

50TH ANNIVERSARY OF WORLD WAR II IS OVER, BUT WHAT LIES AHEAD?

People all over the world commemorated this great event in many different ways, but no matter how this Victory Day was marked, everyone paid respect to the over 50,000,000 people that perished during this great tragedy that could have been avoided by the powers that were ruling at that time.

We published our thoughts on that war in the last issue of NSC and this issue also contains facts that are not well known or publicized by the present powers that are in charge.

We cannot but be disturbed by the events that took place in the former Soviet Union on this Anniversary, but we are overjoyed that Soviet people staged counterdemonstrations in former USSR. Read the fax that was received from Moscow. Bill Doaris, our member and reader of NSC who was in Moscow and sent this report to Workers World and Northstar Compass!

After Yeltsin did everything to fulfill the demands of Western powers regarding the holding of the parade in Red Square on May 9th – by this, we mean the hand-picked veterans that marched – the toned-down meaning of this great victory by closing off 10 city blocks around the Kremlin and Red Square to traffic and pedestrians. Even after all of these steps were taken in order to bow to Clinton, Kohl and other Western leaders that came to Moscow to witness this affair, here is what actually transpired.

Leaders of Britain, France, Canada and Germany had bowed out of the toned-down military parade! But you could see red flags flying in spite of the ban by the authorities.

The most galling remark that we have read in a long time was the report in the Toronto Star, May 9th, by Olivia Ward, Moscow Bureau, when she wrote: "Germans had an excuse (of bowing out of seeing the military parade – Editors). It was the enemy in 1945 and celebrating its own defeat could be embarrassing."!!!???

REALLY!

By that remark, it portrays the feeling of the Western leaders gathered there, that the policy of Germany of 1941-1945 seems to be the same as the policy of the present Kohl regime in Germany! There is no other conclusion that can be drawn. This smacks of revanchism, this thinly veiled effort shows that Germany, with the backing of "Western democracies", has the same expansionist policies as Hitler had, in spite of the fact that Yeltsin and company have bent backwards to accommodate this rape of the Soviet people!

This article in the Star newspaper probably sums up the <u>REAL</u> fear of the Western Imperialist powers, when she wrote: "... and they are equally worried about the resurgence of Communism. As long as they can see no alternative to Yeltsin, they will keep on supporting his policies towards 'free and open society'!"

We could not have said it better ourselves!

In another part of this issue, you will read about the cable that was sent to Mayor Luzhkov of Moscow, protesting his edict to bar the Soviet people from holding a REAL demonstration on this 50th Anniversary. Protests of this kind were sent from all over the world!

One of the tragedies of the the celebrations in West. commemorating the 50th Anniversary is the obvious fact that the role of the Soviet Red Army and its people was practically ignored from capitalist media, celebrations, and other events that were held. It is as if a "command" was given from somewhere to minimize or not mention the tremendous sacrifices that were made by the Soviet Union! A person born after 1945 does not know about the loss of over 27,000,000 Soviet people in this carnage! Schools do not teach these facts, the media ignores it. Western leaders minimize it and the enemies of Socialism gleefully applaud these lies and fabrications!

There is an obvious purpose for this happening. The less the present and future generations know about the Soviet sacrifices in order to save mankind from fascism, the more safe capitalism feels. After all, if the young generation would be told in graphic terms that the loss of the Soviet people in World War Two was over 27,000,000 and equate that horrific fact with the present reality - it means that the loss was so horrendous as if the ENTIRE POPULATION OF CANADA WAS WIPED OFF THE FACE OF THE EARTH!

This would bring the stark reality home to everyone. This, they could relate to!

But facts are hard to swallow, hard to remedy the repercussions that might follow if all these facts were known.

EDITORIAL

MOSCOW, May 9 – Bill Clinton joined Boris Yeltsin and other heads of state here today to mark the 50th Anniversary of the end of World War II in Europe. But the country that really defeated the Nazis was excluded from the ceremony. That country was the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, which was destroyed in 1991 after 50 years of "Cold War" by the US and other wealthy capitalist powers.

But the Soviet Union was present in the streets of Moscow and other former Soviet cities as hundreds of thousands of protesters turned the day into a giant rally for Communism.

In Moscow, over 300,000 people, young and old, women and men, from all the nationalities that comprised the Soviet Union, marched up Gorky Prospekt behind red Soviet flags and anticapitalist banners.

Huge marches also took place in Leningrad, Minsk, Kiev, Sevastopol, Khabarovsk and other cities across the former Soviet Union. Elsewhere, the masses brought red flags to the "official" ceremonies and turned them into pro-Soviet demonstrations. In the Baltic Republics, where there were no official commemorations, tens of thousands went to World War II ceremonies with red flags. In Dushanbe, capital of Tajikistan, red flags flew at the official ceremony.

At the heavily guarded state event in Moscow's Red Square, Clinton, Helmut Kohl, John Majors and others prattled about Russia's capitalist "new democracy".

But just a few blocks away, a sea of people, led by war veterans, made it clear that the millions of Soviet people who died fighting Hitler were defending socialism against capitalism. They chanted "Soviet Power" and "Soviet Union", and marched behind banners saying "Red Flag of Victory to the Kremlin". And they condemned Clinton, Kohl and Yeltsin as representing the same multinational banks and corporations that put Hitler in power in Germany.

The Moscow city government first tried to ban "unofficial" rallies from the center of the city. But when the militant Workers' Russia movement made clear it would not be intimidated, the state backed down.

The pro-Soviet march ended with a massive rally in Lubyanka Square chaired by former Soviet general Grigory Achalov and opened by General Varenikov, who had been imprisoned for trying to stop the dissolution of the USSR.

At the rally, Sazhi Umalatova, former Soviet deputy from Chechnya and chair of the Supreme Soviet, condemned Yeltsin and his Western backers for falsifying history. "They say it was purely a military victory, a victory of

Russia over Germany, but it was a victory of socialism over capitalism"

Viktor Anpilov of Workers' Russia and the Russian Communist Workers Party said, "We should not forget that our people won because every person was not fighting for his little piece of land but for a socialist society. Now that private property has been restored we are enslaved by the dictatorship of the International Monetary Fund."

