#### AN EYE WITNESS IN MOSCOW REPORTS ...

October 9, 1993

There is great danger in sending you long letters under the present state of emergency and curfew. I am not sure of the safety of this letter. Here, you will find an issue of IZVESTIA, with my marks on articles which I regard as comparatively impartial, although the paper belongs to the so-called "democrats" and Zionists. The White House is practically a "Black House", both literally and in essence. The tanks, cannons and heavy machine-guns fired at it incessantly for many hours.

I was also under heavy machinegun fire from police armoured vehicles near "Ostantkino TV Tower", near where I live. The majority of the people killed were civilians and CHILDREN. The soldiers and OMON opened fire at apartment balconies where people came out to look at what was happening. The OMON fired at balconies filled with people, stating that there were snipers on them and that they saw something "trembling"! Whole apartment buildings were strafed.

The OMON beat everyone with clubs, they saw and swore at them – anyone that had the misfortune to be

near these sole iers. Some of the special OMON wore American-style camouflaged uniforms with "SPECIAL FORCES" (in English) on the upper part of their arms (near the shot der) like true occupiers!

Most of the OMON soldiers were brought from Siberia. They are descendents of Ukrainian Banderites, Quislings Polozai and Nazis who were exiled there after the Great Patriotic War. The so-called "police" army divisions I mentioned that took part in the punitive actions were

Kontemirov Tank and Taman Motorized Unit, Tula Airborne Division and OMON. The opponents (the members of the Supreme Soviet Deputies and their help – Ed.) had only small arms. But I disapproved of what they did. They had no possibility or strength to win and they acted stupidly and recklessly.

Now, Yeltsin wants to remove V. I. Lenin from the Mausoleum and close it up. Yeltsin banned 14 newspapers and patriotic organizations – Pravda, Sovietskaya Rossiya and Den plus other newspapers. He has charged the opposition. Anpilov, one of the resistance leaders, was arrested near Tula. Someone in the organization of the Communist Party betrayed him for 2 million rubles! Zyuganov is still at large.

Vladimir Shumeyko, who was the boss of Yakoubovsky, who is now in Toronto with millions of stolen dollars, is again the First Vice-Premier and Minister of Information of the Yeltsin's Government.

# EUROPEAN SECTION OF THE INTERNATIONAL COMMITTEE FOR THE RESTORATION OF THE SOVIET UNION

The events of the third and fourth of October in Moscow give us a picture, on one side, of the level of political consciousness of ever greater sections of Russian society who are in opposition to the Yeltsin's dictatorship and, on the other side, of the incapacity of the Executive to govern the country and control the Armed Forces. With the dissolution of the Supreme Soviet on the 21st of September was initiated a process of increasing activation of numerous

social sections who have been hardly affected by both inflation and institutionalized speculation. Furthermore, a question mark has arisen on a part of the social basis of the Yeltsin's regime. The Government is compromised with foreign interest in Russia as well as the local financial system which is characterized with the massive outflow of capital from Russia. This has further confirmed the anti-popular and anti-national character of Yeltsin who now sees his social base, such that shortly after celebrating the pyrrhic victory, members of the Government publicly went back on one of the fundamental principles of Yeltsin's politics - the theory of the necessity for shock therapy in economy.

We speak of a pyrrhic victory in the face of a badly organized and unarmed rival, and of a dictator who carried out a massacre of civilians. Yeltsin lost control over the Ministries of the Interior and Defense, his police organs were overwhelmed by the

surging of popular forces, the Army saw serious signs of internal dissension and revolt. Only the blood bath by the gate of Ostankino TV Tower where more than one hundred people killed as a result of indiscriminate firing, could save the regime from ruination. The more than a hundred bodies registered by the Director-General of Hospitals stand testimony to this. Moreover, according to a statement by the above mentioned organization, it is not possible to verify the existence of wounded or corpses originating from the House of the Soviets (White House). According to testimony of people present in the House of Soviets, the wounded were shot. Afterwards, the corpses were hidden. Yeltsin bathed in blood twice. Hundreds of civilians, for the most part unarmed, now heroes of the popular resistance, became victims of a massacre reflecting the importance of a demoralized dictator, incapable of governing but capable only of

robbing and killing.

On the eve of the 76th Anniversary of the Great October Revolution, we express our condolences for those who fell in the popular struggle against the Yeltsin's dictatorship. In their memory, let us raise the Red Flag of the Soviet State, the flag of the country of the workers in struggle.

The revindication of the Socialist Revolution of October is a revindication of Marxism-Leninism and Socialism as an historical imperative. We see in Yeltsin not only a national traitor and assassin. We see in Yeltsin the highest expression of bureaucratic treachery who reneged from Socialism and restored capitalism in the nation. Nevertheless, comrades, the traitor-bureaucrat has been converted into an impotent dictator.

demonstration and conference was not sent by the AUCPB and they were not invited to participate in this. There could be a provocation that might play into the hands of Yeltsin against the people. The National Salvation Front is not participating in this November 7th event, since they were also not invited. AUCPB is a member of the National Salvation Front.

- Communist Party of Russia, led by Zyuganov, is not in reality a party of communists, since it tries to curry favour with Yeltsin and their program is that of liberal bourgeoisie. Their actions are narrow and provocative.
- There's a great campaign against Lenin and Lenin Mausoleum, organized as if it's the "will of the people" for taking the body out and eliminating the Mausoleum altogether.
- Newspaper "Sovietskaya Rossija" was closed and Yeltsin demanded that the Editor be fired. The Editorial staff, workers went on strike and did not allow this to happen. It is a communist newspaper and the one that acts as the rallying point against Yeltsin.
- Yeltsin's decree closed "Pravda" and it still is not publishing. A tragic

course of events is taking place. Yeltsin managed to get rid of the Editor-inchief who was a real communist, replaced him with an anti-communist ... this was done with the help of the staff and other people that were already on the staff of Pravda. There is a great internal clash between the present ruling body at Pravda, with the help of Yeltsin of course and the Greek multi-millionaire who owns the Pravda newspaper now. HE wants the paper to remain "Pravda" while the present Yeltsin crowd want to change the name. So that the last remnant of Lenin's and Stalin's newspaper would be buried from the people's minds and memories.

- They will be sending us their newspapers and information through many different channels.

# EDITORIAL

# CANADA, THE WORLD, THE USSR, LOOKING FORWARD, HERE AND THERE ...

Three weeks following the massive and bloody gunnery assault in Moscow on the Russian Parliament, Constitution, High Court and the Russian and Soviet people by the blood stained dictator Yeltsin, the Canadian electorate smashed by ballot his chief political and financial supporter in the country ... the Brian Mulroney-Campbell Tory Government. Never in the history of the country has a ruling party been so thoroughly whipped out of power and dumped on the historical garbage pile. From a ruling 155 members elected to form that government, the Tories fell to an almost invisible 2 elected members on their arrogance - strewn path to oblivion.

The unutterable disgust of the Canadian people with the TNC, and Tri-Lateral Commission – guided Mulroney Government of "fawners before corporate finance capital" (when they were not involved in one or another scandalous or illegal activity), knew no bounds. And justifiably so ... for the caving-in and promotion of the sell-out of the country to the banking crowd, mainly centred in New York city. At any rate, the Tories were left, following the

October 25th vote, wheezing and gasping on the beach like some of the rusty oil tankers run aground by their slippery oil backers. The list of corporate-driven infamies, hobbling and destroying the real interests of the Canadian people, is too long a "roll call of disaster" to recount here. But obviously, the Canadian people were well acquainted with them.

Canadians have gained a "breathing space", a chance to "come up for air", if the Chretien Liberals can resist the immense economic and political pressures that will be thrust at them in order to force continuation of the Mulroney-Tri-Lateral-Commission financial and political road to the destruction of the country ... and the total control of the TNC's.

