EDITORIAL

For seven decades of the rapidly closing 20th Century, the proletarian (working class) Marxist-Leninist Revolution of 1917 in Russia, Ukraine, Byelorus, and the 1922 formation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics stood at the epi-centre of world events. Why was this so?

That revolution of the workers, peasants and ordinary people groaning under the old Czarist empire that dated back through centuries of feudalist obscurantism and iron, gun-whip and prison enslavement of all but a chosen few aristocrats and religious mythpeddlers, smashed their way to a new form of society and human relations. Organizing, teaching, leading that heroic feat of the people stood the indomitable Vladimir Ilych Lenin and his Bolshevik (majority) Party. Driven from the temples of greed and power were the Czarist feudalists who acted as the hangmen for British, German, French and U.S. monopoly capitalist powers that were literally bleeding the economic life blood and sinews from the people while filling the dungeons to overflowing with illiteracy, poverty, crime and primitive backwardness.

The aim of their new society was to free hundreds of millions from that intolerable yolk of deprivation and misery, and the erection of a new, unprecedented Socialist society in which the ownership of the means of production and the resources of their land would be used not to enrich absentee and foreign capitalists and "owners", but for the raising of standards of life, literacy and opportunity for all.

HAIL TO THE WORKING CLASS – BOLSHEVIK REVOLUTION

OF 1917 ...

Throughout the world, where workers of all countries toiled and groaned under the hard-fisted exploitation of the capitalist class, as well as among the billions who had, for centuries, borne the enslavement and degradation of the Imperialist-colonial system, the revolution was greeted with wonderment and enthusiasm. Excepted were the dispossessed "owners" and "Imperialists" who saw their privileged life of power and "freedom to war and exploit at will" endangered and at risk.

Short months following the successful conquest of power by the new working class state and the Bolsheviks, their revolution faced the assaults of foreign inspired civil war led by the Czarist butchers whose hatred and fear was without bounds. Not content with that, FOURTEEN DIFFERENT

COUNTRIES OF THE WESTERN WORLD, led by the foremost of hatred inspired "Anti-Communists" invaded the new Socialist Republic. Included were forces from Canada, and "Northstar Compass" and the "Concerned Friends of the Soviet People" proclaim our pride in the fact that we trace our roots back to the formation in Canada of the "Hands Off Russia Committees" that stood bravely in the face of the "anti-Communist" barrages and hysteria of those days, to defend the rights of the peoples of this new revolutionary society.

Then, as now, we proclaim their rights to decide their own futures, free from interventionist armies and internal divisions falsely created to prevent the restoration of new Soviet Republics and Union.



The "Soviets" (Councils), as a new form of more direct democratic expression, control and action by the people at every level, up to and including the Supreme Soviets, had been emplaced in power by the workers and people themselves with the abolition of the Duma or Parliamentary system the Czars had been forced to grant, as a new capitalist class developed in Russia.

THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION FAILED THEN ... AS IT WILL FAIL NOW

The unity of the majority of the people behind their new Soviet system and under the guidance and leadership of the Communist Bolshevik Party of Lenin, and later of Stalin, won the day and a new, if somewhat foreboding future, opened before the people as the exploiters and mass murderers of the "Whites" were driven out by the "Reds". Followed a period of diplomatic, economic and political

isolation and military encirclement by the world's powers.

In 1929, by then, head of the Communist Party, Joseph Stalin, warned the Soviet peoples that there were only ten years in which to firmly build their new society, consolidate it and to develop the means of its defence. He pointed inherited backwardness, illiteracy and social and cultural impoverishment from Czarism and foreign penetration. But there was no doubt, he said, that the "imperialists of the West would once again seek our destruction". During the 1930's, intervention and encirclement, now turned to internal treachery and subversive efforts to undermine the Soviet regime. Former non-Bolshevik leadership elements, including Bukharin and Leon Trotsky, whose professed aim of "world revolution" had been politically defeated in the USSR by Stalin's "build Socialism in one country and lead by example" policy, turned to overt treason. By May of 1937, plans by Trotsky

were complete - to seize power IN CONJUNCTION WITH A GERMAN HIGH COMMAND PLOT TO OVERTHROW THE SOVIET REGIME. Again, these aims were thwarted and defeated, and the plot exposed to the entire world ... in part, through the testimony of Ambassador Davies of the United States who attended the trials. He was acting in conjunction with the administration of President Franklin Delano Roosevelt who had extended "diplomatic recognition" and exchanged ambassadors with Moscow in 1933. All previous U.S. administrations had withheld such recognition in the sea of anti-Soviet hostility that then existed.

Despite all this, in the ten years following Stalin's 1929 warning, the Soviet people had erected their society, abolished illiteracy, set up the world's first universal health care plans, built power dams and electrification necessary to move forward towards their goals of raising human standards of living, and AT THE SAME TIME, DEVELOPED AN UNPRECEDENTEDLY POWERFUL MILITARY MACHINE TO DEFEND THEIR LAND, THEIR LIVES AND THEIR FUTURES. NOTHING LIKE IT HAD EVER HAPPENED BEFORE IN THE HISTORY OF THE WORLD.