At the march assembly point, Bill Doares gave a statement from Workers World Party. He pointed out that the biggest corporations in the US today - GM, Ford, General Electric, etc. – all had plants in Nazi Germany producing for Hitler's war machine and using concentration camp labor. "These are the same corporations Clinton represents today", he said. "But we are confident that the Soviet people, who raised the red flag of victory over the Reichstag, will defeat the new capitalist invaders, those who wear business suits, instead of grey uniforms."

Most of the speakers at the rally were veterans. In an especially

moving demonstration, hundreds of World War II veterans took off victory medals they had been awarded by Yeltsin, and threw them on the ground.

On Sunday, May 7, Umalotova presented a Defender of Soviet Power medals to hundreds of veterans who had refused to accept Yeltsin's award.

Rosa Salmanova, a Jewish woman from Belarus who had served in the Red Army in World War II, told Workers World how her entire family had been murdered by the Nazis in the Minsk ghetto. The extermination squads, she said, were made up of 'Vlasovites' – Russian Nazis who fought for Hitler under a striped red, white and blue symbol of the Yeltsin regime, which Clinton says is "leading Russia down the path to democracy".

"The Soviet people will fight and fight till that flag is removed, and the red flag flies again", Salmanova said.



TRAGEDY OF OKLAHOMA

The tragedy of the bombing of a Government building in Oklahoma City is something that the U.S. government should have expected. The death toll is reaching close to 200 people, with millions in damage and forthcoming law suits by relatives of the dead.

The right wing extremists were active and are active in practically every state of the USA. "REFRESHING" EXPLOITATION OF THE WEALTH OF CENTRAL ASIA

The following information appeared in "The Globe and Mail" of April 3, 1995, in the section "Report on Business", under the heading, "Canadians Part of Central Asian Boom". It's not very often that big business confesses so frankly and in such gloating terms to shameless exploitation of its victims. The readers are told that the Republics of Kazakhstan and Kyrgyzstan, which used to be the "backwater" of the Soviet Union, are now flourishing places of business. Let's see what the "good news" is all about, what sort of business transactions are being conducted, and whose interests are being advanced.

Mr. Werner Wenzel, a Calgary oil executive, is one of the regular foreign visitors to the capital of Kazakhstan, Almaty, which, we learn, is emerging as Central Asia's financial centre. The object of these visitors is to negotiate deals for oil exploration and prospecting for minerals, including gold. Wenzel is happy to point out that both Kazakhstan and its neighbour, Kyrgyzstan, are prime sites for business because of their "visible wealth". Moreover, their governments actively encourage private involvement in their resource sectors and provide support for private foreign investments. Wenzel finds this "very refreshing".

Small wonder. Of course, it's "very refreshing". The Calgarybased oil companies, of which Wenzel is the president, are investing \$420 million in the oil project in Central Kazakhstan, and also have exploration rights at two other sites. The three oil fields have an estimated reserve of between 110 million and 140 million barrels. At full production, they plan to extract up to 36,000 barrels a day. Wenzel is also negotiating the possible purchase of several government oil companies which are soon to be privatized. He is sure he can't lose.

Another investor in Kyrgyzstan is Charles McMillan of Toronto, once an aide to former Prime Minister Brian Mulroney. He became an economic adviser to President Askar Akayev of Kyrgyzstan and helped him draft the country's first economic plan. Apas Jumagulov, the Prime Minister of the Republic, said that his government was committed to market reforms and is "prepared to create all kinds of good conditions for foreign investors". Among these "good conditions" are a five-year tax holiday and other concessions. Another advantage of prospecting for gold in Kyrgyzstan are the local workers that are hired. We are told that they are welleducated and eager to learn, and that

their wages are 10 percent of Canadian norms. This reminds one of the partnership between the Walrus and the Carpenter on the one hand, and the oysters on the other. It is clear who is being devoured and by whom. The analogy between Lewis Carroll's "Through the Looking Glass" and the developments in Kazakhstan and Kyrgyzstan are, unfortunately, only too valid.

However, not everything in the two Central Asian Republics is agreeable to Canadians and other foreign investors. There are former Communists who aren't at all pleased with what their governments are doing, with the way they are introducing market reforms by giving orders from the top and selling out to foreign These business interests. Communists are saying that there is no need for foreign investors. They are right, of course. The Central Asian Republics do not need foreign investors. On the contrary, it is these foreign investors who crave the wealth of Kazakhstan and Kyrgyzstan. It is all so "refreshing".

with U.S. Vice President Al Gore, Croatian President Franjo Tudjman won an agreement for the transfer of U.N. troops.

Under the new mandate, U.N. troops will patrol the borders between Serbian Krajina and Yugoslavia and Bosnia. The intent is to blockade Krajina. There will also be a significant reduction of U.N. troops separating Croatian and Serbian forces.

Serbian Krajina was established in 1991 following Croatian repression of its Serbian minority. This repression recalled the earlier pro-Nazi Croatian state, in which the fascist Ustashe exterminated one million Serbs, Jews and Gypsies. In 1991, Serbs were ousted from 10 towns and 183 villages, and over 300,000 Serbs were expelled from Croatia.

Helsinki Watch reported that "since 1991, the Croatian authorities have blown up or razed 10,000 houses, mostly of Serbs ... In some cases they dynamited homes with the families inside".

Parliamentary member Tomislav Mercep, who belongs to the ruling party, is a death squad leader. In Gospic, Mercep's death squad murdered several dozen Serbs. Mercep was also responsible for the murder of 150 Serbs in Karlovac, as well as a number of other mass killings.

Recently, a monument to antifascist fighters was blown up in Rijeka, and to date, over 3,000 antifascist memorials have been demolished in Croatia. A monument was erected in Zagreb this March, honoring German Nazi soldiers killed during World War II. Last year, Tudjman introduced a new currency, the kuna, the same name as that used by the Croatian pro-Nazi puppet state.







Here's just a summary of some of these protests:


• In the Korean Peoples Democratic Republic, tens of thousands marched, danced and praised the leadership of the country and its booming economy, in spite

ARMY: YESTERDAY, TODAY AND TOMORROW

Many readers and members, as well as people in all walks of life, could not understand how the Soviet Army that liberated Europe 50 years ago, that was the guarantor of peace would not be able, in the last 10 years, to make its stand in stopping the dismemberment of the Soviet Union and the break up of one of the mightiest force that the USSR has known. What were the reasons? Who started this process? Why did not the Soviet Army take a stand in order to save the Soviet Union?