But we were forewarned of that pressure on the morning of October 26th, even before the new Government had clambered out of bed. The Toronto Globe & Mail, the pre-eminent and first supporter of all things TNC, and of the Mulroney disgrace, was already in full flight, posing as either the real or the 'wannabe' champion of the international financial community by midnight, October 25th, election day.

In a 50 column-inch piece, highlighted on the front page of their Business Section, and obviously written prior to the release of the election results to the Canadian public, the G & M writes under headlines, "International bond traders won't be bailing out a LIBERALIZED Canada", and "So Mr. Chretien, What's The Plan?", warned "This is your wake-up call FROM THE INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL COMMUNITY". (our emphasis - Ed.) The purpose obviously was to pass the word to their corporate readers on the "paths of righteousness, more profits, and economic and political control". Included in their warnings were outpourings and so-called analyses of

such items as trade, investment, credit ratings (of governments), production by industrial capital and hence, employment rates, the future of social programs, standards of life ... etc., all right down the transnational corporate plans that include "privatization", so-called "global restructuring", "interventionism" and where necessary ... as with the G-7 puppet Yeltsin; open fascist and military control.

Incidentally, the Globe & Mail (originally founded by Gold Mine Baron, Wm. Wright) was a prime supporter of the TNC foundling Mulroney, even when he was revealed in a "photo-op" recently, posing with Czar Boris like a pair of drunken roustabouts over dead wild pigs somebody had shot. The Globe "tastefully" withheld the photo. On the election results, their stance is clear ... they continue to support TNC capitalism, regardless of the results for Canada and Canadians. But as one rather grumpy voter said: "I feel better with Chretien there than Mulroney, but I don't know how much better. Maybe in a year, I can tell you". He was referring to the not exactly exemplary record of the Liberals in combating the hold of the monopolies over Canadians.

But while the Canadian voters might possibly have created at least some minor problems for the TNC's, the unswerving "Group-of-Seven" support for Yeltsin and Grachev were busily erecting a new Fascist state in Russia. No doubt they all enjoyed the "dedicated" attention of the CIA, the U.S. State Department and their Trilateral boss, Warren Christopher. While the bankers are perhaps not all that happy about all this, because we are sure they know that Fascism "is their court of final appeal" in order to expand and assure their world domination. However, we do not doubt David Rockerfeller felt they "had done what they had to do" to

protect their power and self, in true John Wayne Hollywood style! But an even more sinister "fifth column" appears to be emerging in Russia and the former USSR republics. Bluntly, according to information we have received, that fifth column operates WITHIN COMMUNIST PARTIES TO SOW DISTRUST, DIVERSION AND INNER CONFLICT SO THAT THE DIFFERENT COMMUNIST PARTIES CANNOT UNITE TO PRESENT A CLEAR CALL TO THE SOVIET PEOPLE TO DEFEND SOCIALISM AND THEIR IMMENSE ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF THE PAST 75 YEARS. WITHOUT THAT UNITY, THE PEOPLE WILL BE UNABLE TO THROW BACK THE HIDEOUS TNC SPONSORED DANGERS NOW CONFRONTING THEM. Given the past history of subversive and fifth column activities in the leadership of the CPSU, including Gorbachev, Yeltsin, Scheverdnadze, Alexander Yakovlev et al., a certain level of apathy, distrust and confusion is understandable. But that is not good enough, and should the TNC assault on the Soviet people be successful in establishing a fascist dictatorship, the results will reverberate around the world, including in Canada.

The immediate issue now would not seem to be Socialism in the former Soviets, although we believe that must stand beside and interwoven with the struggles there. The first priority appears to us to be the defence of democratic rights to keep the door open for people everywhere to advance to the type of socioeconomic and political system and state they wish to embrace. It is our profound and deepest hope and wish that a UNITED, FLAMING DEMAND FOR DEMOCRACY, THE DEFEAT OF THE TNC AGGRESSORS, AND A FUTURE OF SOCIALISM SHALL ARISE FROM THOSE WHO WILL UNITE TO LEAD SUCH A STRUGGLE. It may be unity in diversity ... but it must be unity! Failure of the Soviet people to respond will not only be to their cost, but to the cost of all the peoples of the world.

The Tri-Laterilists and their insane but well heeled and developed plans must be defeated. The key to victory for the people is a UNITED program that discards every remnant of chauvinism, national hatreds and that will mark the enemy of the people so clearly no progressive human being will stand in doubt or confusion. As happened before in history, such unity of working people and all democratic, progressive citizens and Governments everywhere can smash TNC sponsored Fascism, open the road to peaceful, democratic, and yes, Socialist development and a future for all generations to come. That is the challenge. That will be the future. "Workers of the World Unite, You have Nothing to Lose But Your Chains, YOU HAVE A WORLD TO WIN!" is not an idle dream. It is humanity's destiny! Get on Board! It is part time to place all our feet on that road of glory and freedom!

#### AN OPEN LETTER TO PRIME MINISTER OF CANADA

Dear Prime Minister Chretien:

On this the 76th Anniversary of the Great October Revolution, we ask your New Government to disassociate Canada from the Yeltsin dictatorship and the aid that Canada is rendering this regime.

The previous Canadian government was supporting the fascist terror in Russia. The target is anyone who doesn't want Russia's industrial wealth, which belonged to the working class, handed over to wealthy capitalists, including Canadian and transnational corporations.

On October 4-5, the U.S.-backed Yeltsin regime massacred hundreds of workers on the streets of Moscow and in the Parliament building.

Now, all elected bodies have been abolished. Working class parties and newspapers have been banned. Scores of working leaders have been jailed on trumped-up charges.

Canada seems to call this "democracy" and billions of dollars are promised in aid.

A cover-up is going on by Yeltsin. There is now irrefutable evidence that the real death toll is many hundreds or even a thousand. Many people are missing and still unaccounted for. The Director-General of Hospitals in Moscow stated that it is impossible to verify the existence of wounded or corpses, since the wounded were shot and their bodies went missing!

On October 15th, the pro-Yeltsin newspaper Komsomolskaya Pravda cited reports that hundreds of bodies of people killed in the Parliament building by Yeltsin's forces were "removed through underground passages and secretly cremated".

#### ON THE 76TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE GREAT OCTOBER SOCIALIST REVOLUTION

At dawn on June 22, 1941, the troops of NAZI Germany, crossed the Soviet frontier and invaded Soviet territory. This marked the beginning of the most savage war in the history of humankind. It demanded unsparing effort on the part of the Soviet people. It took a toll of many millions of lives and turned large areas of the Soviet country into deserts of devastation.

The attack on the Soviet Union was in accordance with Hitler's aim of world domination. It was his

intention, as proclaimed in his book "Mein Kamp", to save the world from Bolshevism. He believed that by destroying the U.S.S.R., he would wipe out the source of support for those countries which saw in the Soviet Union a beacon light in their struggle for freedom. He also hoped to gain possession of the enormous Soviet resources in order to continue his drive for world domination.

NAZI Germany had been frantically preparing for this war, ever since the German President Hindenburghadhanded power to the NAZIS by appointing Hitler as Chancellor of the Reich in early 1933.


In addition to the resources in the hands of Germany, resulting from the plunder of Europe, Germany's industries had been restored and developed by the powerful assistance

of the United States of America, as well as by the friendly aid of the Bank of England.

The western "democracies" hated the Soviet Union because of the successful building of Socialism. At the same time, fearing an attack from NAZI Germany, they used every diplomatic trick to turn the aggression of the fascists away from themselves, and to direct it eastward, against the U.S.S.R. (The duplicity on the part of the western "democracies" has been dealt with in the "NorthStar Compass", Volume 1, no. 2, of September, 1992. It will be further developed in future articles.)

