was – and still is – to destabilize and destroy the Soviet Union and to psychologically influence the Soviet people.

I was not able to understand, why the child and now, a young man living with me, seeing my sincere help to him and seeing my help for my aging parents - now more and more seemed egotistic, showing influences alien to us and our society and speaking of the across-theocean "freedom" and becoming a stranger in his own home, while at the same time, together with some of his friends, listening to Voice of America, Radio Free Europe and somehow receiving dollars, clothes that were advertised over TV and all other symptoms of "mind manipulation"!

This tragedy is not only with my adopted son! With the help of psychological diversions, you were able to poison the minds of the unwary and impressionable young people. This influence was well thought-out, since teenagers are the most susceptible strata to influence. I now have learned about mind manipulation and together with my neighbours, are fighting this menace. The CIA and other foreign agencies have infiltrated our country, thanks to our own traitors, but we are beginning to know and point out "your people" that are among us.

I have decided that I would rather lose my work that I love and lose my adopted son, than give up the IDEALS OF SOCIAL EQUALITY OF PEOPLE AND OF WORKERS' RIGHTS – this means that I will never leave my ideal of a Communist Society.

You, Mr. Brzezinski, even today, are proceeding with your diversion and destruction against me, against my people, against my Motherland! You have become the "Godfather" of the recently-established "American-Ukrainian Committee", which was set up especially to undermine, sabotage and to work covertly and overtly against the Ukrainian people. With this diversion, each of the American Consulates, Embassy, political scientists and religious leaders are financed with American dollars (taxpayers' dollars – Editors). Your future plans are that with your investment now, you will be able to buy up our lands and will be able to recoup many times over your expenditures.

Let it be, that today, you are a victor and I am not. But let me remind you, that in this victory of yours, there is planted a seed of your own destruction. No, you will not suffer the defeat from me, of course not, but you will be defeated by those that you corrupted yourself with dollars and values that are not Christian or humane. You promised these people (like my adopted son) heaven on earth as soon as you establish capitalism here. This policy of dog-eat-dog mentality is paralyzing even our own people, Mr. Brezhinski! It is an epidemic in your part of the world.

I will not curse you. That curse will be taken up by your own American people. But I only wish that this curse will be fulfilled when you are still alive.

VERIFICATION AND AN APOLOGY ...

We are pleased to tell you that the Special Supplement, "Broadsiding the Toronto Star and Fellow Travellers" mailed last month, has received some favourable comments. Thank those of you who have seen fit to pass them on either verbally or in writing.

That we were on the right track is confirmed by Don Sellar, "The Star's Ombudsman", who, on Saturday, April 30th edition, devoted his entire column to this question. His headline: "Ukrainian ad section confusing".

We agree with that, and suggest it was something more than that despite Mr. Sellar's words. He writes: "Naturally, because the paper bears responsibility for what rolls off its presses ... the usual requirements of libel community tastes and advertising standards apply ... The section (on Ukraine in a sixteen-page 'advertorial', whatever that may be - Editor) had unbylined articles with no labels making clear they were paid advertorial content, as opposed to news. The group responsible for the upbeat section was identified as "the Children of

Chernobyl Canadian Fund and Star Project Committee". Still, many readers were confused. understandably so." Sellar writes. "The blurring of lines between editorial and advertising ... was evident in complaints. Some callers believed, wrongly, that the newsroom was responsible for various errors of fact or interpretation in the advertorial ... Asked about the confusion, Publisher David Jolley said The Star is pleased to let organizations get their messages out "in their own words and their own style, not necessarily those of the newspaper." "In this case", Jolley said, "we may have been a little negligent ..."

Alexander M. Belonogov, Ambassador of the Russian Federation to Canada, also took considerable umbrage at the Focus Section on Ukraine, falling just short of suggesting that the entire business was a calculated political action aimed at worsening relations between his country and Ukraine. We make no comment on that.

We DO raise this question: What are the broader responsibilities of a publisher to bring unbiased enlightenment and information to the public? Where does the line come down between responsible dissemination of news and information (even in paid advertising) and misleading or disinforming the public, and does the mere paying of advertising costs remove responsibility from the publisher to disseminate unbiased and correct news materials, etc.? We have noted that copy inserted in commercial advertisements is either correct in detail, or if not, correctable by the publisher.

Conversely, we clearly can follow the wide latitude given to unbylined writers in reporting news events. Where is that elusive line drawn at The Star ... or is it? Would it be pure conjecture to ask what influence advertisers paying for 16-pages might have on editorial judgement and integrity?

Finally, in this item, we apologize to our readers for the rotten little gremlin, clad in purple who, in our Broadside, fouled up the columns 2 & 3 on page 2, and column 1 on page 3. This is how it should have read: (Beginning last 3 lines – col. 2, page 2–)

"Even the anonymous Star writer, under headline, 'New Leaders Who Have Been Chosen, (to col. 1, page 3) Face Challenge' notes that Christina Maciw, Legal Counsel to the 'Council of Advisors to the Parliament of (to 1st line col. 3, page 2) Ukraine', says the results of the recent elections 'have shown that the Communists, Socialists and Agrarians won more seats than everybody else put together, including RUKH, the right Nationalists, the Centrists ...' (read then from the last line of col. 3, page 2) "under good ole ..." to the 4th line, col. 1, page 3-"privatized gouging and exploitation ... etc." (sorry about all that, but we killed that gremlin by overfeeding it with fat salty pork rinds and ice cream. CUBAN-CANADIAN WORKER SOLIDARITY DEVELOPING ...

A delegation of Canadian trade unionists was in Cuba to join with workers and officials of the Central of Cuban Workers (C.T.C.) and a wide ranging number of U.S., Latin and South American trade unionists for May Day celebrations and discussions. George Steiger, a prominent member of the Concerned Friends of the Soviet

People, who made the trip, reported to the editors of Northstar Compass and President Michael Lucas on his return from the events.