This article below tries to answer some of these questions – Editors.

As is well known, the Red Army was organized February 23, 1918 in order to defend the victory of the Great October Revolution which started the country on a socialist path. Even though our country was in shambles, the young Red Army was able to give opposition and eventually defeat the remnants of the Tsarist Army. After that, the Red Army defeated the Germans and the Antante which invaded the young Soviet State. Why was this so? Was it because we had biggerresources or man power? No! It was the dedication, the belief in the Revolution and the belief in communism. Tsarist Army went into battle with the cry of "God, Tsar and Fatherland" but they were not defending their best interests or a better life for their families.

Miracle did happen that poorly clothed, poorly armed young Red Army defeated 14 countries that invaded the young Soviet State!

After the Civil War, there came upon us the Great Patriotic War, a most terrible calamity to have befallen our Motherland. The Western countries of Europe fell into dust under the tanks and planes of the Wermacht-France in 2 months. Polish gentry in two weeks. The ruling classes of these countries energetically gave up their countries. These leaders were in league with fascism in that they wanted once and for all to finish off communism and the USSR. These leaders were the ones that started the fires in Buchenwald and other death camps.

And it was only the Communists and the unity of Soviet people that took up arms and dealt the death blow to fascism. Now the Western historians are running all over themselves, saying that it was "Stalin who fed Hitler"! But it was your previous leaders of Europe and America that fed Hitler, that urged him "Eastward", that did everything possible in order for Germans to bleed dry together with USSR and then the West would walk in to pick up the spoils.

England was shaking on its own island, trying desperately to move Hitler eastward. Second Front was delayed and delayed ... hoping against hope that the Red Army would suffer a defeat. Western Ukrainian nationalists and Zionists alike praised Hitler for their own ends. There are documented proof published in their own newspapers that are available to any scholar or researcher to look at and study. Historical documents tell the truth, no matter how unpleasant it is.

And again, the USSR, not having the industrial potential of Western Europe again performed a miracle ... and our soldiers went all the way to Berlin and beyond,

helping to liquidate fascism with the help, late as it was, by the Western Allies.

Nowadays, the present apologists for Hitler, the modern "pseudo-democrats" write and cry that the USSR won the war because of Stalin's terror and because of the enormous losses by the Soviet people.

These people should remember that India in the course of this war (India was a colony of Britain) lost over 20,000,000 from starvation! British colonial Empire paid for the war, while we had to pick up the pieces ourselves. Yes, Stalin did help to close the German furnaces, stopped making lampshades out of human skins. Glory to him, because he was man of his time!

Here is an episode, available from documents and archives, that Western historians or our present "democrats" never want to make public. The war was near its end, Russian aviation was in the final stages of upgrading its bombers and fighters with rockets which can be fired from planes up to 70 km. Stalin telephoned the designersconstructors whether they recommend that the Soviet airforce be equipped with these devastating new rockets. The designersconstructors stated that the accuracy still is not perfect, that civilians can be also killed, not only military targets. These were rockets - the first to come into warfare. Stalin and his commanders decided not to use these effective That is long-range rockets! humanism!

While these countries who are teaching us now how to live – England and USA – bombed and liquidated the cities of Dresden and Hamburg, which had absolutely no military significance. More than 250,000 people were killed. Was this humanism?

Put into this category Vietnam, Laos, Korea, Hiroshima, Nagasaki and others. Americans were very effective in fighting civilians.

On the shoulders of Soviet Army was the brunt of the Second World War.

Then the question has to be asked: how can such an Army of victors, showing such heroism on the field of battle, give up its Motherland to the present temporary occupational clique? Very straightforwardly!

Truth is as straight as a stick. The Army was erocled and disseminated from within, and sold out, as all of us were sold out!

The beginning took place under Khrushchev - the top brass, which was replaced, reshuffled, demoted, liquidated, transferred or retired began to distance itself from the common soldier "below". Stagnation in the army spread, robbery is an epidemic, which is allowed to go on without any disciplinary actions being taken, like it would in any army; aging of officers corpse under the excuse "not enough of new recruits". Political training is practically non-existent. Afghanistan tragedy produced the use of narcotics in the Army which became an epidemic. The USSR was asked many times by the duly elected Afghanistan Republic for help under the Mutual Treaty that we had with that country, having lived in peace for over 100 years.

A special campaign is started by the so-called "intelligentsia" against our Soviet Army, calling for disbanding the Red Army altogether. False accusations that "children of leaders" are not fighting, like that of Stalin's son – which is a well known fact that he was shot by the Germans even though Germans offered to give up Stalin's son for their own Marshal. The moral of

the army became so low that they did not know or were not told as to who they are defending and for what reasons.

Then the process "perestroika" started. Agents of influence from the West "theoretical intelligentsia section" started a massive campaign in order to undermine, discredit the Soviet Army through their radio broadcasts daily in close to 36 different languages, mass propaganda through the press that was subverted by the Gorbachev clique to support this anti-Army campaign. This campaign was well thought out, well planned like: "Tbilisi, Rust, South Korean Boeing episode when the plane was shot down (everyone now admits it was on a spying mission - Editors) and other events. Gorbachev starts the final process of eliminating any dedicated officers to Soviet rule. Moral terror is unleashed against new recruits and the recruits and the population are being isolated from each other. The edict by Gorbachev was that the "army has no place in politics". These "Agents of Influence" show that they are still afraid about their own skins. Covertly they begin to promote, enhance the prestige of their "quiet Commanders" - as Dudayev as an example of Chechniya; part of the latest newest armaments are taken off the lists and mothballed; other technical innovative armaments sold by the top brass to different illegal bands and nationalists. The KGB somehow is very quiet while this is going on - which is now evident that the top brass of KGB was replaced with loyal servants of Gorbachev and Yeltsin.

The full process of "depoliticization" of the army proceeds with speed as proposed by Yeltsin and Rutskoi. History of

the Soviet Army is coming to an end. Sold out by its top command, the army starts to break up into sections, into separate armies, into local regions, etc., etc. Generals, officers, sergeants are made to swear allegiance to different "countries", such as Russia, Ukraine, Tadzhikistan, etc. Flags are changed, colours are changed.

What do we have today? Our great army is in countless pieces. The army is not in any position to save the country or to even save itself. The powers that be now have also not been sleeping ... they have organized their own "personal" army such as OMON and Presidential Guard which is practically just as numerous as the regular army!