The NAZIS had amassed an army of tremendous strength along the Soviet borders, from the Barents to the Black Seas. Before dawn on June 22, 1941, the sudden assault was

V. I. Lenin speaking to 2nd Congress of Bolsheviks




launched in the form of a massed air and artillery attack. The land forces then crossed the frontier into Soviet territory. The war for the total destruction of socialism, the dream of imperialism since the Great October Revolution of 1917 was now a reality. 190 divisions of troops, 50,000 pieces of artillery, 5,500 tanks and 5,000 aircraft attacked the Socialist country on a front of fifteen hundred kilometers.

The initial Soviet strategy was retreat. Lenin had taught that "One does not accept battle when to do so would be beneficial to the enemy". It is also an axiom of military science that an attacking force suffers losses at a ratio of 3 to 1.

In the early days of the war, while initiative remained with the enemy and while the overall tactics of the Soviet forces were based on strategic withdrawal, many army units and formations, on the initiative of local commanders, often engaged in successful counter-offensives. This was disconcerting to the NAZI Commanders who in previous campaigns, because of their overwhelming superiority of armour and air power, were not accustomed to encountering resistance from their victims on such a scale.

For example, the battle for Smolensk lasted for two months and the battle for Kiev continued for seventy-three days. The fighting at the approaches to Leningrad (which city, Hitler was going to take in a week), developed into a major battle which lasted for the duration of the siege and continued until the enemy was defeated and the city liberated after 900 days. It was the tactics of the Soviet army in the first year of the war that led Winston Churchill to write: "the Soviet army has clawed the guts out of the German Army".

Adding to the difficulties of the invaders was the role of partisan fighting organizations made up of



civilians in the occupied territories. These partisan groups disrupted communications behind the enemy lines. Thousands of NAZI convoys were destroyed, trains carrying supplies to the enemy were blown up, and enemy troops never knew when death could come from bullets, grenades of booby traps.

Many thousands of these anti-NAZI fighters were killed but their damage to the enemy was of inestimable value in the winning of the anti-fascist war.

The world was astounded by the tenacious resistance of the defenders of numerous cities, towns and fortresses. Who can say which was the most heroic? Many cities had conferred on them the title of "Hero City": The entire country was in fact, a Country of Heroes. Military experts everywhere said that according to all the laws of military science, the Soviet Army should by now have been defeated.; But this was a people's war, and the Soviet people, linked by ties of blood to their Socialist Motherland, did not know the meaning of surrender or defeat. In addition, the science of Marxism-Leninism embraces military science as an embodiment of the class struggle. The NAZI were to discover that they faced an army led by the finest military minds in the world.

At the frontier fortress of Brest, the garrison repelled enemy attacks for a whole month, although surrounded by the main body of the NAZI troops. The 25,000-strong garrison at the naval base on the Honko peninsula, guardian of the northern approaches to the Gulf of Finland, held out for 150 days. Theport of Odessa on the Black Sea, stopped 18 Rumanian and German divisions; Sailors, soldiers and townspeople defended the city from August 10 to October 16, 1941.

Despite major successes, the overall strategic plans of the NAZIS

failed. The enemy was forced to fight long, protracted battles which upset the enemy's timetable, disproved the fable of NAZI invincibility and proved that the "blitzkrieg" could be stalled. This led to a fundamental change in the course and outcome of the war.

As early as August 11, 1941, General Halder, the NAZI Chief of Staff, stated: "The general situation is revealing more and more clearly that we have under-estimated the Russian colossus. This applies to all aspects of the country's economy and general organization, to the means of communication, and in particular, to purely military matters."

This observation of the NAZI General Halder, was completely correct. The Communist Party, which had played the vanguard role in the organization of the building of Socialism, now, under the leadership of its Central Committee, changed its role to that of vanguard in the mobilization of the entire country in defence of the Socialist Motherland.

On June 30, 1941, the Central Committee of the Party, the Presidium of the Supreme Soviet, and the Council of Peoples' Commissars, adopted a joint decision to set up a State Defence Committee with Stalin at its head.

This Committee was an emergency organ in which all power was concentrated and the work of Government and military establishment, the Party and other organizations brought under one head.

A General Headquarters, or "STAVKA", was set up August 8.

Stalin was appointed Supreme Commander-in-Chief.

During the first six months of the war, approximately one million Communists joined the Red Army and Red Navy. One-third of the Central Committee of the Party was at the front. Prominent Party leaders, including Brezhnev, Bulganin, Voroshilov, Zhdanov, Ignatov, Kaluberzin, Kuznetsov, Manuilsky, Suslov, Kruschchev, and Schcherbakov, and many more too numerous to name, took an active part in troop control.

Those party workers who remained in the rear, through their organizational discipline and selfless dedication, spared no effort to ensure adequate supplies of food and weapons for the men at the front.

Placing the economy on a demanded wartime footing tremendous effort. Workers worked the maximum possible hours. Women, old age pensioners, boys and girls in their teens, took the places of the men at the front. Large scale industrial evacuation took place. Between July and November 1941, fifteen hundred industrial enterprises were evacuated to locations in the Volga areas, beyond the Ural mountains, in Siberia, Central Asia and Kazakhastan.

Here, the enterprises were re-assembled and were again in production within a month.

The party introduced the slogan: "Everything for the front!", "Everything for Victory".

## VIEWS FROM A SOVIET FRIEND:

# AN OPEN LETTER TO MY DEAR CANADIAN FRIENDS ...

A black raven is now destroying my Socialist Motherland. The Yeltsin clique has drowned in a sea of blood, sons of our Motherland who struggled for freedom and truth. An Army was thrown at the Russian Parliament to destroy it with Russian guns. Not even in fascist countries this has been seen to happen only rarely. During this, there is to be seen some solidarity among the patriotic forces, but unfortunately, there are many obstacles on this road to Unity.

I remember the sunny days or June 15–16, 1991 in the City of Odessa. Being optimistic about the fate of our socialist Motherland, into Odessa came delegates to the First All Ukrainian Conference of the Republic Society, "Unity for Leninism and communist ideals". Delegates were from all provinces of Ukraine, and guests from Povolzhia, Northern Caucausus and other parts of the Soviet Union. But, someone's hand was involved. The place of our meeting was to be the Palace of Culture – Lesia Ukrainka in Odessa. We were forced to try and meet at the offices of the Malinovski District Party Centre. Even there, we were barred from meeting, since events took place which made it impossible for the conference to take place. Then the conference had to be held near the Ocean coast. The weather was perfect, the sun and the sea breezes made our work more enthusiastic. In the evening in one of the large houses, the delegates proceeded to discuss and debate the future of our country.

I remember the poems read by the chairman of the Odessa chapter of Society "Unity", A. N. Mayorov. His poems were full of love for the Motherland, for socialism, for the Soviet Union. From Dnepropetrovsk, there was E. D. Ojyaperov whose speech and poems enthused the delegates. Productive were the discussions and reports by the present General Secretary of the AUCPB, Nina Andreeva.

On July 13–14 in the City of Minsk, there took place an All Union Conference of the Bolshevik Section

of the CPSU. The speeches and thoughts of the Bolsheviks stated the forthcoming catastrophe of the USSR and of the traitorous actions of Gorbachev. This was a more representative forum of true patriots, true communists-Bolsheviks. At this conference, there were hundreds of delegates from all parts of our Motherland.

But lightning struck! The Motherland underwent a revolution by Gorbachev-Yeltsin in August of 1991 which made very critical the further work of the democratic forces.

To power came "pseudo democrats".
The Communist Party was banned.
Motherland dismembered.

Nevertheless, the fight continued. You cannot strangle the people who knew the happiness of work and existence. On November 7–8, 1991, there took place the founding congress of the All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks.