All delegations were quests of the Central De Trabajadores De Cuba while on the island and were organized from Canada by the Worker-to-Workers Canada-Cuba Labour Solidarity Committee under the direction and leadership of Sarah Shartal. High among the priorities of this Toronto based organization is activity to help extend closer and official ties between the CTC and official bodies of the trade union movement of Canada. Governmental relations between Canada and Cuba have never been severed and have existed officially since the 1959 uprising led by Castro since that date. Official student exchanges, agricultural assistance, tourism, trade and transport have been all of great benefit to both countries. Despite this amicable governmental relationship, there has never been an official relationship between the trade union centres of the two countries.

Work is proceeding apace to organize a second conference called the Second International Solidarity Trade Union Conference in Solidarity With Cuba, and is being organized in Detroit for the 23rd of September this year, Steiger reported. In addition, a special course in collective bargaining is in the making.

NATIONALISM!?

Canada-USSR Association was formed, so that people of two different political systems would travel the road of friendship and understanding. Unfortunately, the growth of nationalism is opposed to this ideal.

Nationalism is a two-edged sword.

When people were subjugated, nationalism was used in order to break the chains that bound the people and was used to gain the road to freedom – as was the case of the liberation of Slovaks and Czechs from the Austro-Hungarian Empire after the First World War.

Unfortunately, nationalism today is used in order to divide, not unite, utilizing the often used adage: divide and rule. This is the road towards fascism.

Example: German fascism utilized nationalism to destroy Czechoslovakia at the beginning of World War II, when Hitler occupied the Sudetan lands of Czechoslovakia, on the pretext of "liberating" Germans from Czechoslovakia, while in the south, Hungary occupied the south of Slovakia, Poland and also, not to be outdone, took part in the northern part of Czechoslovakia.

To the unfortunate tragedy of Slovakia when Hitler occupied the Czech part, in Slovakia, there appeared the clerico-fascist government which declared "Slovakia" independent, but in actual fact, it was a Protectorate of Germany. They installed as

President-Priest Joseph Tiso who took an active part in liquidating the Slovak National Uprising. This was the scenario for the whole of Europe until fascism was defeated.

YOUTH MOVEMENT IN USSR: IN THE NINETIES By Oleg Vorobiov

FOR A RESURRECTED KOMSOMOL AND SOCIALISM

Sources of the contemporary youth movement in our country must be looked for in the USSR during the late 1980's. This was a desperate move to get out of the hole, into which Komsomol was led by the upper echelon of degrading Komsomol leadership. More than 30 years KOMSOMOL lived without any of its own programme, all was downtrodden in an atmosphere of hypocrisy, double facedness, lack of ideals and principles. And the time had come for hope: youth believed the promises and appeals of Gorbachev, and the process of undermining the independent thinking of the masses was started.

In a rousing spirit and enthusiasm, there took place the XX Congress of the Komsomol organization in 1987. Many good resolutions and speeches were adopted on behalf of rank and file Komsomols - but all went into the waste basket. Heading the appeals of Gorbachev (in which the upper crust of Komsomol officers were involved - well prepared to demoralize and made ineffective the enthusiasm of youth - Editors) to start "perestroika", "faster reform", "renewal" - the youth, who believed in Gorbachev, received instead, a slap across the ears. The initiative groups that stormed across the country with the new program and Constitution of rejuvenating the Komsomol organization received instead, persecution across the USSR, and Moscow in particular.

The XXI Congress of Komsomol did not do much better – everything was in a cloud. The dissatisfaction down below in the ranks of the Komsomol was boiling and the problems grew by leaps and bounds, as also the appetite for commercial benefits by the "upper crust of Komsomol". (as was meant to be by perestroika – Editors)

Foreseeing the death of Gorbachev's "new perestroika" course in 1989, a group of Komsomols organized the Union of Young Communists (SMK), worked together with elder comrades from the United Front of Workers, Society "Unity – for Leninism and communist ideals" (All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks), Initiative Movement of Communists (later, this movement became the Russian Communist Workers Party).

In 1990, the Union of Young Communists was enlarged and became the Youth of "Communist Initiative", Moscow organization which was headed by a young Muscovite, communist, economist, Igor Maliarov.

Tragic and disgraceful days were lived by the Komsomol organization in September of 1991, after the victory of the "democratic revolution" of Yeltsin. The scared (turncoats – Editors) leaders-businessmen of the Komsomol organization announced at the XXII Congress that they are liquidating the Komsomol organization!

Sharp denunciation of the traitors and their revisionist positions at this congress was voiced by Igor Maliarov. Together with a group of delegates to this Komsomol Congress, he organized an Organization Committee, "For the resurrection of the Komsomol". Top speed work of the young communists brought fruit and the

Moscow organization of the Komsomol was born. In April-May of 1992 convened the XXIII Congress of resurrecting the Komsomol organization. This congress took place in spite of a ban on the organization and obstacles put in its path by the authorities. At the congress, there were delegates from Moscow, Leningrad, Rostov-on-Don, Novosibirsk, delegates from Ukraine, Byelorussia, Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania, Adagia and Ossetia and many other cities and districts of USSR.

Soviet youth again vowed and adopted the ideals of socialism, ready to struggle for social justice, for unity of the communist movement and for the unity of the USSR. Elected as the first secretary of the Komsomol was the former secretary of the Zelenogrask District Committee of Moscow, Andrei Yezersky, and the secretary for Ideology became Igor Maliarov.

There was much to be done: organize sections all over the country, in the heartland of Russia, establish contacts with the former Soviet Republics, rebuild international contacts. Even with all of these necessary problems to solve, the leadership of the Komsomol became more and more bureaucratic in their style of work, newspaper organizing only interviews and sending out resolutions upon resolutions and instructions all over the country, without thinking what these would accomplish. This method of work made the growth of careerists easy, revisionism took hold plus the growth of Trotskyites elements. The group around Yezersky, tried with force to liquidate the dissatisfaction from beneath or any initiative to establish the Russian section of the Komsomol - a Republican organization in Russia, an integral part of the USSR Komsomol.

January 23, 1993 in Leningrad, there took place an Extraordinary Congress of the Russian Komsomol and it condemned the adventurist leadership in the CC of the Komsomol organization, and then proceeded to elect as its First Secretary a recognized leader of the young communists of Russia, Igor Maliarov.