Foreign agents are hovering in every division, every "sovereign Army" all over the former Soviet Union. They do not even bother to hide themselves, since they are "observers", "advisors", as they were in Vietnam and other countries that USA has invaded so often.

Anti-peoples government have placed the former Soviet Army on its knees before their across-theocean masters. They are now agitating one section of the army against another ... thus the old saying of "divide and rule" is very apropo now. The Aviation Arm of Soviet Army, organized to defend the people, are now bombing our own people and cities. It is a laugh to think that the present "Ukrainian Army" would be able to defend Ukraine! We all know that the present leaders of Ukraine are not worried about being attacked by Russia or others, they can always come to terms with them ... these present leaders are worried about only one enemy - their own people.

When an army is bought and serves for money, they will have

no hesitation to shoot at their own people. History has proven this over and over again.

Somehow the bourgeosie think that having organized such an army that they will be able to sleep peacefully. The people will not rest, they are organizing, they are becoming aware as to what is being prepared for them. Now or later, this regime will be toppled and thrown out. The Army still will be heard from.

Therefore, it is necessary to carry on the propaganda and organizational work among the Army recruits, officers and associations. This is the task of the All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks.

Bolsheviks already know how to work among the Army. Regarding the punitive detachment of the present clique in power, like "OMON" or the "National Guard", we must isolate them from the rest and from within, and make the truth known to the rank and file members as to who they are and what they are forced to become.

These punitive detachments will never be able to submerge, liquidate or stop the history of the glorious Soviet Army from the annals of history!

Sooner than later, the working people will again become masters in our own home, and defending them will be our worker-farmer Red Army.

WHO IS BEHIND THE RELIGIOUS CULTS IN RUSSIA?

The campaign to undermine Socialism, break up the Soviet Union, establish capitalism and subvert the Soviet people into a pool of cheap labour and a supplier of raw materials, takes on many forms of subversion, trickery, outright involvement of transnational corporate power and the International Monetary Fund. The latest form of subversion is the growth of "Religious Cults"!

Gathering material for this column, I perused many newspapers, articles and statements from different sources and here's what comes to light in this sordid, secret and covert operation that has its origins in the different religious orders of Western countries.

There are over 1,500 new religions operating now in Russia alone, not counting the other former Soviet Republics. All these religions sprang up in the last 3 years, and all of them are imports from both the West and East.

It seems, if we are to believe the newspapers, that millions of people are caught up in the fervor of these mystical sects. What comes through very clearly in these articles is that Yeltsin's regime is not doing very much to stop these cults from kidnapping people, brainwashing them, making them steal, rob and give away the property that they might have. There is evidence of

torture, beatings, deprivations, terror and actual deaths performed by the leadership of these cults.

The question that begs to be asked is this: "If the Western reporters and Western religious agencies are able to find these things out, how can it be possible for the Russian law enforcement agencies not to know that these groups exist or that they kidnap, brutalize and rob?" OR ... they know, and actually promote these groups in order to prevent unity of actions against the present intolerable conditions that the present traitorous regime has inflicted upon the people?

There is also very hard evidence that these cults are inter-connected with the Japanese Aum Shinrikyo cult which gassed people on Tokyo subway. This cult has attracted over 30,000 people in Russia – actually more than in Japan. They have financial and logistic support as we reported in the last issue of Northstar Compass.

These cults advertise openly, pay big money to the privatized newspapers in their agitational work. They use TV, Radio and booklets by the millions that are printed OUTSIDE the country and given out all over the former USSR.

The cult "Moonies" and the "Unification Church" boast that they have over 50,000 trained teachers spread across Russia, giving to schools over 200,000 books, all published on glossy stock, hard cover, four colour illustrations and all printed in the WEST!

Not only are these cults doing their religious and cult subversion, they are actually owning large properties in Russia, operating soup kitchens, medical facilities and orphanages!

The usual statement by the Yeltsin's government is that "we cannot crack down on these groups *since this would hamper the religious expression of its members".

These sects have connections to Yeltsin's government. Protests by the people whose children were kidnapped, whose property was grabbed by these cults, come to a dead end ... the authorities will not do anything or the militia. These parents, relatives are told that: "it's your affair, you find the solution"!

There is bribery by the leadership of these groups, right to the central Russian government.

According to sources, it was revealed that the "Moonie" textbook, "Inner World of a Soldier" was ordered in thousands by the Russian defence minister for the Army! The actual presence of Russian military hardware in the cult's possession in Japan, (Aum Shinrikyo) has raised questions as to the close connections and cooperation.

Russian members of Parliament are bought by the big money cults, thus making any potential laws that would curb these activities very unlikely.

There are thousands of members of these cults that disappear from life every year! What happens to them? The police will not do anything in order to find these missing people. Who gives the order from the top to ignore these events?

A statement is made that "With Socialism gone, a vacuum was created and these cults stepped in".

This statement is too coy, too self-serving, masked to deceive the people.

There is a DEFINITE link to the dismemberment of the USSR and the promotion of these cults. Its aim is to erase by whatever means they can, any idea of Socialism, of the rebirth of the Soviet Union and the role of Communists in this resurrection.

After a person is recruited into these cults, drugs are the order of the day, prostitution, semi-starvation. Isolated from their families, some simply vanish, while others become hobos wandering the streets, railway stations, penniless and prime targets for murder, rape. This gives authorities the right to arrest them, put them away ... thus solving the problem, but not preventing the problem from happening.

THIS IS OBVIOUSLY A POLICY FROM THE TOP!

Many of these publications come to the conclusion that this phenomena is "more of a business than a spiritual crusade".

<u>DEAR READER</u>: The above was gathered from reliable newspapers, both in Canada, USA and Britain – all of them are anti-Socialist and of course, anti-Soviet to the core. But they reported the situation as it is.

To operate these cults in a foreign country, you need, first of all, people who already are trained in the Russian language; in mind-bending techniques and with plenty of money to operate. These cults have property, logistics, source of printed materials from the West or East, plus the time to train their converts and to spread far and wide across the Russian Republic.

Anyone with any sense of understanding knows that this is not possible without fantastic financial sources to help them in their work.

A fact that is an "open secret" is that millions upon millions of Bibles are sent to the former Soviet Union ... from Canada, USA, Britain, France and Germany.