IMPERIALISM PERSISTS, AND THE NAZI WAR MACHINE IS TURNED TO THE EAST

Repeated efforts by the Soviet Government to develop "collective security" against the Nazi-Fascist war machines, and earlier to "Quarantine the aggressors" were spurned by the Western Powers (including Canada) at the League of Nations and in other diplomatic efforts, until Hitler put into force his barbaric war plan, "Barbarossa", on June 21, 1941, aimed at the total



destruction of the Soviets. Only then, at the eleventh hour, did Prime Minister Churchill of Britain (realizing that with defeat of Soviet Russia, Britain and the British Empire would stand naked before the Nazi war machine) proclaimed on June 22, 1941 the alliance that was eventually to stop the Nazi marauders. With the Pearl Harbour debacle and Japanese attack on December 7th that year, Roosevelt finally was able to lead his country into the war.

It should be said that the British suffered heavy casualties and losses in the continuing battles, and that the U.S. lost some 450,000 war casualties, while Canada lost 42,000. But the Soviet people saw some 25,000,000 or more of their fellow. citizens die and their country devastated. But it was they who, in fact, almost single-handedly destroyed the Nazi war machine and forced the Allied terms of "unconditional surrender" on Nazi Germany. Again, Imperialist designs to bring down the Soviet Socialist Republics had failed - this time, in the unprecedented violence of World War II, or as the Soviets call it, "the Great Patriotic War".

1945 - 1946 IMPERIALISM DECLARES THE COLD WAR ... A CONTINUATION

Despite the erection of the United Nations; despite a world weary of war to the point of exhaustion; despite the formation of the World Federation of Trade Unions in a new and democratic advance for working people; despite an unparalleled upsurge of international goodwill, neighborliness and solidarity among the peoples of all lands as a result of Allied victory; IN ORDER TO DESTROY THE SOCIALIST SOVIET UNION, and to open its vast wealth and resources to monopoly

capitalist (read "TNC-globalization") exploitation, yet another war was declared. This one, they called the "Cold War" and it was designed to overthrow the Soviet system and state by any and every means available. NSC has dwelt on that history to some extent in our previous 25 issues.

That it succeeded to the extent that former Soviet Army detachments under the command of Yeltsin and Grachev literally blasted and burned out of existence the Supreme Soviet on October 3rd, last year, murdering a reported 2,000 Soviet citizens, we all know. That this was followed by an illegal election to re-establish an illegal constitution and the Duma and a form of Presidential dictatorship, in accordance with old Czarist control mechanisms, we also know. That the country has been dismembered and the USSR and its standards of life in every form destroyed, we know all too well.

The reasons? It remains for the former Soviets to tell us precisely and in detail, but one essential fact emerges: THE BASIC AIMS, PURPOSES AND METHODS OF THE ORIGINAL REVOLUTION WERE PUSHED ON THE SIDE AND BURIED IN INCREASING DEPTH OF BUREAUCRACY AND CORRUPTION BY THOSE WHO WERE UNPREPARED AND REFUSED TO EMPOWER AND ASSIST THE WORKING CLASS, THE AGRARIANS (FORMERLY PEASANT) AND PEOPLE TO TAKE CONTROL OF THEIR OWN COUNTRY AND THEIR OWN FUTURE. From this distance, what were the elements of the corruption, subversion and naked treachery that led to the demise of the Leninist working class - Bolshevik Revolution would seem certainly to lie in the rejection of the science of

the working class – Marxism-Leninism, and the expropriation of the rights of the working class itself.

But, on this the 77th Anniversary of that epochal triumph of human reason, action and will of the working class, Bolshevik Revolution as we witness the rebirth of united struggles against the new oppressors and "Czars" who act as the hangmen for the TNC's and the Western "globalized" powers; as we see hundreds of thousands marching in the streets of Moscow and elsewhere, proclaiming the resurrection of Marxism-Leninism and the Socialist future, we raise our shouts of joy with them. The future does not belong to the crooks, the exploiters, the traitors, the liars, the corrupted and the obscene. That radiant future, albeit slightly dimmed at this point, is now arising in the east, in the land of all humanities' friends ... the Soviet people. Arise, you mighty people and land. For our small part, we will greet your new day with joy and love. You have more than earned our pledges of international friendship, solidarity and peace, as well as from the working people and the democratic forces of the entire world. We salute you on this 77th Anniversary of your world-shaking venture into the new, and still to be won, societies of the future.

GREETINGS SENT TO INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR, MOSCOW

October 31, 1994

Dear friends and comrades:

We extend our warmest greetings and wishes for a successful Seminar. We express our regret that we have not been able to overcome certain bureaucratic restrictions by denial of entry visa to your country for an official representative of the Concerned Friends of the Soviet People and Northstar Compass to attend. We are however pleased that the bearer of this greeting has been permitted entry; he is a member of the Editorial Staff of Northstar Compass.

Your Seminar takes place during the time of the celebration of the 77th Anniversary of the Great October Revolution of 1917. Despite the escalation of the class war in your country and in the international arena in the form of the hideous Cold War that was rooted in the basic policies and structures of international finance and industrial capital, and that continues even more sharply today, we hail this Anniversary of the triumph of the working class people and peasantry of your country that for more than seventy years held aloft the banners of human progress for a world of friendship, co-operation and peace. It is impossible to imagine what kind of world we would now inhabit had not the sacrifices, foresight and immense, world shaping actions of the working class and people of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics not been present within the historical experience of humanity.