The Komsomol organization became resurrected, it defeated the policies of Yezerski (tool of Gorbachev-Yeltsin - Editors) and began the cleansing of its ranks at the XXIV Congress that took place in April of 1993 in Minsk, Byelorussia. Delegates from Russia, Byelorussia, Ukraine and delegates from other organizations came out with a program of work and strategy during this period of the restoration of capitalism, the reactivation of reactionary forces was discussed, and they elected their Central Executive Committee. The president of this CC became a 20 year old student of law institute from Moscow, Nikolai Dronov.

The organizational format was to have been finalized in September of 1993 by a Congress. It was to take place in Moscow during the tragic events of the counter-revolutionary take-over by Yeltsin's reactionary forces. It was decided to cancel this Congress and to take part in the defence of the Constitution and of Soviet elected power.

The October events brought the Komsomol unbelievable losses. By a special DECREE, the existence and workings of the Komsomol was banned, the organization lost its finances and building. Igor Maliarov and others were forced to flee

Russia for their lives. In many instances, we had to start from the beginning.

A plenum of the CC of Komsomol of Russia took place in Minsk, Byelorussia which decided that the urgent problem now is to strengthen the existing local organizations and to organize more and more sections of the Komsomol.

Now that the opposition is licking its wounds and strengthening

its ranks, the Komsomol looks at the immediate necessity of uniting the work of the youth organizations in cooperation with the elder comrades from the left and communist parties and patriotic organizations.

At the present moment, aside from the Komsomol organization, in our country, there are scores of other young movements and associations.

Having the "official recognition" and financial help from the "democratic" organizations, although their membership is small, they have tremendous material help, but they defend the interests of the businessmen, effectually have no authority among the broad section of the young generation.

The Trotskyite youth movement is very weak without any influence, whose main aim is to

break up other functioning youth organizations by blackening the names of their leaders. The leader of the Trotskyite youth managed to get some working and student youth to be with them.

In our country in the last while, there grew many anarchist youth groups and movements plus the "greens" movement. They do not agree with the present policies of the regime, and on some questions, they cooperate with the Komsomol organization.

A new youth organization is being organized by Russian Party of Communists, dedicated to look after the interests of children.

It seems that the Communist Party of Russian Federation, not lacking in funds, is on an organizational drive to get youth into its ranks.

March saw the activity of the Crimean Komsomol.

Becoming active are Punks. Extravagant in their dress and manners, they are known by their hate of the present Yeltsin regime. Many of them took part in the defence of the House of Soviets (White House) in October 1993.

An important event for our country took place when the Organizational Conference of the Union of Patriotic Youth "Fatherland" took place. The leaders of the organization, Alexei Lamsi and Ivan Voronin, look at this organization as a movement fighting the devastating results of the "political reform", for moral and cultural resurrection of Russia, resurrection of historical traditions, unifying of the USSR. There is also a section devoted to saving, restoring and building of monuments of history and architecture. To this end, this patriotic organization was able to get into its ranks many left and patriotic youth.

The growth of the youth

movement in our Motherland is growing. The activity is noticed very much in the former Soviet Republics. Under the conditions of illegality, the Komsomol organization is growing in the Baltic Republics. The flowering and blooming of the youth movements is predicted in the very near future. This is tied to the fact that according to the new Constitution (Yeltsin's -Editors) the government will not guarantee youth free education, and the high school education now is not mandatory as it was before. Not too long ago, the government announced that starting with the new school year, all textbooks will have to be bought, which, of course, most average families cannot afford to buy. The students now are facing a real crisis: the scholarships or bursaries are not enough even to buy a copy of Agatha Christy's book! In this situation, the youth will be forced to unite for their rights.

Gone are the days when youth organizations and the Komsomol were led and directed by 40-50 year old apparatchiks in tailored-made suits. Young people have taken to the streets to demand and fight for their rights. They will come up with leaders from their ranks, the average age which is 26 years of age.



We have written much about the tragic events in Moscow, on October 3-4th, 1993. We have also published many photos of the tragedy and will do so again and again, because the world must know of the butchery there. Now more facts are emerging, "thickening the plot". Below, more fragments from journalist Michajlova. When ALL the facts have become completely revealed, we shall publish them as well. Michajlova's facts presented here are based on documentary sources in Moscow – Editors.

• The USSR was not dismembered by the "dissidents" inside the country as proclaimed to the high heavens in the West, or by the crocodile tears shed by Western secret services and journalists on their behalf.

Before Yuri Andropov died, he had discussions with Y. Vlasov in

1974 (Vlasov was a trusted correspondent for Governmental newspapers, such as Izvestia and also internal newspaper for official use only). Andropov hinted that the KGB was impregnated with agents from CIA and said, "I must start a cleansing process internally!"

Even in 1974, the process of "burrowing from within" was in progress!

- The events of 1993 during the May Day Celebrations showed the hand of Yeltsin even then, while the Western correspondents were already saying that they did not "see anything out of the ordinary" during the bloodletting by the OMON good squads!
- On August 12, 1993, Yeltsin already, at that time, said in an internal memorandum that he will "finish with these elements by October 4th".
- In August, when the Director of CIA came to Moscow, he brought with him heads of different CIA departments "street battles", "sniper positional tactics", and "crowd control specialists". Already all these specialists, together with their Russian counterparts, formed the command centre under the command of Lieutenant General Barsukov, while a CIA counterpart was his second-in-command.

In order to help these groups, representatives of the 6th US brigade came to Moscow in secrecy. They were stationed at NATO headquarters, under the command of John Canty. At the disposal of Yeltsin, two top advisors of the CIA were given him as coordinators of the planned attack against the Parliament defenders.

Some Russian members of the Ministry of Defense said that they will not work under the command of the CIA. Most of them were dismissed from their posts and rank.