AGAIN, WE ASK THE QUESTION – WHERE IS THIS HELP COMING FROM?

Imperialism, through its secret services, plus the help of their own Churches, Synagogues, are the people that are behind this avalanche of subversion against the Soviet people and their belief in Socialism!

Does this not remind you of the early days of America and Canada,, when the Jesuits accompanied the conquerors, with one hand on the sword and the other on the Bible, in order to bring "Christianity" to these "heathens", while at the same time, murdering them, taking their lands away, practicing genocide and eliminating the culture of these native peoples!

Of course, these modern "Jesuits and Conquistadors" have learned new techniques, more insidious and sublime than the sword ... but with a more devastating effect.

I wonder whether Kohl, Clinton, Chretien and other "Western leaders", while having cocktails with Yeltsin, did they ever mention this terrible tragedy? OR ... whether Yeltsin over his 300 ounces of Vodka, ever asked Clinton about the plight of American native peoples, or Chretien about the sorry plight and economic conditions of Canadian native peoples?

I also wonder whether any Minister or Priest of a Church in Canada or the USA, ever preached a sermon about these cults in Russia and how they are operating against the teachings of Christ?

Cults come and go, but Socialist ideas will live on forever. Time is coming soon when these leaders, who are promoting and financing these cults, will be brought to justice!

"THE MOLOTOV-RIBBENTROP PACT"

There are many bourgeois misconceptions about the Second World War; but two are particularly important to combat. One is that Stalin was "unaware of the likelihood of attack" and was "taken by surprise". The other is that the Molotov-Ribbentrop Pact was an act of treason by Stalin, against the international working class. The

two misconceptions are linked essential lies perpetuated by bourgeois historians to falsify history.

Firstly, Stalin was well aware that the biggest danger to world peace was German and Japanese imperialism. In fact, Stalin is on record as saying to Antony Eden, in Moscow, that the situation was more dangerous than 1913:

"Eden ... saw the international situation as worrying but not hopeless. Stalin however pointed out that he saw the situation more serious than in 1913. When Eden asked why this was so, Stalin replied that in 1913, there had only been one seat of war – Germany, whereas now, there were two – Germany and Japan." (cited from Archives: Dokumenty vnesnei politiki SSSR Vol. XVIII, p. 247, by: Fyodor Volkov in "Secrets from Whitehall and Downing Street"; Moscow, 1980, p. 231.)

In fact even earlier, Stalin had pointed out the danger emanating from the West:

"We are 50 or 100 years behind the advanced countries. We must make good this distance in ten years. Either we do it, or we shall go under." (J.V. Stalin: "The Tasks of the Business Executive", in "Works", Volume 13; Moscow, 1955, p. 41.)

It was this understanding that informed the Stalin-led attack on the Bukharinite Right Deviation:

"Do you think we can achieve the final victory of socialism in our country so long as this contradiction exists? What has to be done to end this contradiction? To end it, we must overtake and outstrip the advanced technology of the developed capitalist countries ... outstrip and overtake these countries technically economically. Either we do this, or we shall be forced to the wall." (J.V. Stalin: "Industrialisation and the Right Deviation (1928)", "Works", Vol. 11, 1954, p. 259.)

And why did Stalin see this? Because of the inevitability of the capitalist crisis of over-production leading on to the re-division of the war:

"The continuing world crisis ...
It is not surprising that this is the most severe of all the crises that have taken place ... whereas in the capitalist countries, feverish preparations are in progress for a new war, for a new re-division of

the world and spheres of influence." (J.V. Stalin, "Report at the 17th Party Congress on the Work of the Central Committee of the CPSU[B]; Jan. 26th, 1934.)

Therefore, Stalin with Molotov and Zhadanov tried to forge principled alliances. Hitler's ambitions on Russia were known:

"We National Socialists consciously draw a line beneath the foreign policy tendency of our pre-war period ... We stop the endless German movement to the South and West, and turn our gaze towards the land in the East ... If we speak of soil in Europe today, we can primarily have in mind only Russia." (A. Hitler, "Mein Kampf"; London, 1984, p. 598, 604.)

But the natural allies against German revanchist fascism would have been Britain, France and the USA. Unfortunately, the majority of the ruling classes of these countries were also consumed with desire to destroy the USSR. The majority factions of these ruling classes (Neville Chamberlain in the UK and Edouard Dualardier in France) were of the opinion to "appease" Hitler to drive him towards Russia first. To this end, they allowed a shameless policy of rapid re-armament of Germany and turning a blind eye to Hitler. As Stalin said to the 18th Congress of the CPSU in March 1939:

"England, France and the USA ... draw back and retreat, making concession after concession to the aggressors ... without the least attempt at resistance, and even with a certain amount of connivance ... How is it ...? ... The policy of non-intervention reveals an eagerness, a desire ... not to hinder Germany say ... from embroiling herself in a war with the Soviet Union ... One might think that the districts of

Czechoslovakia were yielded to Germany as the price of an undertaking to launch war on the Soviet Union." (J.V. Stalin: "Works", Vol. 14; London, 1978, pp. 363-367.)

This tactic of British and French imperialism was further exposed by constant spurning of the USSR calls for a collective security pact. Lloyd George (Liberal party) made a speech in the UK Parliament upbraiding Chamberlain for making a unilateral guarantee to Poland without any talks with the USSR. Under pressure, the Government agreed to send a delegation to Moscow. However, it was sent by very slow sea and rail (not air); and with secret instruction to - "Go very slowly with the conversations". (Documents British Foreign Policy, 3rd Series, Vol. 6; London, 1953, Appendix 5, p. 763.)

The real intent was clear – the British and French had no intention to secure a collective security agreement. Moreover, Chamberlain was secretly negotiating for a military alliance with Germany; thereby threatening the USSR with a Four power enemy. Sir Neville Henderson, British Ambassador in Berlin, reported to Lord Halifax (August 29th, 1939) a conversation with Hitler and Ribbentrop:

"Herr von Ribbentrop asked me whether I could guarantee that the PM could carry the country with him in policy of friendship with Germany ... Her Hitler asked whether England would be willing to accept an alliance with Germany. I said speaking personally, I did not exclude such a possibility." (Documents Concerning German-Polish Relations and the Outbreak of Hostilities between Great Britain and Germany on Sept. 3rd, 1939" [Cmd. 6106]; London, 1939, p. 130.)