We point to only three of these contributions to all people, everywhere: 1) the Revolution showed the world that the deadly grip of

the Imperialist exploiters and war-makers could be successfully challenged and could be replaced by a new and higher political, economic, social and cultural society; 2) that despite the hostile encirclement of the Soviet Union and open encouragement of Nazi-Imperialist and Fascist forces, by the enemies of Socialism and human progress, to destroy the first land of Socialism, it was the people and their leadership of the USSR that played the greatest and decisive role in the destruction of the Imperialist Nazi enemies of humanity, and; 3) that vast scientific and technological advances of the USSR in a wide field of scientific endeavour has opened new vistas before humanity for the preservation and security of all the world's people, and of our little "spaceship" we call Mother Earth.

Today, the struggle for the restoration of the Socialist Soviet mode of life in your former Soviet Republics is crystal clear. This is underlined unmistakeably by the destructive and retrogressive standards that the so-called "free market economy" has brought your people. We say without fear of

contradiction that a return to Socialism and the greatness of the USSR is absolutely necessary not only for the people of Russia, Ukraine, Byelorussia and other former Soviet Republics, but for all of humanity. Only thus can a future of progress be secured and the domination, wars, confrontations, illiteracy, poverty, disease and exploitation be overcome. It hardly seems necessary to repeat that a continuation of humanity's course to a new Trans-national Corporate world of depravity and primitiveness is a return to a new "Dark Ages" for all humanity.

That is the course already embarked upon by these powerful, degraded TNC forces. Whether or not peoples of the world will now embark upon Socialist paths of development immediately, no people can fail to see that their future is intertwined and part of the immense struggles of the peoples of the Soviet Union, because all confront the common enemy of TNC control. Workers and the people everywhere must now lend whatever support they can to overcome the effects of the external

WHY THE CANCELLATION OF CAMPAIGN?

DEAR READER: We feel that you should be aware of what transpired from November 7th to November 10th in our Editorial Board as to correspondence, telephone conversations between yours truly and the office of the Canadian Civil Liberties Association!

I received a telephone call from the office of the Civil Liberties Association asking us whether we would like to distribute or give publicity to the campaign waged by this organization against the unconstitutional work of CSIS!

I agreed and a letter was written to us, thanking us for taking part in this important work.

Then I telephoned the next day, asking them to send us a "good copy" of their leaflet on CSIS since their original copy came by fax, but the quality of print was poor for our NSC reproduction.

I received a letter from James Mitchel of C.L.A. dated November 7th, stating that they are glad of our help to promote this campaign. I asked for close to 700 copies of the leaflet which asked people to protest this undemocratic and underhanded work by CSIS and to help the Civil Liberties Association with finances. We received good copies the same day by Special Delivery.

We agreed to publish the full page leaflet in the November issue of NSC instead of an insert, since they did not have 700 on hand.

On November 10th, I received a call from James Mitchell, representing Civil Liberties Association (remember, this is only 1 day later since we agreed to give them publicity) who told me the following: "Please do not give us publicity in NSC since the campaign now is of no significance and we have other more important things to do!"

I asked him: "It looks as if someone has put pressure on you NOT to give this IMPORTANT ISSUE more publicity and to have our readers/members write letters of protest to the Canadian Government!"

No answer on the other end of the telephone!

CSIS - the Canadian Secret Intelligence Service - which is spying on anyone and everyone, including opposition parties in Parliament!

You will recall that CSIS was responsible for planting a named Bristow—"mole" who helped organize the Heritage Front, a pro-fascist organization that was allowed to exist, promoted and nurtured. This caused a scandal in the newspapers and it was raised in the House of Commons in Ottawa – but now, you can hardly see any news item pertaining to this scandalous situation perpetrated against the Canadian people!

All of a sudden, this is NOT AN IMPORTANT ISSUE for Canadians? Who is controlling the Canadian


Civil Liberties Association, whose roster includes well known persons as lawyers, writers, trade union leaders, civic leaders, members of parliament, etc., etc.?

TO OUR SOVIET READERS!

We have for the last 2 years published articles gathered mostly from anti-Yeltsin press that we receive from former USSR. We have also commented now and then on these stories, plus writing editorials and other articles about the worsening conditions and the complete disintegration of law and order, the Mafia impregnated privatized industries and government apparatus. Sometimes we do not know where the Mafia stops and government begins, or vice versa. In other words, we showed our readers in 24 countries of the world the desperate situation in which the people in the former USSR are finding themselves now.

Here, I would like to quote a CANADIAN source – "Maclean's Magazine" – whose Moscow correspondent, Malcolm Gray, writes regarding the situation. His article is entitled, "MOB RULE – Extortion has become a way of life in the new Russia".

We shall make no comment on this article ... it speaks for itself so well, that any decent person reading this article cannot but be amazed and perturbed that the Western Powers are supporting this situation in the former USSR, while trying to curb the same situation in their own countries!

THE LESSON IS VERY CLEAR!

In 1993, Sergei Skorochkin finally gave in to the mobsters who were demanding

a \$22,000 payment. The operator of several food outlets and a distillery in Zaraysk, 160 km southwest of Moscow, Skorochkin knew only too well that refusing to pay the protection money could cost him his life. Said Skorochkin: "Of course, I paid them off."