- Snipers of the 6th NATO brigade were told to take their spots on top roof positions, in all strategic spots, thus encircling the "White House". Western correspondents on October 3-4th already gave their dispatches, saying that some "GI's" were wounded.
- At this time, there took place a coordinated effort to bring to Moscow underground formations of youth of the Zionist organization, "BEYTAR" from districts of Russia and from abroad. They were instructed under the guidance of Israeli "commandos" representatives who came to Russia in secret.
- There were also snipers recruited from the Baltics, who were fighting in Moldavia against the Predniester Republic movement.
- TV cameras and photojournalists from CNN, a week before that bloodshed, were already in positions on top of buildings and in all strategic positions, while the Russian crews were not given the opportunity to cover these events from any vantage point.
- It was found out only now that in the summer of 1993, American troops, together with Yeltsin's trusted divisions, held manoeuvres on the territory of middle Volga River. This is in the centre of Russia! What were they doing there? Were they training how to be soldiers?

The above facts are colossal! How much more are the Soviet people going to have to wait before all the truth comes out? We are going to get this material together and we shall publish it in the near future – Editors.

To such people belongs a well-known farmer-agronomist, brigadeer, mechanical agricultural engineer, from the Korovgrad Province of Ukraine, A.V. Gitalov. His hard life started as a 15 year old youth in 1929 ...

Kulak bands in those times were desperately trying to sabotage the collectivization process, which united individual farmers into a working collective. These Kulak bands organized diversions, killed off farm animals in their thousands, burned bread so as to make the peasants who joined the collective farms starve. This was one of the main reasons for the hunger-famine that overtook our Motherland in 1933. Besides that, the year being without rain, there was a crop tailure. People overcame this tragedy, these diversions, this natural calamity, their unpreparedness and no knowledge of the technology that was becoming available in agriculture at that time. Life began to improve, it went on its own road to remedy the previous years. But, again, the tragedy of the war overtook our country and another lesson was learned. We overcame this tragedy also as victors.

After the Second World War, Alexander Vasilevich, together with his collective farmers, again put their shoulder to the wheel to improve the agriculture. He was the leader of the collectives' mechanized brigades and this brigade became the best brigade in the whole of the Soviet Union, in production, yield and savings to the State. On their experience, the State built a school of higher learning in agriculture, whose 15,000 mechanical engineers

graduated and took their place in agriculture all over the country. Gitalov was the first in the Soviet Union to introduce the complex method of cultivation of hopeless seeds, without losing human work, besides many other inventions and accomplishments in agricultural productivity. He worked also as a tractor driver on a farm in the USA. When he visited America, he learned from US farmer, Mr. Garst, hismethods, and after returning back to his Motherland, he overtook the American farmer in the production of corn.

Soviet Government was very impressed with his work and he received honours for his work. Twice, he was honoured with medals as Hero of Socialist Labour ... besides many other medals, honours and citations. Not only was he an expert in agriculture productivity, he was an activist in Soviet affairs and in the Communist Party of the Soviet Union. This man was elected many times to the Supreme Soviet of Ukraine. He was a Deputy for close to 40 years in the Supreme Soviet of Ukraine. He was a member of the CPSU since 1942.

His thoughts, his expertise, his proposals and methods were published in his "Thoughts about bread", in the newspaper "Pravda of Ukraine" ... after that appearing in a brochure with 2 million circulation.

"His name is the whole epoch in agriculture" was what "Ukrainian Pravda" printed, by I. Kratchenko, correspondent. He was a peoples representative, a talent of the people, a worker who was not boastful or carried airs about his accomplishments. He wanted to make sure that three grains grew where before, only one grew. He was, above all, a human being, devoted to his work, his country and to humanity. His

conscience was crystal clear. That is why his heart and soul did not accept the "perestroika euphoria" which he saw as a criminal robbery of people's wealth, the hard work of generations of Soviet people.

The foreign method of work, a method that is alien to our people, was hung around our necks by our internal and external enemies. The vellow devil was let loose to poison the minds of the people. Something most terrible happened in the life of Alexander Vasielevich ... He was attacked and robbed, beaten. His Gold Stars as Hero of Socialist Labour, were crushed, they took his watch and other gifts he received from the Soviet Government for his work. He was not able to sustain this attack, his heart could not survive this tragic hooliganism. "Oh God" he cried in the hospital, – "How low has our country fallen, year after year, how our country is being degraded!" In a couple of days, the Hero was no more. He died on his 80th year - on the 65th Jubilee of his life work in agriculture for the betterment of humanity that he so cherished and worked so hard to improve standards.

He became great by his dedication to work, he left life, but he gave his all for people whom he served. People, who somewhat forgot his greatness, on whose behalf he died and went on the road to Calvary ... his life being taken away by the elements of the "pseudo-democrats" that now rule Ukraine. But the name of Gitalov now shines even brighter than the Star of Bethlehem, guaranteeing him eternal glory and love of working people. We believe - the stars will awaken our people who still are dreaming and will also obliterate the darkness that still hangs over us. People will awake. My Motherland

Motherland will again be socialist.

NEWS ITEMS from INFORM-FAX "Workers Russia"

Only full transfer of the government to the workers and the complete elimination of the road to

capitalism will save Russia from complete degradation and physical death. This was the consensus arrived at by the Congress of Workers that gathered in Moscow in April.

Congress demanded the resignation of Yeltsin and a new election for the president. Looking at all of the opposition forces and the cry for unity among the communist groups, more than 400 collective groups, movements and parties were asked to present their candidates for the presidency of Russia.

The Congress then approved a motion that there should be picked only one candidate that all of the present representatives of the movements agreed upon. This candidate, in case of victory, will then proceed to abolish the post of presidency in Russia ... and the whole presidential structure as alien to Soviet government. This candidate, if successful, after eliminating the presidency, will proceed to reestablish socialism in the USSR.

The candidate to the post of president was elected. He is Victor Anpilov, head of the Russian Communist Workers Party, released from jail.

Telegram sent to Moscow Kremlin by Citizens of Voronezh, Russia

We demand that:

- 1. Resignation of Yeltsin, liquidation of the post of president of Russia and the complete take over of the Soviets of all governmental functions.
- 2. Make definite the freedom of the demonstration of First of May by workers of Moscow.
- 3. Immediately stop construction of a monument to Hitler's soldiers of the 6th Army of Marshal Von Paulos, which was liquidated by the Red Army at Stalingrad.