It was this that prompted the brilliant coup of the Molotov Ribbentrop Pact. This spiked the guns of the British and French collusionists. But it also delayed the inevitable onset of war by enough time to allow Stalin and the party to move the factories East of the Urals and to gear up for the war.

Even virulent anti-Soviets such as historian E.H. Carr admit that:

"The Chamberlain Government ... as a defender of capitalism ... refused to enter into an alliance with the USSR against Germany ... In the Pact of August 23rd, 1939, they [The USSR] secured: (a) a breathing space of immunity from attack; (b) German assistance in mitigating Japanese pressure in the Far East; (c) German agreement to the establishment of an advanced defensive bastion beyond the existing Soviet frontiers in Eastern Europe; it was significant that the bastion was and could only be a line of defence against potential German attack, the eventual prospect of which was never far absent from Soviet reckonings. But what most of all was achieved by the pact was the assurance that of the USSR had eventually to fight Hitler, the Western powers would already be involved." (Carr: "From Munich to Moscow: II"; "Soviet Studies", 1, No. 21949, p. 103.)

COMMEMORATES 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF VE DAY IN EUROPE

On Sunday, May 7th at the Friendship House in Toronto, members of the Canadian Friends of Soviet People and readers of the publication Northstar Compass came in order to remember and honour the more than 50,000,000 people who perished so that we may live. More than 27,000,000 Soviet people died in order that mankind could be saved from fascism.

While people were gathering, stirring music of those days was heard in the hall.

The Anniversary Meeting was opened by Michael Lucas, President of CFSP and Editor of Northstar Compass. His remarks are published below.

As the playing of Last Post was heard, two veterans with their medals on their chests, Dave Roberts and Bob McNicoll, carried a wreath and placed it on the podium, while Doug Adams, as Chair, asked the people to stand for two minutes of silence, in homage to our dead comrades who gave their lives for humanity.

Doug Adams, veteran of Royal Canadian Navy, spoke about the role of the RCN in the war and of his experiences.

Michael Lucas was asked to

read a cable resolution to be sent to Mayor Luzhkov of Moscow as a protest for denying the Soviet people a permit to hold a May 9th demonstration, celebrating the 50th Anniversary of the Great Patriotic War. The resolution was passed unanimously. Resolution is published elsewhere.

Joe Glenn, Veteran of the International Brigades – Mackenzie-Papineau Battalion of Canada, spoke upon his involvement in fighting fascist dictator Franco of Spain in the Spanish Civil War. We publish his remarks below.

Two resolutions of protest were adopted and sent to the U.S. Senate Foreign Relations Committee and the House International Relations Committee, protesting the upcoming law that will put an even tighter embargo against Cuba.

Robert McNicoll, veteran of the Royal Navy of Britain, spoke about the causes of the World War Two and those in the West who were responsible in abetting Hitler, besides, he mentioned the war against fascism started when Italy invaded Abyssinia.

Dave Roberts, veteran of the Canadian Airforce, spoke movingly about the losses caused by the war of his comrades, while Andy Durovecz, veteran and member of the Canadian secret service agents who were dropped behind enemy lines in order to help with the partisan and the resistance movements, spoke about this aspect. His book will be off the press shortly about his years in this dangerous mission that he was involved with.

Dorothy Roberts reminisced about the war efforts at the home front and the work that the women of Canada performed.

Len Waga, born in Poland, told about his experiences when he was in concentration camps, ghetto uprising in Poland and appealed to the members present to always remember that it was the Red Army that saved mankind from fascism.

Michael Lucas reported about organizations that co-sponsored this event and sent greetings and financial contributions. The following organizations were mentioned:

After the official program was over, a video called, "Spring of Victory" about the last days of World War II and the storming of the Reichtag in Berlin by the Red Army and the victory celebrations in Moscow, Leningrad and other Soviet cities on May 9, 1945, was shown.

The following part of the event was dedicated to the memory of one of our members, activist and founder of the publication Northstar Compass, the late Bill Tyconik. We publish the text below of the words that were spoken by Michael Lucas, President on behalf of all those that gathered at the Friendship House.

Dear Friends:

Today's event is dedicated to the 50th Anniversary of the defeat of fascism. We have tried, in our small way and meagre means, to present to our readers some aspects of the war, its beginnings, and the aftermath ... in order that those of us that still remember the war, would be able to pass on this information to their children and grandchildren.

Fifty years is a long time to remember these horrors, and as humans, we tend to forget or try to remove those memories from our minds. After all, people must live and look ahead to a brighter future. But those of us that are prone to this should also remember that if we DO NOT know the past, neither will we be able to be prepared for the FUTURE!

Those of us that took part in this struggle remember those who died so that we may live. Therefore, it is necessary now, on this 50th Anniversary, to again try and open up these pages of history when there are still people who were part of this terrible tragedy, that can remember, that can tell others of the horrors and above all, of the causes that cost humanity over 50,000,000 lives!

Confusion, lies, fabrications and outright sabotage of the facts of World War Two are meant specifically to erase from future generations the sacrifices that were made by our fathers, grandfathers, grandmothers, sisters and brothers.

But facts come to life, like flowers after April showers ... they cannot be hidden forever. We will publish added facts gathered from a well documented, well written book called "War of Liberation" written by our friend and reader of Northstar Compass in England, author Ernie Trory. In our next issue, we shall write an overview of this excellent 396 page book so that our readers would be able to order this book through Northstar Compass.

As we all know, the West – including Churchill and Roosevelt – and their governments hoped that Russia and Germany would bleed each other dry, thus opening the area for Western powers to grab the industries and establish their economic zones of ownership.

There was and unfortunately there still is the belief by even some progressives and communists that Stalin was responsible for the "purges" during the period before the war and thus, he weakened the readiness by eliminating officers who would have been able to prepare the Soviet Union for the German onslaught. This belief is prevalent today, fanned by anti-Sovieteers both outside and inside the Soviet Union.

Here are quotes from Ernie Trory's book:

"Roosevelt had, of course, been well briefed on the strength of the Soviet Armed Forces and the loyalty of the peoples of the USSR to their government by Joseph E. Davies, US Ambassador to Moscow from 1936 to 1938 who wrote in a letter to President Roosevelt on January 18, 1939 the following:

'It is my opinion that both the Soviet government and its army are a great deal stronger than is generally recognized in certain European quarters ... in the event of so dire a calamity as an international conflict between THE TOTALITARIAN AND THE DEMOCRATIC STATES, (our emphasis - Editor) the Soviet government is, in my opinion, a much more powerful factor than the reactionaries of Europe concede, and might be of the greatest value.'