Skorochkin is not the only person reluctantly keeping bad company. Extortion has become a way of life in Moscow and other centres. And his problems did not end after he started paying off the thugs. Eventually tiring of the mobsters' constant demands, the 33-year old businessman told his story to the police - only to hear that there was not enough evidence to lay charges against the extortionists. Not long after, events took a violent turn. According to Skorochkin, seven armed men confronted him near his Zaraysk home on May 1. In the ensuing struggle, Skorochkin says, he seized a Kalishnikov rifle from one of the assailants. When another racketeer fired at him with a pistol, he shot back, killing the man. Now a member of the Russian legislature, Skorochkin insists that he acted in self-defence – and to date, police and his parliamentary colleagues have accepted his account of the confrontation. In the meantime, he stays close to home as he awaits the outcome of the police investigation. Said Skorochkin: "My friends are guarding me against gangsters."

Criminals, seemingly, are everywhere. They have even extended their power and influence from the back streets to government offices, using a combination of threats, violence and payoffs to officials. By some accounts, the ranks of the Russian Mafia now include some 200 highly disciplined crime syndicates and as many as 3,500 less formal groups. And not all of their victims live in Russia: highly paid Russian athletes who work

abroad, including several National Hockey League stars, have also been targeted for extortion. Bankrolled by the ill-gotten riches they have collected at home, Russian mobsters are peddling everything from narcotics to stolen components for nuclear weapons. Concluded a recent report by the Moscow-based Analytic Centre for Socio-economic Policy, a government-funded thinktank: "In Western Europe and the U.S.A., organized crime controls only purely criminal spheres such as prostitution, drugs and gambling. In Russia, organized crime controls everything."

The centre's director, Pyotor Filippov, sketches a bleak picture of Russian crime. He says that 80 percent of stores, restaurants and other companies in Russia's emerging private sector pay protection money to racketeers – in some cases, as much as 20 percent of their revenues. Filippov's anti-crime experts estimate



that the 150 most powerful gangs wield effective control over a combined 40,000 private and state-owned companies, including most of the country's 2,000 commercial banks. According to Western intelligence agencies, Russia's gangsters have also helped Colombian drug barons set up cocaine distribution networks linking South America and Eastern Europe. From the other direction, the gangs transport opium and heroin from Afghanistan and Central Asia to the West.

The number of reported murders across Russia jumped from 13,543 in 1989 to 29,213 last year pressure. The head of the Russian Ice Hockey Federation, Vladimir Petrov, acknowledged at the World Hockey Championships in Italy this month that extortion was a problem faced by many of his players. In March, Buffalo Sabres right-winger Alexander Mogilny complained to police that a fellow expatriate, Sergei Fomitchev, who had helped him defect five years earlier, had threatened to shoot or stab him if he did not hand over \$150,000 in protection money. Fomitchev, who insisted that he was only trying to borrow money from the hockey star, pleaded guilty in Buffalo last month to a reduced charge of menacing. He is due to be sentenced this week.

Unlike Mogilny, most NHL players from the former Soviet Republics refuse to talk openly about the problem, although many admit off the record that they have paid protection money to discourage attacks against their relatives back mome. For their part, officials of the NHL Players Association say that there is little they can do because, as they see it, there is no credible law emforcement in Russia. "There is no order over there right now," association boss Bob Goodenow told Maclean's last week. "And until

there is, there is no way that we can exert any influence to stop the thugs."

One target that offers night-marish possibilities for criminal power and profits is the former Soviet nuclear arsenal. In 1991, Greenpeace activist William Arkin – a homicide rate of 20 per 100,000 people, one of the world's highest (Canada's murder rate in 1992 was 2.7 per 100,000; New York City's was 27). Mob-linked contract killings have become especially popular – accounting for a reported 250 deaths last year, two-and-a-half times as many as in 1992.

Not surprisingly, opinion polls suggest that crime is second only to economic survival as the chief preoccupation of Russians. Under communism, muggings and other types of crime that afflict major Western cities were relatively rare in Moscow. Now, most of the city's nine million residents are worried about their personal safety, afraid that they will be injured or killed by street gangs or robbers. To some Russian biznesmenyi, in fact, using force is simply the most efficient way of solving a problem. Said

interior Minister Viktor Yerin: "Violence is increasingly becoming a method to exert pressure on administrative officials and a means to coerce or remove business rivals."

Adding to the public's frustration is a more traditional Russian problem: official corruption. These days, that can range anywhere from police shakedowns of motorists – typically, an officer might overlook a minor traffic violation in return for a \$3 bribe – to demands for huge bribes by highly placed government officials.

High-income Russian athletes are particularly vulnerable to mob demonstrated the arsenal's shocking vulnerability when he secretly negotiated with Soviet soldiers stationed near Berlin to buy a nuclear warhead for \$330,000. The plan failed - but only because Soviet authorities abruptly withdrew all of their nuclear weapons from Germany when an abortive coup erupted in Moscow in August of that year. In 1993, Western intelligence reports say, Russian security agents seized 60 kg of highly enriched uranium - enough




to build three weapons as powerful as the bomb that devastated Hiroshima – and later arrested several people on smuggling charges. Meanwhile, German police arrested several men from the former Soviet Republic of Kazakhstan who had smuggled nuclear fuel as well as beryllium and zirconium – two rare metals used to build nuclear weapons – from their homeland to the West.