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8,000 workers are to be let go by the Tyumen Russian Aviation Complex which manufactures aeroplane turbines for civil and military planes. The Aviation Complex now does not have enough money to pay the workers. On top of this, the English firm which is now in a controlling venture at the complex, has decided that our aviation complex must become a repair shop and not a production complex, since the turbines now will be manufactured in Britain. We are to become the repair analogues to British engines. Margaret Thatcher, God Mother of Gorbachev and the mentor of the capitalist reform in our country, will be very happy with this turn of events - free British industrial giant takes its competitor by the throat in the name of "democracy, competitiveness and friendship"!

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It costs 15,000 to get a cord of wood in the far away Sorokinsk District near Tyumen, Siberia. In order to heat a normal home, in the long winters of Siberia, you need 10 cords of wood, but pensions for senior citizens do not meet this need. The villagers of the town of Vorsovo, as a sign of protest and against the gouching of the privateers, hoisted the Red flag on top of the TV Centre, and are ready to fight the crooks-Mafia-democrats and to re-establish the Soviets again ... from the bottom up.

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Under Soviet Government, it seems there were more Russian Orthodox people going to church than now. This is the consensus of the religious people themselves. It's only a natural reaction, seeing that in order to go to church, buy the candles for services, the costs are going higher and higher. MAY DAY CELEBRATED!

My dear Canadian friends:

I received the Northstar Compass #8 but did not receive a letter whether you have received all of the materials that I did send.

May Day was a grandiose affair, with no less than 100,000 demonstrators in Moscow, filling the whole of Lenin Prospect, filling the prospect from side to side. Again, the present regime banned the May Day Celebration taking place on Red Square. The march was over 5 miles

in length, with people carrying their children on their shoulders. War veterans came out en masse, some with walking sticks and even crutches. I have never seen so many young people as this time taking part.

The OMON (Yeltsin's riot police - Editors) were on hand with their water cannons, while trucks were concentrated in the side streets. They did not dare to interfere. During the march, someone threw from the roof tops anti-Soviet and anti-Communist leaflets into the crowd. The people rebuffed this provocation with shouts and raised fists. No one ran to the roof tops to punish hooligans - there was order. This provocation was meant to give an excuse to the authorities to send in these OMON goons and break up the May Day Celebrations. This time, they did not get their opportunity to spill blood.

In the crowd, there were known leaders walking such as Anatoly Lukyanov, former chairman of the USSR Supreme Soviet who was imprisoned and now is being tried. Also marching was Gennady Zyuganov, Sazhy Umalatova, woman from the Chechen Republic in the Caucusus, who is heading a movement there to revive the USSR; Sergei Baburin, head of the Russian Patriotic Movement; Ilya Konstantinov, president of the National Salvation Front, former prisoner in Lefortovo Prison (together with Anpilov and many others). Anpilov, with his son on his shoulders, led the May Day March. He also presided over three meetings held during the march - in the October Square where we laid flowers at the foot of V.I. Lenin monument; in the Gagarin Square where we were beaten up last May Day and where we laid flowers on the pavement; (our writer himself was beaten on this spot last May Day - Editors). The last meeting was held at the University on Lenin Hills. At these meetings, leaders from all movements and Communist-Socialist parties spoke. The priest who spoke, spoke well, even though this May Day Celebration coincided with the Russian Orthodox Easter.

At this last meeting of the May Day March on Lenin Hills, the crowd sang patriotic and revolutionary songs and danced. The whole function was a great inspiration for me. I felt part and parcel of the great numbers of people who think like I do and who feel like I do. These people are not afraid of the clique that is now in power and are fighting for a great Socialist Motherland. Even in spite of the bloodshed and deaths that occurred last year during the May Day Celebrations, the participation was tremendous. Also, in spite of the tragedy and death at the "White House" last October, the people are beginning to rally and are becoming more and more militant. This is extremely inspiring.

I'm sending some newspapers in the envelope to you. "Molniya" newspaper is included, and newspaper "Voice of a Communist" where, from the archives, an article and document is printed which shows that Alexander Yakovlev (former Ambassador to Canada -Editors) demanded that the Soviet newspapers do not celebrate the 75th Birthday of the hero, Marshal Zhukov! This was written over 15 years ago, so readers can realize that Alexander Yakovlev (mentor of Gorbachev) - even at that time was doing his anti-Soviet work. - Editors).

I hope that these newspapers and clipping will be of interest to you.

Will send an issue of the newspaper "Zavtra" - (Tomorrow) which has an article on the "health of Yeltsin" from Iona Andronov's book, "The Secrets of the Kremlin" which will be published in the West.

Andronov is a former correspondent of the "Literaturnaya Gazeta" to the USA and Afghanistan, a deputy to the Supreme Soviet who stayed in the "White House" when it was under attack and saw the deaths of his comrades - he stayed to the very last.

WHO ARE THESE "OURS"?

Nowadays, all forces of opposition (and not only opposition) very often utilize the terminology – "Ours"? This term is utilized everywhere, even by opposite forces, like ice and fire – extreme opposites. Examples such as OURS from (Ryzhkov to Andropov) or deputies such as (Khasbulatov to Svobodkina), etc., etc.

This word now is losing its roots and meaning. Case in point was my understanding of the thoughts of former Vice President Nikolai Ivanovich Ryzhkov (under Gorbachev) when lately, he gave an interview in OUR newspaper, "Tomorrow". I will try to look at this question not only from a Marxist point of view, but also from the emotional one.

Nikolai Ryzhkov, finding himself in opposition at that time of crisis, during Gorbachev's sell-out – talked with workers at the industrial enterprise "Belogordsky Energomasha". The discussion with the workers by Ryzhkov proved very heated and showed the true attitude, feelings and programme of the former Vice President, which was unknown publicly until now.

Ryzhkov also did not pull any punches, during this heated discussion. The same questions were asked: "Why and how did this calamity happen?" He answered: "Why? Because you, the workers, were to blame! Therefore, do not ask me why! I should ask you this question!" He went on to say that all the workers and Soviet people are to blame for this tragedy ... "because you did not want to wait for step-by-step road towards the market economy as I wanted to you wanted immediate consumer goods. So now, you've got it! You were impatient, and you were not very bright!"