Regarding the preparedness of the USSR and Stalin for a war with Germany, Davies wrote when he saw '6,000 civilian partisans' march

on May Day on Red Square in 1937. Davies said:

'This is a preview of an organized guerrilla bands which the Red Army will leave behind German lines to harass and sabotage German communications and supplies.'

He also warned Roosevelt, President of United States not to be taken in by Western propaganda about the treason trials that had taken place in the Soviet Union during the 1930's, including the so-called "purges" of Red Army Generals.'

Davies was later to write the following:

'Passing through Chicago on a speaking tour, I was asked - "What about Fifth Column in Russia?" I replied that there were none. I was correct and I brooded over that question. Being an observer on behalf of the USA at these trials, I knew and saw with my own eyes that the fifth column that was on trial were guilty beyond a shadow of a doubt. It was a fact that Hitler did not from the beginning find any quislings or fifth column to bank on, as he had found in Norway, Croatia, Czechoslovakia, Belgium, France, Hungary, Rumania, etc.'

Further, Davies wrote:

'As I ruminated over this situation, I suddenly saw the picture as I should have seen at that time. The story of the so-called treason trials of 1937-38 which I attended and listened to. In re-examining my records of the events, I found practically every device of German fifth columnist activity, as we now know it, was disclosed and laid bare by the confessions and testimony elicited voluntarily at these trials of self-confessed "Quislings" in Russia'."

This was said by an anti-Sovieteer, representing the ruling class of USA and not known to have any SYMPATHY for the Soviet people, socialism or the CPSU! How can you equate these words with volumes of propaganda that was written since those trials and since World War II? Or is it the case of the BIG LIE – the bigger the lie, the more people tend to believe you?

Time has certainly come, on this 50th Anniversary of the Great Patriotic War, for the so-called 'friends of socialism', Marxists-Leninists, Communists of all colours to see the truth. There is irrefutable proof available which point to this fact! OR ... is it not in the interests of these 'Sovietologists' to face the facts? After all, facts cannot always be hidden away, subverted or presented in 'Marxist phraseology'!

Time has surely arrived to give credit where credit is due. More than 27,000,000 people did not give their lives for a system that they hated! Again, we repeat ... over 50,000,000 died to defeat fascism, Nazism and militarism. Did they all die in vain?

Let the present would-be 'rulers' of the world, no matter under what kind of flag they may hide, remember that history does not forget or forgive!

Let us remember and honour our dead, who died in order that we may all live!

MAY THEY FOREVER BE REMEMBERED!

Dear Friends:

You have gathered today to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the defeat of Hitler and Fascism. We, veterans of the Mackenzie Papineau Battalion, also celebrate the event but we reflect also that had the civil war in Spain ended with the opposite results, the war in Europe may not have occurred or at least, been delayed for a number of years.

At the time of our withdrawal from Spain, many of our members

predicted there would be a general war in Europe within six months. In this regard, we contend that the International Brigades and the Spanish people were the first ones to fight against the Nazi Fascist armies. Many Mac-Pap veterans re-enlisted to fight again and were ostracized originally by their commanders.

Today, we vets are fewer in number and perhaps less than 18 are active and less than half of that number fully mobile.

We must be alert to the fact Nazi and Fascist movements are not dead. From reports heard and visions on TV, it has resurrected in Germany and other European states. The bombing at Oklahoma City and subsequent disclosures show fascism has created so-called militia volunteer groups in the United States who mouth and practise the actions of the once powerful Nazi Germany. They boast they have organizations in 40 of the 50 states and in Canada.

Their hate literature is evident. Even if the statements are grossly exaggerated, it behooves ourselves to be aware of the dangers to society these groups pose.

At this time, I would like to announce there will be an unveiling of Plaque at Queen's Park and dedication ceremony commemorating the Mac-Paps involvement in Spain on June 4th at 10:00 a.m. The plaque originated by the Historic Sites Monument Board Of Canada. It will be mounted on a rock brought over from the battlefields of Spain by our support organization - the "Association of Veterans and Friends of the Mackenzie-Papineau Battalion". The location is about 100 yards south-west of the legislative building and a short distance from the statue of William Lion Mackenzie.

In closing, I would like to inform those present who have not had the opportunity to read our book "Canadian Volunteers Spain 1931-1939" by William Beeching, I have quite a number of copies available for a small consideration.

WILLIAM (BILL) TYCONIK

The death of William (Bill) Tyconik, Sunday April 16th at the age of 87, has deprived his family, the Canadian Friends of the Soviet Union and the Editorial Board of Northstar Compass of a strong, warm, devoted and dedicated companion and Comrade. Bom of Ukrainian immigrant parents in the inter-Lake area of Manitoba, his life was devoted first to his family and in equal measure, to interests and needs of his fellow humans.



It was this quality that led him to membership and activity in the Canada-USSR Association many years ago and that placed him voluntarily on the Executive of the Canadian Friends of the Soviet People and Northstar Compass Editorial Board. There, his calm, thoughtful council and expressions of opinion, frequently brought resolution of differences that arose and wise direction in the development of our activities and projections. No one was more respected and carefully listened to in the regular Thursday morning meetings of the Board, that have

taken place since its formation in mid 1992.

The Editorial Board of Northstar Compass paid tribute to Brother and Comrade Bill Tyconik when they stated: "Bill was a respected and effective working man all of his long and productive life. He cared for and nurtured his family, and beyond that, never lost sight of the struggles and sacrifices in the long unending class war to achieve freedom and advances for his fellow workers. He was a model of dedication and tireless activity in all its phases: trade union, political, social and in day-to-day practical work."

The Canadian Council of CFSU and the Editorial Board of Northstar Compass extends our deepest condolences to his surviving family. To the International friends and supporters of our activity, we want them to know something of this dedicated and tireless friend they may never have known about, but who extended himself with a full heart to his very last days, as an internationalist and supporter of international friendship and solidarity with all peoples and of a world at peace.

We salute his memory and take his life as an example for ourselves and for all who have had the benefit of his courageous, unfaltering work.