In any event, criminal control of nuclear weapons would surprise few people in a country where the tight controls of a totalitarian system have withered away. In the city of Tver, 170 km northwest of Moscow, informants among the region's highway patrolmen often tip off local criminals whenever trucks loaded with valuable cargo pass through traffic checkpoints. Gangs also control the city's many sidewalk Before granting new kiosks. permits, licensing authorities routinely check to ensure that the applicant has been approved by one of the local godfathers.

FROM GLORY TO DESPAIR!

Take a good look at these two photographs and think of how the internal traitors that are ruling the former Soviet Union accomplished and devastated not only the economic and cultural life of Soviet people, but the once-great Soviet Army which was the guarantor of peace in the world!

These soldiers served their country well, but now they are cast aside. This burial service offers 'American hearses' and 'European embalming technique' for the wealthy ... P. Runina, whose uncle had just been buried, said: 'You don't think it can be made worse, but it is degrading to think that even in death we are treated without respect ...' ... Funeral Director Vladimir Smirnov acknowledged that a normal funeral service included putting a



rough wooden coffin into the ground, but that does not include covering it with dirt. 'That costs extra' ..."

OUR COMMENT: Capitalism breeds and develops barbarism. No such thing could be imagined even in the wildest dreams, under Socialism, except possibly during war.

WE COMMENT: Precisely, as Mr. Fedorov notes, capitalist efforts to transform Moscow into a dirty, crime ridden city of glitz such as are found everywhere in the U.S.A. and the capitalist world, have temporarily prevailed: They have also succeeded in corrupting hockeyists, Mr. Fetisov, Mr. Mogilny, Mr. Bure, et al., to the smell and taste of "filthy lucre" as was the case with the arch anti-Communist gangster, Al Capone. Welcome to your current company of capitalist bosses, "dear" degraded Soviet trained athletes, who "defected". Fetisov, Fedorov, and others were what in Canadian military terms would be "deserters". "Masha says she is thinking of killing herself (and) looking out at the smudged landscape of this once-pristine Arctic village, its sulphurous sky, run-down wooden huts ... and sickly cows in the nearby shed, you know it is more than a throw-away line. 'What's to live for here?', she demands ... 'if it weren't for my child, I would be ready to go'. The suicide rate in Russia's northern territories is probably the highest in the world ... last year in Kolvo, seven people died and only one was born, reducing the 160-year old village to 406 souls ...

"Kolva was once the place where wages tripled overnight, and a cozy retirement awaited workers. It is now Russia's biggest welfare case ... Only workers for foreign oil companies are paid with certainty. The others – fishermen, dairy farmers, reindeer herders – get welfare vouchers ... Although the Komi Republic, like most of the Siberian Arctic, is rich in oil ... (a picture cutline says: 'Polluted wasteland creeks, streams and rivers are contaminated by oil pipeline

leaks. The pollution has poisoned wild berries, the residents' main source of fruit.' – Editor)· "From the far east to the Western Arctic, 26 minority communities are battling for survival", writes Ward. "The Hatanzeski's (a family of the Komis, fairskinned and related to the Finnish people – editor) live on hand-outs from bleak state stores ... When the fish started floating belly up, we knew we were finished", said Vladimir.

WE COMMENT: Much has been made in the Western media of the "oil spills worse than the Exxon Valdez tanker spill", but above comes from oil pipelines spread throughout the Northern Siberian area. These were built by Soviet initiative and the oil wealth was then in the process of being used. During that period, nobody, not even the most virulent anti-Sovieteers among the Western media, have accused that system of "leaking oil pipelines that polluted the areas". Why now? We can only conclude that under the rapacious capitalist "rush to get the oil out" at bargain basement prices, lack of maintenance of the lines, and probable overloading of them has created this new crisis. So, what else is new under capitalist management? How many disasters, including the use of immensely dangerous oil tankers with single hulls (contrary to all safety requirements) have occurred. Headline: "YELTSIN TELLS HIS GENERALS - "SHAPE UP ARMY", and "YELTSIN DRESSES DOWN HIS MILITARY COMMANDERS"

"Speaking on Monday to top military commanders, President Yeltsin expressed unhappiness with their work, urged greater military readiness, and said he expected new frictions with the U.S.A. under a Congress controlled by the Republican Party ... 'We can expect a certain toughening of the U.S. stand on foreign policy and military issues', he said. His Government should seek closer ties with the Republicans, 'to balance our relations' but he concentrated on military matters at a delicate time for the armed forces which have been shaken by scandals and persistent allegations of corruption ... The job of Defence Minister Grachev is thought to be on the line ... Yeltsin hinted that more personnel changes were to come (and) said that commanders were not taking full responsibility for their soldiers' combat readiness; reform of central command was going too slowly; units were undermanned; resources and weapons were being wasted and officers were not fulfilling their obligations. The Russian Government complained officially on Saturday (Nov. 12th) that '... the United States appears increasingly persistent in pushing through unilateral decisions not within the framework of agreed collective action" ... Mr. Yeltsin's address was the only part of the conference, scheduled to last two days, that was open to the press", the story concludes.