With the first consolidation of the Bolsheviks in the country, there took place a formation of other communist, socialist, other parties and groupings. During this time, there took place in Byelorussia "Belovezhskoj Pusche", a congress of the workers-farmers Socialist Party with Bolsheviks program orientation. At this moment, there is taking place a formation of the Communist Party of Ukraine (Bolsheviks). In this regard, in Dnepropetrovsk, there is already established the Committee of the AUCPB.

On the basis of the former CPSU in the Ukraine, there are being established other parties that are called Socialist and Communist, but they're not Bolsheviks-Leninist in their program. Their program is not always to the point and not always geared to resolve the tragic consequences of the counterrevolution. Nevertheless, their birth is aimed at a progressive solution to creeping fascism. This is a sign of the magnetic pull of the ideals of socialism and communism. The logical conclusion is that these groups-parties, sooner or later, will unite.

The disunity among these groups in the revolutionary movement is not only not necessary but at this moment, extremely dangerous! What is the reason for these diverse tendencies? The question is very difficult. But I will try to tell you my own thoughts on this urgent task.

FIRST OPINION: No one

questions how the reality that the dismemberment of the USSR was through a path of treachery of its leaders - tools of world imperialism. This was well planned in detail, whose variants were tried not only once, but many times over the years. But previously, such ventures by imperialism were always defeated or thwarted in their planning stages. During the 1930's, these attempts were tried in open courts and sentences passed on the internal provocateurs and agents who sold out the part and the people. Now, the counter-revolution and their agents say that these enemies were "innocent victims of Stalinism".

But at this time, thanks to the clique of Gorbachev, Yeltsin, Shevernadze, Yakovlev and company, the attack was successful. In formulating the scheme and the scenario of undermining the USSR and the attacks on communism all over the world, Alan Dulles was a chief architect, and in our years, it was Carter, Reagan and Bush. These planners of subversion were of course not so naive as to believe that after the counter-revolution and the dismemberment of the USSR, the communist movement would just roll over and play dead. And it would also be naive for us to think that after the USSR collapsed that these provocateurs of Imperialism would just sit back with folded arms and wait the death of communist ideology. The US imperialists knew that with their help and financing, they would be able to find the internal separatists and provocateurs who, masquerading under communist phraseology and red banners, would be able to hide themselves in different communist-socialist parties and movements. Therefore, in looking at different parties and their leaders, it is necessary to be very careful and realistic, not looking at their "slogans" but looking and analyzing their actions. The insertion

of differences in the communist movements – is an enormous help to capitalism.

SECOND OPINION: growth and establishment of today's communist and socialist parties and groups is based on the remains of the CPSU. But this party, after its XX Congress, became more and more a conglomerate of different points of view - from Bolshevik-Leninists to Mensheviks and even anticommunists! (I am a member of the party over 30 years, and I know well what was the composition.) Into the party ranks, there came elements who were there as careerists, fortune seekers. The Communist Party was the ruling force! A paradox took place. The Ukrainian Parliament, the majority of its members were communists, but in 1991, these same "communists" banned the Communist Party of Ukraine! Can we believe in these organizations/parties, those that were born out of the CPSU?

THIRD OPINION: The motley political composition of former CPSU was reflected in the troubled road to socialism of Soviet people in the last 30 years after the death of Stalin. Wars, internal and external counter-revolution alwavs held our people in high tension. Therefore, after the Great Patriotic War and the rebuilding of our Motherland, the Party revisionists with its leader Kruschov promised the people an Utopian path to communism, and

many people believed this. Revisionism got a foothold and began to do its work.

The criticism of the "cult of J. V. Stalin" did unprecedented harm. In the whole world, the personal qualities of Stalin were unique. About this uniqueness, many leaders wrote-Churchill, Roosevelt and others. (To think about this, why do not the world leaders write about the uniqueness of Gorbachev or Yeltsin?) Not even their foreign admirers and helpers! Stalin, in bitter battles with the enemies of Lenin, saved Leninism, promoted the works of Lenin among the Soviet people, and led the country from backwardness to the top position in the world.

Anti-communists well knew, if they could break away the people from the teachings of Stalin, the theory of communism will become faceless. World-wide criticism started of the "cult of Stalin". In place of studying the Marxism of Lenin and Stalin, the materials that were produced were out of context. Paragraphs, observations that could have been said by anyone were published. The theory and practice of Lenin was buried under pseudophraseology and became just words without meaning. In place of the real Lenin, they produced an idol, a stone image. Now, they are trying to throw all of this in the river of history.

How can we give rebirth to a monolithic communist party under these complex problems and in this situation? To accomplish this, we have to make a detailed study of our history. We have to categorically reject "anti-Stalinism" which in essence now means anti-communism. In the first place, we have to separate the real dedicated communist from the restorer of bourgeois society. This could be done by looking at his or her attitude to private property. Only peoples social property can save mankind from exploitation of man by

man and guarantee the path towards socialism. This was shown by the might of the USSR before the counterrevolution came on the scene. To accomplish this can be done only by the working class, in unity with the farmers and with a party of Communist-Leninists at its head.

The mushrooming of communist-socialist parties and groupings is now hampered in their drive for unity by mindless internal squabbling as to who shall be the leader. Do not break the spear into fragments! Our main task is to – eliminate parasitic capitalism, return back our Motherland to the Soviet people and resurrect the mighty Soviet Union.

My dear friends: The saying goes, that the road to truth has to go through Calvary. Unfortunately, history has many times proved this to be correct. That's the way it is now. Truthful Soviet patriots have shown themselves in opposition to the self-proclaimed Czar, Boris Yeltsin, who is trying to put his stamp of finality to fascism in our country. They will be judged by the people. Glorious was the rise of Prometheus! Forever will the song of 'Danko' be sung and remembered. The sun will again shine over our Socialist Motherland!

In this time of tremendous hardship for our people, I greet you and shake your hands from the bottom of my heart. The struggle will be hard and long. But united we will stand!

I asked her about the situation as it transpired in Russia during the November 7th celebrations. Here are the points that she made:

• In Moscow the OMON riot police, which in fact are the Yeltsin's private militia, gathered from Siberia, Razin and Kaluga, made up of the grandsons of Ukrainian Banderites' grandchildren, former quislings and fascists that helped Hitler during the Great Patriotic War and were sent there by the Soviet authorities after the war as



punishment for their war crimes and helping fascist Germany.

These OMON police cordoned off the Red Square with tanks, troop carriers, trucks, buses and water cannons, while the OMON police with shields and batons were beating people and chasing them into the subways so that the people were forced to have the demonstration on the 76th Anniversary of the Great October Revolution on the outskirts of Moscow.

Yes, there was bloodshed, but the will of the people was not broken.

Hundreds of thousands nevertheless gathered to celebrate the Revolution.

The press, radio and TV scared people of arrests, beatings, losing their right to live in Moscow, losing their jobs and apartments.

• In Leningrad, there took place huge demonstration even though the main thoroughfare of Alexander Nevsky Prospect was barred by tanks, buses and troop carriers. The demonstration nevertheless took place in a parallel street, even though the OMON riot squads beat people & arrested many leaders.

The Leningrad parade took a couple of hours to pass the reviewing stand. Nina Andreeva was the main speaker.

- Celebrations took place in Minsk, with scores of thousands demonstrators in Perm, Razyan, Samara, Volgograd and all the main cities of Russia.
- The scare tactics of arrests, beatings, outlawing different political parties and groupings did not overall affect the great celebrations, but we must admit that many people were scared with this fascist terror.
- Nina Andreeva was happy to report that thousands of new members were joining the ranks of the All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks. Their membership on

this November 7th grew substantially in the Russian Republic.

\*\* Nina Andreeva sends us her and the membership of the All Union Communist Party of Bolsheviks comradely greetings on this 76th Anniversary and she also said that we were the ONLY people in Canada that sent greetings on this the great day for humanity and progressive people of the world.