How can you, Nikolai Ivanovich, say that to the workers? It's the Gorbachev, Abalkin, Petrakova, Gaydar, Yeltsin – these are the son-of-bitches who are to blame, plus people like you who tried to soften the march to market economy! How can you blame the Soviet workers?

This is what OUR workers received from OUR Ryzhkov, published in OUR newspaper as answer to OUR question as to why?

Myself, as an ordinary worker, learned over many years from the rank and file workers before I became the manager of the enterprise.

This brings to mind an incident of a professor who wrote a book on the Israel's aggression against the Arabs. One of the managers of the section of our industrial enterprise, already imbued with reformism, asked the professor, "How are OUR people doing?" One old timer attending this meeting asked the person asking the question, "Who are the ones you call OURS?"

The person asking that question

soon after emigrated from the Soviet Union. From then on, I always ask myself the question and ask it of others also. "What do you mean by OURS?"

I'm asking this question of Nikolai Ryzhkov: "Where and who were OURS during the XXVIII Congress of the CPSU? Did you ever ask the workers what they thought, what their proposals were, their solutions to the upcoming crisis? Did you ever ask OUR workers?

It was you Nikolai Ivanovich, together with Leonid Abalkin who headed a Commission on Economy and it was both of you (former members of CC CPSU) who brought in the resolution on Market Economy! You never talked at that time about capitalism, even though you knew what you proposed as market economy was, in reality, capitalism.

Ryzhkov told the workers this terrible truth: "Our program was for private and state property – state property to be only 40%. This was our line!"

At the 28th Congress, I was empowered by our RCWP to try and get to the podium to speak. I told Ryzhkov himself, that you cannot make socialism better by healing it with capitalism. This will be chaotic and will bring workers into terrible economic hardships and completely ruin and dismember the USSR. As far as the CPSU is concerned, the party will not be able to withstand this remedy!"

Do you remember Mr. Ryzhkov? Our proposals and analyses, you and others did not allow us for 3 days to get to the podium and speak. The leaders at the podium were Gorbachev and Yeltsin and their stooges. Over 200 Deputies signed a petition to let me speak, but this was to no avail. Only on the last day, we organized our Communists who

took over the 13 microphones by force, did we manage to speak to the Congress delegates.

After my speech, Mikhail Gorbachev called me up and with his dark, gloomy, full-of-hate eyes, asked me: "Victor, what's this? We thought that you were OURS, and you ...?"

For the resolution on Market Economy, only 1,259 delegates voted – 1/3 of the CPSU delegates. Where were OURS – in the midst of the 1/3 or among the 2/3? Obviously, they were here and there.

Different "OURS" took different roads at the 28th Congress. Did these delegates understand? Not all, but most did. Ryzhkov, former Vice President under Gorbachev, understood. During intermission, I and Sergei Strebkov from Kubishev came up to Ryzhkov. He told us what we all feared was happening. He said: "Muzhiki, (friends) you have no idea what is happening and what is being planned and who is coming into power" (By this, Ryzhkov meant Yeltsin and others – Editors).

Of course, we did not know everything, but we were obsessed with the idea that among all those deputies, there were "OURS". The whole calamity is this – the CPSU could have cleansed itself of these opportunists-traitors, but the biggest tragedy was that the leadership of the CPSU was not in touch, did not consult "OURS" – the rank and file workers.

This cardinal fact, Ryzhkov does not understand to this date. Replying to the question as to why he did not speak up against Gorbachev, why he did not make known the dangers that Gorbachev's policies presented to the Soviet people, he said: "it is better to argue up at the top, bite each other, but this fight should not be allowed to be known by people below. I did

not want to put people into a position where they had to make a choice, are you for Gorbachev or Ryzhkov?"

In this, there's a terrible weakness in Ryzhkov and this sickness affected most people of the CC CPSU. He continued to state that even in 1990, he knew what was happening!

Why did he not ask "OURS", the people in the factories, collective farms? The big question is whom he did ask? They were not "OURS"! They let this dangerous situation become a play of personalities ... instead of asking the people what must be done, informing them about the dangers of Gorbachev's intrigues.

This cardinal fact of being with the people, discussing the future with them, was forgotten, or more to the point – purposely, the events transpiring were kept away from the masses.

We cannot speak or pretend that these leaders were OURS. Facts proved that these people were adventurists, traitors, opportunists and they had no qualms to sell their country to the transnational corporations.

But we, as communists, follow Marxist teachings – any given question or problem should be answered by consulting the people, listening to their advise and experience. Privatization should be looked at from a class point of view – Who will own it? Who will work at it? For whose benefit willit serve? Only from this position, we can ask, "Who are OURS?!"



3.5 million children, because of the high cost of travel and lodgings, were not able to enjoy their summer holidays as was done previously for children going free to Pioneer Camps. In 1992, only 4% of children were considered fully healthy.



AT THE MEETING!

At the Volyn University, there took place an event that united the professors and students alike. What's so different about this? - you will ask. The question is this - the meeting was awaited for over three months, from November of 1993. Professors received their pay last November (1993) 250,000 rubles (coupons), they had to live on this miserable pay more than 90 days. From this, he had to pay for a loaf of bread - 2,560 rubles, liter of milk - 3,500 rubles, kilo of meat - 50-60,000 roubles, newspaper – 1-2,000 rubles. Live on this for 90 days!

One more example. They are planning an Educational Conference at the University. But in order for a professor or a student to publicize-print his thesis, the cost is over 50,000 rubles ... for two pages of his presentation. As they say here, miracles are in a sieve. This is not an anecdote – this is the contemporary "democracy"!

But why are the people quiet? No, they are not quiet. They talk, complain and exclaim around corners. To speak up openly was not accepted before. The people got accustomed that the state will look after the individual. There was never more than a day or two when your pay was not given to you before - everyone knew that they have work, because Soviet State guaranteed it, free education everyone knew that they would get, free medical care and rest-holidays. This was taken for granted. All the rights for MAN were guaranteed.

Yes, but this was before. Now, we have different times ...