WE COMMENT: What happened in the "conference" outside of the reported Yeltsin sneech, is open to question and speculation. We would guess that while there is some growing tensions with the U.S., we suspect Yeltsin was much more concerned with his domestic situation than with the international scene and allegations of tension with the U.S. are simply windowdressing. In the previous edition of NSC, we reported on actions being taken by the President as early as two months ago, to prepare for a "winter of unrest" by surrounding the seat of Government in Moscow with more than 50,000 specialized troops, in addition to those already present and on the alert. These were reported as preparations to put down what Prime Minister Trudeau of Canada in 1970 falsely dubbed, "apprehended insurrection" in Quebec. However, it might be remembered that Trudeau never shot up the Parliament Buildings in Ottawa, as Yeltsin did in Moscow just a year ago. Stay tuned, there is more to come, we believe, and particularly since it has been reported to NSC that something like 750,000 marchers turned out in Moscow to celebrate the 77th Anniversary of their working class - Leninist Revolution. 

ABOUT WHAT WAS KUCHMA SILENT?

Working class of Ukraine celebrated the 50th Anniversary of its liberation from fascist hordes. The full liberation of all Ukrainian territories took place on October 8, 1944. Fifty years have passed and in spite of the massive propaganda by "national-Democrats", this anniversary took place. Of course, the "three-zub" banderites tried everything possible to disrupt this mass anniversary celebration and hide it under a solemn ceremony,

But let us look not only at the things Kuchma said, but at the events and things that he kept quiet about. In order to present this thought, I will do it in a manner of a dialogue, based on the facts of his speech.

KUCHMA: "More than 3 years, the struggle took place for the liberation of the Ukraine. Ukraine became a war camp. Front and rear

came together."

• Why only "3 years", it was more than 4! Did not the Stalingrad struggle, Kursk Bulge, liberation of the Baltics, the storming of the Reichstag in Berlin - was that not a fight for Ukraine? Was not the bloody battles on the hills of the Volga and on the steps the Reichstag littered by bodies of SOVIET soldiers - was that not a fight for the Soviet Union which included the Ukraine? It seems that the president looks at the overall struggle and victory as only the liberation of Ukraine? Is this just an oversight or is it done for political reason?

KUCHMA: "Time and history produces its own results. Soviet Union is gone, but in its place, we have sovereign states."

• Is this good or is it bad? Why does the president step away from the political analysis and meaning of this great victory? On the destruction of USSR, Hitler pinned his hopes also! After that, Dulles had the same plan. What were the reason for the demise temporarily of the Soviet Union and that includes Ukraine also. The forces that President Kuchma represents are obviously not interested in bringing these reasons to the fore, or if they are, they want to bury them so deep that no one will unearth them.

Everyone knows, including our enemies, that the Soviet Union was transformed after the Great Patriotic War into a mighty state that the world reckoned with.

Ukraine, under the Socialism, had reached world heights in production for the needs of her population. At the end of 1980's, the needs of the population was ensured to the tune of \$230-\$240 per month per each person – which reached the high standards of the leading countries of Europe. Where is all this today, Mr. Kuchma?

Where are the gains of the present policies? Of course, you did not touch on these matters, did you, Pan Kuchma. It is self evident that the interests that Kuchma represents do not want these facts aired!

KUCHMA: "It is a shame that at this time, we cannot give the necessities of life to those that fought for our freedom."

• To admit your errors is good. But where is the road ahead? Where did all of our riches go to? Why is it that the robbery of the people grows as mushrooms after rain, while the rich grow richer and the poor grow poorer – yes, the new Ukrainian bourgeoisie. Kuchma did not speak about this at all.

KUCHMA: "Without the liberation of Ukraine in 1944, without Victory in 1945, there would not have been the rebirth of Ukraine."

• Of what country and government are we talking about? Are we talking about the Socialist Soviet Ukraine? Or are we talking about the present "sovereign" robbed, poor Ukraine? If we are talking about the present day Ukraine, then the Day of Victory has nothing to do with it. This was accomplished by the renegadebourgeois of the upper echelons of traitors who were masquerading themselves as members of the CPSU. These are the renegades of the type of Krawchuk and company who have brought my country to a brink of catastrophe.

KUCHMA: "No matter how we look at and feel about the Central Planning economy of the former Soviet Union, it showed its successes during the war years."

 Why only during the times of war? Did not this central planning system rebuild the ruined economy and built up the mighty USSR equal to the leading industrial countries of the world? Did any other country in the world know such tremendous growth in industry and economy as was had the USSR? What proposals has Pan Kuchma for the present ills? The answer is simple – he defends the interests of private enterprise and the system of capitalism. Then why this demagogic lies about the interests of the working class? How was it possible that inside 3-4 years, Ukraine became one of the poorest countries, maybe compared to the Third World backward economies now.

KUCHMA: "Germany had established more than 230 'factories of death', concentration camps where millions died."

• Why is it that Pan Kuchma did not mention the Ukrainian bourgeoisie nationalists who also took part in burning and murdering Soviet people?

For example, a member of the Ukrainian Republican Party, Shkuriatiuk at the session of Rovno City Council, was welcomed by applause when he said; "I am proud of the fact that out of 1,500 policegendarmes in Kiev Babij Yar, we had 1,200 Ukrainian nationalists from OUN and only 300 Germans!" All the 250 villages and towns that Pan Kuchma talked about cannot be put only on the German shoulders. They had tremendous help from the banderites' bands. But the President kept quiet on this score. He does not look at the facts that in the city of Rovno, one of the streets there is named Stepan Bandera! Why did not Kuchma speak of this? Besides all this, these bands did not stop their attacks against their own people after the war ceased. "We are driven to our nationalist road by our nationalism above all" is proclaimed by one nationalist newspaper, 'Unconquered Nation'. "Our word is followed by gun shots. The last word will be said by our Mausers". In the "Nationalist Hymn", there are

words that are published which state: "For our country, for honour and glory, we are going to liquidate bloody Moscow and Warsaw". Can anyone, including Pan Kuchma, keep quiet about this?