She urged us to drink a toast to the victory of and the rebirth of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.

### Corroboration From the "Nation":

That the hideous effects of the Yeltsin Moscow blood bath have resounded around the world is clear. But most media covering the Moscow events of October 3-5th in Canada and the U.S. have "skillfully" smokescreened the purpose and depth of the bloody provocation. Acting as the paid mouth pieces of monopoly capitalism, in most instances, that "skill" has been carefully honed and developed. But when something different in terms of honesty and keen insight is found on the news stands, it is worthy of our close attention. "The Nation", the long standing journal of open reporting and calling "spades" by their right names and even anti-establishment purposes, published in New York, is one of our favorites in this regard. At NorthStar Compass, sometimes our little boat has great struggles in the heavy seas of disinformation et al., flowing from the commercial press. Therefore, it was heartening to find in recent issues some "Nation's" articles we would welcome in our own pages. One such appeared in the October 25th edition of the "Nation", entitled "Putsch in Moscow", written by Daniel Singer, Europe correspondent. We excerpt here portions of that article, partly as new information, and partly as corroboration of our own NSC position on the Yeltsin-G-7 bloody disaster for

the past 18 months.

"Capitalism" (Singer writes) is re-entering Russia dripping with blood ... The Russian President \*Yeltsin) already has blood on his hands. He has the blessing of the entire Western establishment, including Bill Clinton, himself. Although this coup was perhaps the first in history to be fully televised (now) a distorting veil is being drawn over the events ... Yeltsin's determination to stifle any hostile voice in the press is all the more significant because of the way his henchmen manipulated television ... the obsession of the besieged deputies with their media isolation may explain why they fell into the trap on Sunday (October 3rd) when Rutskoi, dizzy with temporary success, exhorted supporters to capture the Ostankino TV centre. The defenders were ready, and the resulting battle enabled Yeltsin to mobilize the troops to defend (??? -Ed.) law and order ... The reason all Western Governments backed Yeltsin to the hilt was their assumption that he is the best man to keep Russia safe for capitalism, and the most likely to carry out the orders of the international financial community. Tomorrow, or the day after, the general will remind (Yeltsin) who it was that made him Czar ... (and will demand something in return - Ed.) There are already ominous signs (that have now become a reality - Ed.) that the regime is using the opportunity to silence independent left wingers and trade unionists. (See NSC's correspondent John Benson, next issue - Ed.) ... "their choice (the Western leaders') in backing the Yeltsin side, had less to do with democracy than with the reign of profit and the rule of capital ... Some will say it is late in the day to discover the hypocrisy of our establishment

and the subservience of its scribblers. Yet, Eastern Europe is the one area where this myth still worked. The West paraded as the ally of the downtrodden, the protector of ... workers or of the victims of the Gulag. It is this myth that has been blown to bits by the tanks shelling Moscow's White House ... the people of Eastern Europe looked wistfully to the West, only to discover that the capitalism they were getting was not the one shown on American television. If you are determined to impose capitalism by any means ... you opt for some kind of iron fist, for a Czar ... this week's grim message from Moscow (is) written in green and red ... green for dollar, red for the blood spilled, not despite, but because of Boris Yeltsin.

OUR COMMENT: It is pleasing to see such corroboration of the current situation in "The Nation", and sadness for us to agree that "It's rather late to be discovering the hypocrisy of our establishment". NSC has, from our beginning, clearly warned of the dangers of Presidential Fascist rule in Russia.

"What lies ahead? Only a Yeltsin 'safe' Duma can emerge from the fixed December 12 elections, which under present repressive conditions, I believe will be boycotted by large sections of the population, especially in the regions. It is difficult to get a truthful picture of the reaction to

Yeltsin's dictatorial rule in the regions and the republics. The Yeltsin media is trying to create the impression of a bandwagon support for the self-dissolution of the Soviets. But I believe there will be increasing passive, as well as active resistance.

"The reality is that Moscow cannot govern without the existing Soviets. Liquidation of these deeply rooted, tested people's instruments of power will lead to utter chaos, and compound the already existing economic crisis. Yeltsin's Imperial insistence, I believe, will accelerate the present tendency of the regions to move away from Moscow by declaring themselves Republics.

With a 'me-too' Duma and Constitutional court, all three branches of the Government will stand above the people. Thus, the danger exists of the closure of democratic channels with all the inevitable consequences of mass disobediance and even political The struggle to open strikes. democratic channels therefore constitutes at this point one of the chief tasks of the left-centre patriotic forces and coalition. Their chief strength lies in the regions. The vast opposition, if driven underground, will find ways to resist. Yeltsin will now move more aggressively along the IMF fast track towards capitalism. That the struggle will continue and gain momentum, there can be no doubt ... The class struggle will sharpen. Dictatorial rule will lead to broadened democratic resistance. Objectively, all of this will lead to the struggle for Russia's return to the path of renovated socialist development and a renovation of the USSR. But it is clear this will be a long and difficult struggle ..."

## "YELTSIN'S IRON CURTAIN ..."


Mike Davidow, writing from an "on-the-scene" vantage point where he produces his invaluable column

"Moscow Diary", writes in the October 16th edition of the People's Weekly World that "Yeltsin's Iron Curtain ... hangs heavy, even over Moscow's martyred dead", referring to the dead from the blood soaked events of October 3rd and 4th, and the subsequent iron rule imposed by Yeltsin and his "bought and paid for" military divisions under Grachev.

"Not even a single burial of the more than 200 victims of Yeltsin's day of infamy were shown on TV. All 'arrangements' were made and supervised by the Yeltsin authorities to keep the victims of the slaughter from public view", Davidow writes. "Martial law prevented the people from even mourning their dead."

The mass media maintained an attitude of servitude to Yeltsin, and during the massacre, focused solely on the soldiers and police who had been ordered to fire on their own people. Only seven police and eight members of the military, including the bestial OMON, were among the dead. The 49 defenders of the Supreme Soviets were left unburied for three days. "Western telecasts (especially CNN) were far more objective than Russian coverage", Davidow informs us. These showed that the enraged demonstrators who stormed the Yeltsin controlled TV

Tower had at the beginning confined their demands to something the Supreme Soviet had already voted for – an end to the Yeltsin biased one-sided reporting. Viktor Anpilov, 1st Secretary of the Russian Workers Party, had appealed over and over again: "do not fire on unarmed people", only to be answered by bursts of automatic weapons, while many fell to the ground, and a minimum of casualties occurred in the TV station.

Davidow had an "on the scenes" view of all of this from a balcony on the House of Soviets and heard cries from the people for arms to defend themselves but not a single rifle was issued. Unarmed young men piled onto trucks to try and save their comrades under fire, only to be killed themselves under the murderous military and police fire.

"Russia today is ruled by Tsarlike decrees and the military are acting as an occupation force. There is now no parliament, no constitution, no constitutional court", Davidow writes. "Tsar Boris the Second, (as he is now commonly called) has arbitrarily 'abolished' the 'disobedient' Moscow Soviet (and) removed elected governors of regions and replaced them with his own appointees. He demands the self dissolution of District and City Soviets. (He) has abolished the entire opposition press. His puppet election committee is fixing the rules of the (coming) elections. (He) has already adopted a constitution to "legalize" presidential dictatorial rule and the imposition of capitalism on an unwilling people. He has already banned everybody except his "loyal" opposition from participation in the elections. This is the great "democrat" President Clinton rushed to support! (As well as Kim Campbell, then Prime Minister of Canada, whose rise to power was excelled only by the thoroughness of her disappearance from public life at the

hands of the Canadian electorate. She cannot say we didn't warn her of the results of supporting Yeltsin and the Reaganite – Mulroney TNC agenda – Editor).