There was a Strike Committee organized at the University. At the

end of February 1994, there took place a meeting. The strike did not take place, as it did in Kiev University. But there was such determination by faculty and students that finally on February 26th, the faculty received their pay ... for December only. And at the beginning of March, for January. What about February? No one knows. Some professors say that with the February's pay, they might have to drink with a glass of water. We shall see. But will all of us live? ...

Well, what can I say, we have to adapt to this "democracy". The fact is that the people elected these "leaders" themselves. There is "freedom" now for all. You want to live, live – or you can die! No one has any right to you or concern about you. This is the real bourgeois democracy!

Besides, to our meeting of professors and students, there came a very important personage -Deputy to the Supreme Soviet of Ukraine, - violent "democrat", anticommunist and former pseudocommunist of CPSU-Ukraine, Mr. Gudyma. He tried to brow beat professors and students, telling them that they should wait a bit longer than 90 days for their pay. He said that Western Ukrainians (as opposed to Eastern Ukrainians -Editors) are more cultured. "You should be more patient. This is how it should be, as was done to 'shut the vocal demands of the striking miners'!" But after these provocative words by the Deputy, the whole audience of professors and students rose up with clamour and shouts. The Deputy again derided the professors and students as "Kolbassa eaters" and left the microphone and stage. But this "people's representative", this "deputy", this "pseudo-communist now turned rabid anti-communist"

does not want himself to be patient. He lives very richly, thanks to the "pseudo-democrats". He gets paid not in rubles (coupons) but in Dollars, not in "sovereign coupons", and besides this, he has plenty of kolbassa to eat. You cannot blame the veterans for being angry and traumatized by today's situation and attitude! They fought, they came back, expecting that in their older years, they would have peace and quiet, respect and at least, understanding as to why they fought and died.

During our last meeting of the veterans, Vasili Bondarenko, a fighter pilot ace, Hero of the Soviet Union, told us that one day as he was walking along Kiev Street, a young youth of 17 years, full of nationalistic hate in him, stopped him, tore the gold medals from his chest tunic and threw it away so hard that they broke into pieces and said through his teeth: "You, grandfather, take off those other tin medals or I will take them off together with your head!"

The veteran was so astounded by this act, not believing that this could even happen, that he just stood there. After, he thought – if I was only 20-30 years younger, I would know what to do!

I do not know in what kind of family this upstart was brought up. You could rationalize that this was just plain hooliganism, that he did not know what the Golden Star meant. But this is just wishful thinking. These cases are not isolated – they are happening each day and someone is doing this indoctrination with a purpose in mind.

Anyone knows, even the basic criminal, that receiving a Golden Star is for valour beyond the call of duty. This is a nationalistic attack, promoted by Ukrainian nationalists and their across-the-border foreign sponsors and paymasters.

In Ivano-Frankovsk region of Ukraine, veterans in a city sanctioned manifestation to celebrate the liberation from German fascism the city of Ivano-Frankovsk

were marching to lay wreaths and flowers to the liberators. Suddenly from side streets, a well organized gang of youths with batons, sticks, knives and bottles attacked the veterans, trampling underneath their feet the signs, flowers and wreaths and physically beating up the veterans, while local militia were not to be found anywhere. The police to this date cannot find the perpetrators and the case is closed!

President Krawchuk and his government know that they adopted a Law #2159-XII from March 2, 1992 which guarantees the sacredness of medals, or decorations that the veterans of the Ukraine received in the Great Patriotic War. The heroes of these medals and decorations must be protected by law agencies — that's what this decree adopted states!

Where is this protection?

There are so many instances of planned hooliganism that it is impossible for me to list even a segment of them. It is enough to state that on a trolley bus, in the middle of Kreshchatik Street in Kiev, some hooligans attacked a woman veteran in her 80th year and physically tore off her chest the medals she was wearing.

There is a definite campaign to either steal the medals from apartments, take them off forcibly from the chests of veterans – it all goes to point to a campaign of liquidating any open vestiges of Soviet society from the onlookers' eyes and memory.

To this date, the Ukrainian authorities have not been able to catch the hooligans. Not one case has been solved.

I appeal to all veterans to organize and to take all measures to stop this planned liquidation of medals, decorations and physical attacks.

leave the Lenin Mausoleum alone.



- ... Largest percent of young people interviewed told us that they do not expect to get any help from the present regime. This is the beginning of tragic results for the future if things do not get better ...
- ... The lack of medicines, and the tremendous high costs make them affordable only to a very few ...

There are being set up more and more pornographic theatres, like "Aphrodyte" with foreign owners and pornography rule the theatres of Ukraine today. Either you flow with the tide or you are marooned in limbo.

In order to graduate from the Actors Institute, you must do a diploma work, but if it does not contain pornographic acts, there is not much possibility that you will receive your diploma.

I will be forced to do likewise. Rather, I will leave now, before it's too late. Things have to change, we cannot go on like this!

Thank you, my "Tovarish", for listening to my story. I believe in you, and am waiting for the time when this foreign culture that is foisted upon us to emulate will pass, and our culture containing the highest humanness and optimism will again be seen on our stage, TV and in our spectacles.

We cannot live like this.

I and many others protested to the militia standing outside, but he only laughed and told us to move on!

Is it worth going to vote? Maybe the Election Commission should not bother anyone of the public but just cast ballots themselves!

In spite of these illegal practices, the left forces managed to get the most votes. The struggle continues. – Editors.

From newspaper "LUGANSKAYA PRAVDA"

This newspaper was sent to us by our correspondent, Felix Gorelik from Lugansk, for which we sincerely thank him. We publish some excerpts from it, since space does not permit us the opportunity to give you word for word translation.

• Regardless of the Constitution guaranteeing work for everyone, as the present Ukrainian leaders like to proclaim to the world and to us in the Ukraine, the situation is getting desperate for finding work. As the old proverb says: "If there is a neck, you will find a yoke" — but nowadays, you cannot find a job

even if you do have your neck ready for it!

This is especially true for young people, who are coming into the work force. Can you imagine the trauma of young people, looking for work for the first time? Having been brought up under Socialism, having seen full employment of their parents, it's a shocking experience for them.