In Rovno, where the nationalists took over the local government, they dismantled a monument to Nikolai Kuznetsov, the legendary Secret Service man, known worldwide as a hero behind enemy lines, who was murdered in cold blood by the Banderites. When the Ministry in Kiev protested this act of vandalism, the local government shrugged it off! You can see there is no Soviet of Ministers or a central body to which anyone listens to. How does Pan Kuchma look upon this? Does he not see what is happening? You cannot but see the political reasons for his being mum, as an accommodation with the banderites and all sorts of



HUMAN RIGHTS IN RUSSIA NOW!

In a very detailed analyses of this important question, we present a condensed version of this article which shows readers the terrible impact on the future of former Soviet society by the present course of the "new capitalist class" under leadership of Yeltsin and company.

The publication of the "Rights of Man" for the Russian Federation, published by "Russian Newspaper", August 25, 1994, unfortunately did not engender the deserved attention of the other newspapers or from the general public. Even though the article stated, "that in our country there are extremely serious economic problems, dangerous curtailment of the rights of people in political and social spheres", hardly any detailed accounts in the mass media and the lack of factual information.

The authors of this Commission reported that in 1993, there were over 600,000 refugees from other parts of former USSR into Russia, even though all of us know that this figure is way too low, given for political reasons, not to agitate the people. There are millions of "legal" and "illegal" immigrants flooding Russia due to persecution and untenable situation in former Soviet Republics. These unfortunate millions have absolutely no rights, no agency to help them relocate or to smooth the terrible plight. According to international law adopted by all countries in 1991, Russians have absolutely no guarantee or even a chance of their legal rights to be guaranteed now.

This Commission reported that there were over 876,000 persons in jail as of January 1, 1994, which is 0.6% of the total population. This

figure, it is predicted, will grow substantially as the situation deteriorates.

In the Armed Services of Russia, there were over 32,000 persons jailed when they demanded and sought legal rights as they were under the Soviet Union. In 1993, over 2,572 soldiers died in jail, protesting their human rights (of those, 462 committed suicide).

Workers' rights are under tremendous attacks by privatized foreign and local firms, industries, with hardly any trade unions to fight for the rights of workers. There were over 100,000 workers jailed when they demanded their rights, their social guarantees. These are only reported cases ... what about those unreported or buried from the media!

Most of the jailed workers are those that demanded that they get paid for work done, instead of waiting sometimes 3-5 months to get paid.

Things are so bad, that at the beginning of 1994, there was owing workers for back pay over 800 billions rubles, but according to some trade unions that are organizing, the sum is more than 3.8 trillion of rubles!

During 1993, there were reported over 1,113 strikes, conflicts,

lock-outs in industry. The State calls these strikes – demands "against the law" so that more than 95.1% of these strikes were considered by the Yeltsin's government as "unlawful"!

The most terrible conditions prevail in the privatized sectors of industry, which employ 14 million workers out of a work force of 70 million.

There are terrible accidents, since there is no safety guarantee in these privatized foreign owned industries. According to the admitted figures of Ministry of Labour itself (and these figures are played down) everyday there are over 1,600 serious accidents, over 27 workers get killed each day while 55 workers become invalids for life. During 1993, there were over 400,000 workers maimed forever, while over 8,000 were killed outright!

This is due to the disintegration and ineffectiveness of the once powerful trade union movement. In 1994, only 835,000 workers of the millions received some sort of social help. According to the August-September figures of this year, there were over 9 million workers unemployed ... but the more correct figure is close to 15,000,000 workers!

It is hard to understand that these authors of the Commission would overlook this cardinal fact that over 60,000,000 workers in Russia are receiving less than the required minimum wage according even to the law that is supposed to be in force today!

Below is information which will show graphically how things stand:

Workers living 1991 1992 1993 1994 under minimum 17 42 54 59 wage (in millions)

Workers living in 1991 1992 1993 1994 absolute poverty 1.4 7 4 5 (in millions)

Instead of this Commission demanding from the Government steps to rectify this deplorable, savage conditions under which the workers live now in Russia, it only slaps the government on the wrist!

What are some of the losses of rights of the population, that this Commission was forced to admit?

* Workers are held, beaten up, arrested, including Peoples Deputies who sometimes come to the defense of the workers. More than 100,000 documented cases are before the courts, which might, or in most cases, will not act.

Even if these arrested had the opportunity or the money to get a lawyer for their defence, in most cases, the lawyers or defenders are barred from visiting the arrested worker.

Workers all report the fascist-like beatings by the personal goons of Yeltsin, the OMON police-militia from districts 18, 48, 77, 100 and 119 in Moscow. These arrested workers are beaten up while being arrested, while interrogated, kicked, fists in the faces, boots to the stomach, small of the back, pistol whipped and threatened to be shot. All these methods are against the Convention which was signed by all countries, including Russia.

Even journalists cannot escape the beatings – 65 in total in Moscow, while 6 journalists were killed by OMON during the White House tragedy in Moscow, last October.