Further on, in his column, Davidow points out, "Life savings have been literally confiscated by soaring inflation, mass impoverishment now exists side by side with new riches. Socialist gains ... have been lost - the world's lowest rents, greatest housing construction; free comprehensive medical care, higher education with stipends; job security; vacations at resorts, once reserved for the rich, harmonious national relations. IN THEIR PLACE HAS COME THE MOST RAPACIOUS, FOREIGN DOMINATED CAPITALISM" (our emphasis – ed.) ... "The resulting great popular upsurge of protest includes many who two years ago were among Yeltsin's closest supporters" the PWW columnist writes. "The issue at this point was not socialism, but the defence of democracy, the Soviets and the existing Constitution ..."

OUR COMMENT: We regret that we have been forced by space considerations to abridge Davidow's column. We are painfully aware that such reporting simply cannot be found in the mainstream media of our country, or anywhere in the TNC controlled news media world. We highly commend PWW, its editors and Mike Davidow for placing before those who either need, or want to know, the reality of world events, beginning in the former USSR, but affecting the vast majority of citizens and working people everywhere. Thank you for your courage and dedication to the truth. We will assist in any way we can.

#### QUESTIONS STILL NOT ANSWERED

Questions arise now as to why this happened and were there no alternatives to this bloodshed?

- At the Ostankino Tower and in the Russian Parliament Building (White House), there was a huge preponderance of American Journalists, cameramen, who had at their disposal radio-TV communications equipment supplied by Yeltsin's clique, while the Russian journalists that were there were NOT ALLOWED any communications apparatus to broadcast or record this upcoming tragedy. Why?
- Who in their right mind, Rutskoi, Khasbulatov or Anpilov, gave the order to storm the Ostankino TV Tower, knowing full well that it was impossible to take the TV Tower because of heavy defense by Yeltsin's forces with tanks, troop carriers, water cannon, militia with machineguns as opposed to the Soviet patriots who were mostly unarmed? Who was the "quisling-provocateur" in the leadership?

Even if they were able to take the TV Tower, the heart of transmission technological apparatus was across the road from the TV Tower. It just does not make any sense. Everything points to a "set up"!

• Another event which come to light now – even on the evening of

October 3rd, the defenders in the "White House" were NOT GIVEN ALL of the arsenal of guns and ammunition as was available in the building! Why?

- A question needs to be asked of the Yeltsin's soldiers who were the snipers that shot the people at the TV Tower, firing from left and right into the crowd? One is reminded of the situation in Romania in 1989 when the TV Tower was also besieged by the forces and there were snipers taking a toll of life, but not ONE was apprehended there or in Moscow? Are you soldiers without heart, without feelings, without a conscience?
- Why did someone give the order to storm the TV technical centre, knowing full well that the results would be catastrophic for unarmed people, which included women and children?
- Although the defenders of the White House knew that it was impossible to hold out much longer, they did not hoist a white flag on top of the Parliament Building for all Muscovites and the world to see that it was uneven struggle.
- Was it necessary for the tanks, cannon and machine-gun attack on the defenders of the White House by Yeltsin's forces, when they knew without question that it was going to be a slaughter? NO, it was not necessary to do this criminal act at all, either strategically, politically or psychologically.

#### **OUR COMMENT:**

It was a planned provocation, all the players in this drama were at their assigned posts – the idea was to have brother kill his brother, thus making the healing process practically impossible.

More of the intricacy of the events will be coming to light and we shall keep you informed.

Soviet people will not forget or forgive; Humanity will record this

slaughter as the beginning of fascism. Similarity to Nazi Germany in the 1930's is self evident.

On the intervention of your father, who was a Director of the biggest enterprise in our district, you were saved from a court sentence. On your father's intervention, they blamed this as an "unfortunate accident"!

#### AN EYEWITNESS OPINION THAT DIFFERS ... FROM A VISIT TO MOSCOW

On September 19th, I set out for a visit to Moscow and St. Petersburg with members of the U.S. Grandmothers For Peace.

On the way over, I read in the Globe and Mail, Sept. 18th under the headline, "Yeltsin Reformers Regain Upper Hand" that ... "Prime Minister Victor Chernomydrin, who was viewed as a hard liner opponent of reform when he took over in December, seems to have accepted that reform is Russia's only hope of survival. That is the message in the return of Yegor Gaidar, the chubby academic who emerged from obscurity two years ago to become the architect of Russia's transition from a Communist to a market economy."

I felt on reading this that something was about to happen in Russia. The days before the coup, we spent talking to ordinary citizens and various officials. Readers of N.S.C. are already aware of the disintegration of the USSR that started under Gorbachev, now a hated man over there, while in the U.S., he opens a "Peace Foundation"!

Russia was one of the remaining republics not at war. The living conditions of the Russian people had vastly disintegrated since I was last there in 1987. People are already going hungry. The price of a Hans Christian Anderson story book is half the average wage. The militia guard the hospitals because the mafia is so powerful that after a failed assassination attempt, they have been entering the hospitals to "finish off the job".

There is a market for "guard dogs" because of the increasing street violence. One of our interpreters who had to find the money to get textbooks for her son in law school, (as the laws change, new textbooks are required) has taken up dog breeding as a source of income. Western tobacco company advertising is everywhere, and has also taken over the dominant shares of the Russian tobacco industry. In fact, Western interests seem to have taken over everything. Yeltsin was so enamoured of the new MacDonalds in Moscow that he attended the opening of it with great pomp.

Despite the strong emergence of the Russian Orthodox church, U.S. TV evangelicals dominate the airwaves at the weekends, along with other Western commercials such as an ad for Father Christmas offering chocolate to a father for his child when most parents can't afford basic food and clothing.

On the morning after the coup, we were met by our interpreter who looked extremely worried. The Kremlin, which we were supposed to visit that morning, had been closed, and she told us that the

media was now under the "forces of Yeltsin" whereas prior to the "coup", dissident factions had been allowed public expression.

That night on television, with an interpreter, we watched the news. We saw Yeltsin (a known alcoholic and rumoured drug addict) stride up and down as he talked and gesticulated. We saw President Clinton give his 100% endorsement to the coup. The announcer ended this farce, tongue in cheek, with the words, "No Comment".

That day, we drove past the "White House" (not a pun on the U.S. White House, it is literally "white") and saw the remnants of the barricades and small fires of the previous night. Meanwhile, as we drove and walked around Moscow for the rest of the day, we saw a population going about its business as usual. When we asked our guides why there was so little opposition to what had happened, they told us the following:

80% of the population was so fed up with the economic deterioration that they could not care less as long as something was done about the economy and they could find work to put food on the table.

The remaining 20% divided into two camps.

- 1. The people who supported Yeltsin even though they despised him as a man because they felt only a dictator could carry through the economic changes that were expected of them.
- 2. People who understood that the International Monetary Fund and World Bank were pushing for the economic shock therapy and that the coup heralded the end of any chance of democracy in Russia, and that what would probably happen was that there would be 1% of the population living in luxury, 99% living in economic slavery under military rule, i.e., even worse

conditions that prevailed before the 1917 revolution.

This group was also frightened, as they expected to be picked up as dissidents in "purges". They also said that probably a Yeltsin designed provocation would happen. It would be blamed on the opposition, to give Yeltsin an excuse to carry out same purges.

As I write, October 5th, this has happened. With the full approval of the Western "democratic" leaders.

On my return to Canada, I was amazed to see the rhetoric of the Canadian electoral scene. Promises of jobs, jobs, jobs, as though what had just happened in Russia had no implication for Canadians.

On the plane as I returned from Amsterdam, I read the front page of the International Herald Tribune, September 28th. The big picture on the front page was of a small number of "pawns" in the "great game". Russian soldiers, looking quite bewildered, faced "hard line" Russian protesters.