- With privatization going on, with the top posts in enterprises in the hands of speculators and anti-Soviet elements, even if you get a job, the pay is so low as to be impossible to subsist and when asking for a raise, you are told, "you can leave any time there are others waiting"!
- Parents who are working, sometimes do not receive their pay for two-three months at a time. They depend on their grown children to help out, but now, they find themselves in even worse situation than their parents!
- Industrial schools are hard-hit now, since during Socialism, the school had free meals for students, but now, the schools make students pay for the meals, while at the same time, the stipends that students were receiving from the State are lowered, and the meal costs are taken off them.
- More than 56% of young workers are unemployed and the schools cannot find work for them or help them in any way. They are the unemployed generation, thanks to the "perestroika market economy".
- There is a special movement promoted by the forces of reaction, in order to hoodwink people again from voting for Socialism, and that is the strategy of saying "Forget Socialism and Capitalism, there is a THIRD ROAD to prosperity"!

They propose the course of Social Democrats that were in Germany, who helped put Hitler on the rails to fascism.

- Let not these present "social-democrats" get upset that people confuse them with RUKH or the present Ukrainian party in power. We do not see the difference between them anyway.
- The temporary demise of the USSR was accomplished (besides from outside) mainly internally by top echelons of the CPSU. Unfortunately, a lot of people were fooled by the "package of capitalism-market economy" and the "heavenly gates" that will open up immediately. Now, we all know upon our own skin what this market economy means people are beginning to awaken. That is why the voters are making their choice, no longer under any illusion.

REMEMBER THESE NAMES – From the October Massacre!

Under this heading, the newspaper lists the names of all the officers, their rank and section they commanded in Kontemirovsky Division. People will remember these names and justice will be done for the murder of innocent people.

The Ministry of Defence had thrown against the House of Soviets the following:

- 3,000 officers and men
- 10 tanks
- 80 cannons
- 20 armored vehicles
- 15 machine guns
- 60 assault heavy machine guns

As I have written before in your Northstar Compass about the elections in the Ukraine, let me bring you up to date on local elections in Lugansk. As I wrote before, we call our city-district, "Lugansk-Stalingrad". You be the judge of my predictions!

From 24 Districts, 18 candidates from the 24 were all members of

the Communist Party of Ukraine! The miners said their piece by voting for the representatives whom they know will fight for their rights.

Pervomaisk City, where there are mass of emigrants from the Lvov district, and which was considered a bastion of support for RUKH movement, an invitation was issued to the residents to come out into the streets under the slogan of, "in the name of the enemy of the people" (instead of "Lenin", they utilized the word, "enemy"). Some of our candidates lost, like V. Shackim, not able to get the necessary publicity or get air time on TV, since everything had to be paid for to private enterprise.

Nevertheless, Lugansk has built a foundation, which overall is a success as seen by the last election results, but which we think that in the future will be emulated by the whole of Ukraine. In the composition of the new Ukrainian Parliament, there is a mighty, solid block of left

wing-communist deputies, who will have a tremendous influence on the policies of the governing body.

And those that are still under the influence of the nationalistic forces or under illusion of "market reforms", will eventually come to realize, as the workers of Lugansk have realized. Capitalism will not pass. Victory will be ours!

LETTER FROM MOSCOW

I send greetings to all friends of the Soviet Union on this May Day and the Day of Victory.

I received the recent Northstar Compass with Anpilov's letter to you. Judging by his photo, that means that you received my letter and materials that it contained. In general, I'm not sure whether you do receive all the materials that I regularly send you.

Hans from Berlin sent me a letter recently and he is satisfied with what he received from you. I read his article on Germany in the publication. I feel that I've accomplished something by connecting Hans with you.

Last week, I attended a Students' Rally at the House of Soviets (White House). The rally was against poverty, low student stipends, the destruction of education and scientific development. One of the organizers was the Komsomol organization. Afterwards, they marched to The Kremlin along Kalinin Prospect (now called New Arbat) from the Ukraine Hotel up,

they were stopped by the OMON (Yeltsin's goon squads - Editors) and were beaten - some arrested. I feel that this is good schooling for the students-young people, because some of the youth still entertain the notion of hope in the policies of Yeltsin. I'm enclosing one of their leaflets. By the way, almost simultaneously, there "picketing" at the USA Embassy, (across the road from the White House) against US and NATO bombing of Serbs. The police did not interfere.

At the White House, another cross was erected (this time, made of stone) on April 4th, six months after the terrible massacre at the Supreme Soviet Building. On this day, there took place huge demonstrations and rallies to commemorate this occasion. Enclosed, please find a photograph of this rally from the newspaper, "Pravda". On the photograph I marked the photo of Naval Lieutenant Igor Ostapenko. He was the one that organized his sailors and rushed together with them to the defence of the Constitution and the Supreme Soviet that were defending the "White House". The sailors were stopped by OMON near Moscow and were shot at, detained and then they were severely punished. Igor Ostapenko perished in this confrontation (see photo on cover – Editor).

At a rally at the Lenin Stadium in Luzhniki (readers will find a photo of this rally in this issue – Editors) General Varennikov of the Army, hero of the Great Patriotic War, one of the so-called "putschists", gave his own Gold Star as Hero of the Soviet Union to Ostapenko's father! It was a heart-warmingmoving moment that brought people to their feet with tears in their eyes!

Enclosed, please find an Invitation Card for the Rally which was dedicated to the anniversary of the Referendum for the USSR.

The walls of the stadium (near the White House) where OMON and "Beytar" (Zionist organization) shot the prisoners (defenders of the White House – Editors) are still plastered with slogans, placards, quotations against Yeltsin's regime. I enclose a poem from the Wall, "Hitler's letter to Yeltsin". (Readers have read this

poem in the April issue of Northstar Compass - Editors). Perhaps your readers will not understand what is meant by the "rails that were melted" to give Yeltsin an iron cross. The crosses at the walls where people were murdered are always covered with fresh flowers and wreaths. The trees around there are draped in red and black ribbons. The whole place is guarded by young Cossacks.

This year's May Day celebrations were attended by thousands of people, but again, the police did not allow us to march through the Red Square. Although this time, there was no bloodshed or attacks on the demonstrators.