A funeral service was held Saturday April 22nd in Toronto. Members of his family and David Clark, Business Agent of the Steamfitters & Plumbers' Union – Local 46 eulogized his life. Among the mourners were many old acquaintances, friends and comrades. Some of these also recalled Michael Tyconik, his brother, who likewise distinguished himself in the ongoing struggles of his people. He deceased some years ago, also at an advanced age during which he never faltered in his devotion and dedication to the

principles for which they both fought and gave their lives.

At the end of the service and eulogy, Harold Bates, long time friend and designated Poet Laureate of the Northstar Compass read a special short poem in memory of "Bill":

Working with the people in mind.

One of the last requests that Bill Tyconik made to me at the last Council and Editorial Meeting before he passed way was, that I should list the countries that the USA has invaded since the time of the Second World War. He wanted the young readers to know, on this the 50th Anniversary of the Victory in World War II the terrible legacy that the United States through its transnational corporations has left for humanity.

Fulfilling Bill's request, here are facts gathered from a book called "The Ruses for War" by John Quigly.

"The United States is unique in maintaining abroad a large establishment of military basis, battleships. Our companies are everywhere,

Since he had come from a poor country, he also was knowledgeable and interested in World Affairs and believed that people had their rights, especially the poor.

He has seen many deaths, marriages, births, and illnesses of his family members and friends, and lived through hardships of war and hunger in his 94 years. He was a family man who enjoyed having his children, grandchildren and great grandchildren around him and was very proud of their accomplishments. There was many a time when he enthralled them with his stories of the "old country" and the time spent in the Czech army and when he worked in Argentina. These stories will stay with us forever. He also was independent for as long as he could be, as he drove his car until the winter of 1992. John passed away April 4, 1995, at the age of 94 years and 3 1/2 months.

Your Holiness:

I followed with great interest and inspiration your recent tour of Asia and Africa. Your strong will and your miraculous endurance once more left a memorable trail as you consoled millions of hearts, many of whom travelled long distances to meet you and wish you well.

Your Holiness, please allow me to introduce myself. My name is George G. Legebokoff. I was born in Canada of Russian Doukhobor ancestry and grew up in a communal Doukhobor farming settlement in Saskatchewan, in Catholic surroundings. What has prompted me to write this letter is Your Holiness's recent tour through depressed and poverty stricken areas, under most severe climatic conditions, promoting peace and understanding.

Coincidentally, Your Holiness and I were bom on the same day in the same year and, like you, I have made building a peaceful world my lifelong endeavour. Yet, the increased production of weapons and threats of new wars continue to escalate despite the efforts of some countries to legislate gun controls.

June 29, 1995 will mark the centenary of the day our Doukhobor ancestors emphatically told the Czar of Russia, "We shall bear no arms!". Guns are for killing people, a mortal sin against God. Following this refusal to bear arms on June 29, 1895, the villagers assembled and, with songs and prayers, devoutly stacked all the guns and set them ablaze.

The Czar immediately ordered their arrest, which was done and followed with beatings, exile to Siberia and incarceration. What was the crime? Refusing to bear arms, to kill! My grandfather was one who survived the Czar's exile and lived to tell his grandchildren of his incarceration and brutal torture. He bore visible wounds where strips of human hide were carved from the flesh.

In the late 1890's, under the auspices and initiative of Lev N. Tolstoy and the direct support and endorsation of Queen Victoria, the initial migration of several thousand Doukhobors came to Canada with the promise of immunity from bearing arms and military service.

Today, 100 years later in our progressive and technological society, we who refuse to bear arms continue to be victims incarcerated in a world controlled by munitions cartels. CUBANS SUFFER BUT SURVIVEU.S. BLOCKADE

Did you ever wonder why: No cruise ship stops in Cuba, the most important island in the Caribbean? Or why Cuban holidays are so inexpensive?

The answer is the U.S. blockade. It is the fundamental cause of the current crisis in Cuba today.

The blockade was implemented in 1961-62 by the Eisenhower and Kennedy administrations in an attempt to strangle the Cuban revolution. Before the revolution, 90 percent of Cuba's trade was with the U.S. The assumption in

Washington was the blockade would quickly destroy the revolution. Instead, Cuba established extensive economic relations with the Soviet Union and other socialist nations.

Over the next 30 years, Cuba withstood attempted invasion, destabilization, assassination and economic warfare. The country flourished, developing health care, education and other institutions that set a standard for developing countries.

The collapse of the Soviet Union and Eastern Europe between 1989-1991, caused an extremely sharp decline in Cuba's economy. Imports shrank from over \$8 billion in 1990 to \$1.7 billion in 1993. This resulted in severe shortages of not only food, medicine and other vital necessities, but also raw materials, spare parts and, most critically, fuel. This forced the Cuban government to adopt measures known as the "Special Period" in order to best utilize available resources.

In order to tighten the screws, or ratchet up the suffering, a bipartisan effort supported by both presidents Bush and Clinton, the Torricelli Bill - cynically misnamed the Cuban Democracy Act - became law October 1992, just days before the election. The Torricelli Law requires foreign subsidiaries of U.S. corporations to cease trade with Cuba. This trade, amounting to \$700 million in 1992, declined precipitously to under \$2 million in 1993. Eighty to 90 percent of this trade was in food and medicine. The Torricelli Law also forbids from U.S. ports any ship which calls on a Cuban port for a period of six months after the Cuban visit, under penalty of confiscation.

It should also be noted that the purpose of the blockade was never simply to stop all trade between Cuba and the U.S. Washington has actively sought, especially since the collapse of the Soviet Union, to disrupt and destroy economic relations between Cuba and other countries. The sponsor of the U.S. law, Congressman Robert Torricelli is again calling on pressure to be applied against Canada for trading with Cuba. The Cubans estimate that as a result of the Torricelli Law 90 percent of trade agreements made with businesses in third countries are cancelled due to U.S. economic and political pressure.

In spite of the horrendous obstacles thrown up by the blockade, the Cuban people are still being fed, though barely, their education system is still functioning and fully socially supported. Cuba's health care system continues to function, as evidenced by an infant mortality rate almost equal to the U.S. average and much lower than most major U.S. cities.

I would ask: if Canada's economy had suffered the equivalent blows to what Cuba has suffered, what would finance minister Paul Martin's budget have looked like? Where would OHIP be and university tuition fees, etc.?