Beneath that was a picture of three men in business suits who face no soldiers or opposition. The caption under the photo reads, "The I.M.F. Chief, Michael Camdessus, GATT Director, Peter Sutherland, and World Bank Chief, Louis Preston, pressing Monday for a trade pact".

Today in San Francisco, the Campaign is holding a public meeting to commemorate the Bolshevik revolution. Tomorrow, in New York and cities across the country, we will hold demonstrations to expose the truth about Yeltsin's massacre.

On this most important anniversary for the workers and oppressed peoples of the world, let's pledge to build solidarity with workers throughout the former Soviet Union as we struggle against the transnational corporations on this continent.

(The following is a portion of a personal letter addressed to friends in Toronto from Cuba)

#### A NOTE FROM CUBA ...

My Dear Friends:

"... I don't know if you know that due to our serious economic situation in Cuba, the Government has permitted us to receive dollars that can be used in different stores, where you can now buy only with foreign exchange. This way, our Government raises dollars and that is the only currency with which Cuba can buy internationally. There are now no Socialist currencies or countries for us to do commerce with. In these stores, you can buy anything you need, but they are very expensive. Of course, all the money that is gathered this way is used by the Cuban Government for the essentials such as food, petroleum, etc., for our country. I don't know what things are said about Cuba in Canada, but there are some things I should like you to know. Our economic situation is very difficult. However, there are NOT any people dying of hunger, or anything like that. There were people who were considered to be revolutionaries and supporters of the Government, but who are now turned against the Government. But the majority of our people remain revolutionary and are willing to defend our country until the end, if necessary. I would like you to write to me and ask any questions you may have on your mind.

Elsewhere in this edition, we publish an extraordinarily penetrating and courageous article by Professor Harasymchuk of Lutsk in the Ukraine. In it, he raises what we too believe to be central questions that confront Communists and the peoples of the former Soviet Union in the desperate struggle against Fascist destruction, aided and abetted as they are by Western corporate and governmental powers. At stake are their Socialist past and future. Can unity, or as he places it, "a monolithic Communist Party" be re-established in order to raise the demand for the defense of Socialism? Central to that, Professor Harysymchuk raises the corollary question of the division, or corruption and decay of the Communist Party of the Soviet Union, and as a focal point of that, the "demonization" of Stalin to erase the legacy of Lenin.

At NorthStar Compass, we believe the full, in-depth, answers to those questions lie within the competency and ambit of the various Communist parties, and the world's Communists as they struggle to restore comprehensive unity to Marxism-Leninism, and working class struggle concepts for social and revolutionary change and development. We make no claim here, to the gigantic competence that

task demands. We do, however, suggest that the contributions of non-Communists, as well as Communists and including the great mass of the working class, whether in the former Soviet Union, Canada, or elsewhere is demanded and must be welcomed in that political and ideological struggle to find the road ahead. We therefore, from this vantage point, offer what we hope to be relevant insights that we, as "Friends of the Soviet People" have been able to develop.

If we examine historically, the collapse of the Soviet Union, it seems plain that this came when the leadership of the CPSU had arrived at a point of degeneracy, corruption that, coupled totally with their rejection of the working class science of Marxism-Leninism and all of its components including dialectical and historical materialism, the class struggle and the ruling power of the working class. In other words, the degeneracy (that we believe began well before the advent of Gorbachev) and rejection of the ideological base, led to a progressive slide into the pits of destruction we now witness. The Party apparently became a power for itself and thus, alienated itself from the working class who carried the historical responsibility of the ongoing tasks of building the new Socialist and ultimately, Communist societies. In simple terms, the historical role of the CPSU was itself destroyed by its internal decay, and as had been forcefully forewarned, disaster overcame the historic achievements of the early builders and revolutionaries.

It is instructive to recall some of those forewarnings, and their source. Years before the Second World War, in a pamphlet entitled, "Mastering Bolshevism", none other than the now reviled Joseph V. Stalin wrote: (He was then at the head of the CPSU (B). "We may

take it as a rule that as long as the Party of Bolsheviks maintain connection with the broad masses of the people, they will be invincible. On the contrary, as soon as the Party sever themselves from the people and lose their connection with them, as soon as they become covered with bureaucratic rust, they will lose all their strength and become a mere cipher ... As long as the Bolsheviks maintain their connection with the people, their Mother, the Bolsheviks have every opportunity of remaining invincible ..." Here, we find Stalin's words totally in consonance with the teachings of Lenin and the aims of the proletarian Anti-Czarist revolution. In fact, nowhere in the writings or speeches of Stalin will there be found serious departures from Lenin's teaching.

We are in full agreement with Professor Harasymchuk when he calls for a historical "review" of the years of Stalin's leadership. That study and review of ALL the historical data and documents should follow the paths and actions of the CPSU both during his time and since then, and the leaders following him. That is the minimum requirement, particularly for the people and now divided Parties of the Soviet Union, but such would also have far reaching results, we believe, for every Communist Party and working class in the world, including Canada.

It must be more than sheer coincidence that "anti-Stalinism" became the main instrument and smokescreen behind which the rejection and distortion of the working class science of Marxism-Leninism, and finally, the destruction of the Soviet state was accomplished. That this had world-wide and disastrous effects is also very clear. "Anti-Stalinism" as a cloak to hide anti-Leninism and anti-Socialism began with Kruschov's "revelations"

in 1956 at the 20th CPSU Congress. It ended with the abject collapse of the Soviet Union, propelled during the Gorbachev-Yeltsin-Yakovlev-Scheverdnadze years by total sellout of Socialism and total alienation of the CPSU from the Soviet working class. Of course, we must add this was cunningly "aided and abetted" by the Reagan-Bush-Thatcher-Kohl-Mitterand-Mulroney cabal of G-7, all acting as the front line destroyers, for international finance capital the neo-Imperialists of the 1980's and 1990's. In their "death to Communism", "evil empire" lockstep, along with them came the sundry "under-world" of the World Anti-Communist League of General Singlaub et al., the Mafia gangsters of the drug trade and the Nugen-Hand bank scandal, and the various instruments of psychological and covert warfare, the C.I.A., the W-5 and W-G agents, etc., etc.

But centrepiece to the ongoing ravings of the media et al. crowd was fodder presented to it by the Yakovlev Commission established under Gorbachev "to wipe clean the dark spots of Soviet History". An endless flood of anti-Soviet, anti-Stalinist "demonization" materials appeared from that source and continues to poison the waters of public knowledge and information to this day.

One of Yakovlev's revolting accomplishments was to stir an hysterical world-wide revival of the old and hoary "Katyn Massacre" with deafening outcries by the right wing anti-Sovieteers. Here was material unchallengeable from "master" Yakovlev himself, even though he was challenged by leading KGB Director, Kryuchkov as a "30 year agent of the U.S. State Department" ... Charges neither proven or unproven at this date, but that have the ring of truth.


But again, what are the realities of the Nazi-inspired incident? Distasteful as it is, the diary of Herr Goebbels provides, if not definitive proof, then extremely serious questions as to why Yakovlev placed the "guilt" for the massacre of the 4,000 Polish officers on Stalin and the Soviets ... questions that cry out for answers!

There are at least twelve references to what Goebbels calls the Katyn "affair" in the book, published in 1948 by Doubleday & Company of New York called simply "The Goebbels Diaries, 1942 – 43". It was edited and translated from Goebbels' documents by Louis P. Lochner, a 20-year American journalist in Berlin until 1941, for the Associated Press. He was also for six years, President of the American Chamber of Commerce. The materials he worked on were officially released to

him from the "U.S. Office of Alien Property" with permission to "publish translations of selections from the manuscript purporting to be 1942 – 43 diaries of Paul Joseph Goebbels". He was directly acquainted with Goebbels and Lochner received the highest commendations from the publishers.

The first reference to Katyn we note from the "Diary" is dated April 9th, 1943. "I had Polish intellectuals taken there. They are to see for themselves what is in store for them should their secret wishes that the Germans be defeated by the Bolsheviks actually be fulfilled ..." Goebbels wrote.

The second quote and excerpt regarding the grisly graves near Smolensk by the Nazi "big Lie" Maker: "... the commentators marvel at the extraordinary cleverness with which we have been



able to convert the Katyn affair into a highly political affair", and "... the military men at Der Feuhrers GHQ ... succeeded in eliminating the pictures of Katyn from the weekly newsreel" ... (both quotes dated April 28th, 1943). April 29th, 1943, Goebbels introduces a reference that seems unclear in its connection with Katyn: "... The Russian General Vlassov, who fights on our side ... has been pretty much shelved by the Ministry of the East ... He wrote a report that grips one's heart strings ..." On April 30th, 1943: "... our propaganda is suspected everywhere of having blown up the Katyn incident to enable us to make peace separately with the English, or, the Soviets ..." (Again, a somewhat obscure reference but apparently with some thought regarding the rejection by the Soviet Government of their diplomatic ties about this time with the Polish Governmentin-Exile in London) But on May 8th, Goebbels reveals the truth of the Katyn slaughter of the 4,000 Polish officers: "... unfortunately, GERMAN MUNITIONS HAVE BEEN FOUND IN THE GRAVES OF KATYN ... it is essential that this incident now be kept TOP-SECRET. IF IT WERE TO COME TO THE ATTENTION OF THE ENEMY, THE WHOLE MATTER WOULD HAVE TO BE DROPPED ..." (Our emphasis). One final entry is revealing and it is dated May 10th, 1943: "... Der Feuhrer was very impressed by the whole Katyn incident. It showed him what tremendous possibilities are still inherent in anti-Bolshevik propaganda ... (he) also attaches great importance to anti-Semitic propaganda ..." This, after "dropping" of Katyn, can only indicate the total falsity of charges against the Soviets.

We believe that Yakovlev and his "Commission" must have known

of the Goebbels' "diary" when they "studied" Katyn. The sole rationale that the Yakovlev report could have then must be the intent to further "demonize" and defame both Stalin and the Socialist Soviet Union during the anti-Nazi war! We believe that was exactly what this exercise in "glasnost" was all about.

It is not our intent to absolve or excuse any alleged "crimes" by Stalin, or by Beria, or anybody else that may or may not have occurred during their tenure of leadership. But to date, what we have had is an ongoing use of "criminal" charges for purely anti-Socialist, anti-Communist, and anti-peoples political purposes. We would argue most strongly that until these mindboggling charges are proven under a calm, due process of law "beyond the shadow of reasonable doubt", they remain within the realm of dangerous political (in the worst sense) hooliganism, or worse. That has not been done and no final verdict can be rendered either legally or historically until it is done. The alternative is continuing poisoning of the channels of public information and knowledge. Another "side" effect is division among Communists!

While we are about this ... further questions intrude that cry out for honest answers, not political boondoggling. Why, and how did the 20th Congress "secret" Kruschov revelations in 1956 find their way to the pages of the New York Times, well in advance of them being given to the peoples of the Soviet Union? How were Kruschov's "memoir" tapes done and found their way into massive books published in the U.S.A. ("Kruschov Remembers - A Testimonial")? Interestingly, Strobe Talbot, the Magazine Moscow Time correspondent and Soviet "expert" par excellence, edited those massive tapes for publication. He is now the Ambassador for the Clinton Administration on East European Affairs. It would be good for humanity to have these puzzling (and many other) questions "cleared up". That is in order as is the "clearing up" of the Yakovlev et al. Commission. Fascism IS on the march in Russia. Only unity will bring victory to the people.

WE COMMENT: John Gray's 50 column inches (3 inches wide) insight piece, we believe, could not say anything more eloquently than the headlines placed over his overblown story. We can properly observe that with possibly war or post-war exceptions, under the Socialist Soviet Union, such things simply did not happen! But now, Professor Andrei Zyitsev, Director of the Kaluga Sociological Institute in that city 200 miles south of Moscow, survives only because "he was able to harvest his two or three tonnes of

potatoes ..." The Professor is quoted as saying the current situation in his country is a "tragedy". He can only mean both because his "survival" depends on potatoe crop and the new Fascist Dictator. "Cities like Kaluga sleep peacefully and local Soviets across the country obediently obliterate themselves so that Mr. Yeltsin, the new Czar who calls himself a democrat can get on with what he calls the business of creating a state", Gray writes. There is little, or no, mention in Gray's copy of the fact the "new czar" is there because he is backed by the Kalishnikov assault rifles, the tanks and the 105 and 155 mm guns of the military, or that this was done with overt support of the G-7 international finance capitalists, including those from Canada.

#### Headlines – Globe & Mail, Toronto, October 30th, 1993 "RUSSIANS DON'T WANT YELTSIN RE-ELECTED"

"... Only 29% say he deserves to be president again, while half the 1,000 people interviewed in the poll in mid-October approved of the way he was handling his job ... the poll was sponsored by U.S. News & World Report ... Mikhail Gorbachev, who is talking about challenging Mr. Yeltsin in the presidential election next year, remains the most unpopular major politician in Russia. The former President gets a negative rating from more Russians than (you could never guess – Ed.) Joseph Stalin."

WE COMMENT: Any poll sponsored by U.S. News & World Report would have to be suspect since from the time of its founding, that magazine has never carried a single line of objective reporting about the Soviet Union, Socialism, etc. That must be something like a few years short of a half century. But when Stalin beats "good old Gorby"

in the polls, we can't help but scratch our heads. Is this the beginning of the "demonization of Reagan's and Bush's, etc., darling???

Headlines – New York Times, November 4th, 1993

#### "RUSSIA DROPS PLEDGE OF NO FIRST USE OF ATOM ARMS"

Moscow, Nov. 3 - Serge Schemann:

"The Russian Defense Ministry confirmed today that the new Russian military doctrine ... abandoned the pledge not to use nuclear arms first. General Grachev said "As for those states that have nuclear weapons the doctrine says nothing". He declined to elaborate ... The doctrine ruled out the use of nuclear weapons against non-nuclear states that had signed the 1968 non-proliferation treaty, UNLESS THEY WERE ALLIED WITH A NUCLEAR ARMED COUNTRY. (our emphasis ed.) ... Confirmed (were) reports that Russia would not reiterate the pledge given in 1982, by then President Leonid Brezhnev, not to use the nuclear arsenal for a "first strike" ... In any case, the U.S.A. never made a similar pledge ..."

WE COMMENT: During the 1930's and Fascist Dictator Mussolini's rule in Italy, a slogan was raised "Fascism IS War!" That has not changed in our view, and Fascist Dictator Yeltsin has rejected the former 1982 Soviet pledge of "No First Strike", that had it been matched by the Americans, would have brought to an end of the Cold War then. Why? We suspect the peculiar formulation by Grachev indicating a "first strike" component against non-nuclear powers UNLESS ALLIED WITH A NUCLEAR POWER is aimed at former republics of the USSR first of all, who might join with Ukraine or Uzbekastan to resist

Russian Fascist aggression. What other sense can be made of it, we do not know. Meantime, in the face of this ominous situation, U.S. President Clinton keeps muttering "As long as Yeltsin promoted democracy, we support, etc., etc. ..." Of course, once you commit to support of Fascism, what else can you possibly dream up to hoodwink people? Support of Fascism cannot be other than an ongoing, oozing forward blob of mental retardation or worse, unless like Al Capone, or Hitler, you try to cover up and divert attention from what you are really doing! Disgraceful! But Peace among nations now stands at very grave risk ... greater than before.