Under direct orders of Minister of Information (V.F. Shumejko) 13 newspapers were closed, even "Pravda" at that time, even though "Pravda" now is not what "Pravda" was during the USSR times.

The Commission report, even though it was watered down, somehow did not get any attention from the Ministry of Justice or the Courts.

The Supreme Court or the Moscow court did not bother to take any steps to look into these human rights violations or even to take an overview of the terrible conditions which are becoming the norm.

It is this "we shall not mix into the affairs" by the Supreme Court or the Ministry of Justice that led to the massacre that happened in October of 1993.

It is interesting to point out that the authors of this Commission saw fit to concentrate only on 1993, taking the decision to "overlook" the anti-constitutional seizure of power by Yeltsin and the unconstitutional banning of the CPSU and seizing all the assets.

Even giving the information that this Commission gave, it is beneficial that least this information was made available to the press, although it is unfortunate that these facts were not published extensively by the anti-Yeltsin press.

Nevertheless, on December 10, 1993, these facts were made available to the General Secretary of the United Nations Organization.

As a result of this, in February of 1994, the UN elected a top representative of the UN to look into these charges and this terrible situation that has befallen the Soviet people. The representative is Khosse-Aila-Lasso.

No matter how these former Republics tried to manouver, experiment and make deals, NONE of them were capable to satisfy the needs of their people themselves ... as a sovereign, gigantic country, capable to exist by themselves. There is absolutely no perspective that these former Republics will be able to resolve this problem!

SECOND: In the aftermath of the break-up of the Soviet Union, the geopolitical vacuum was created and we see it being filled by others. Other foreign countries have stepped in with great speed in order to fill this vacuum.

Turkey is promoting a very forceful campaign in the Caucases and Central Asia. President S. Demirel of Turkey openly

proclaimed: "Turkey is establishing around its perimeter a circle stretching through the Balkans, Black Sea, Caucauses and Near East". If we are to look closely at this "peaceful circle", we see similarity with the 300-year old Ottoman Empire. Everything becomes very clear as to the intentions of Turkey and the internal traitors.

Germany already today is very active, after the "reunification of GDR with West Germany", Germany has pretensions to Soviet Kaliningrad Territory, Baltic Republics and Ukraine.

There are forces inside our country that are doing everything possible so that the unity will not be achieved. There are forces beyond our borders, who in league


with these internal forces, are hell-bent not to allow this unity to take place.

- They are eliminating and putting away the celebrations of the Day of Victory from the minds of the new generation of children, do not permit the population to march with Red Flags and slogans on the streets of Kiev;
- They decorate all of the city with yellow-blue colours with slogans reeking of nationalism-chauvinism. They describe the Great Patriotic War as Red brownshirts while the Day of Victory they paint with the colours of Banderites yellow and blue.
- Special issues of envelopes, cards are debasing the Day of Liberation;
- They belittle and distort the role of the Communists in the Great Patriotic War;
- They are rehabilitating veterans of nationalist-fascist OUN-UPA

(the insurgents who were part of Hitler's Army – Editors);

- With all the mass media in their hands, they besmirch the history of the Soviet people who showed their heroism, and show hate towards Russian people;
- Even patriotic war time songs are not to be heard on the radio or TV.

There is a planned barrage to demoralize Soviet people!

Dollars now dictate how we must live, what our children must study in schools, how to celebrate holidays. The whole rational has been turned upside down: instead of love – sex; instead of patriotism – treachery to the Motherland; instead of libraries – casinos; instead of goodness and human feelings – don't give a damn.

HERE ARE THE RESULTS:

After 50 years of the liberation of Ukraine, we receive a "present" from today's democrats" of: two pieces of butter, kilogram of barley, kilogram of sugar and two kilograms of flour ...

Where did this "gift" for a month come from? ... from the pockets of the people, from these veterans who fought and gave their lives for the liberation! The prices have risen astronomically! It is hard to believe by foreigners that this is the condition at the present time.

Time will pass – our grand-children and great grand children will be talking and learning about your heroism, our dear Veterans. They will also read and remember, how, after 50 years, you again rose up to defend the gains that were made 50 years ago, when you liberated our Soviet Union and Europe. These veterans will long be remembered, such as General Varennikov, our own Kiev General Poluden, and many many others. Glory to you forever!

November 7th, we communists of Kiev will march shoulder-to-

shoulder with the people during the planned demonstrations to celebrate the 77th Anniversary of the Great October Revolution. We will present to the people that everything that we have today - chaos, disintegration of all aspects of life - this is a counterrevolution against everything that was achieved since the Great October Revolution in 1917. How much had been achieved by our country, USSR, during this short span, and this during the extremely hard and terrible conditions in this unequal struggle with the West! And during the last 4 years, the potential of the people was not used for betterment, but for the liquidation of the gains that people enjoyed.

Another Socialist revolution is forthcoming, even if President Kuchma himself will be against!

The final influence on the upcoming revolution will be the role of communist-Bolsheviks. IN COMMEMORATION OF SOVIET MARTYRS

"October 4, 1994, exactly one year after tanks opened fire and killed over 2,000 people who were defending the Russian Parliament Building – a decision was made to institute a 'Medal of Honour and Heroism' on behalf of the previous Supreme Soviet. The ceremony dedicated to this Special Awards was held at the house of Culture 'Red October'. These Medals of 'Defender of Soviets' was given out to the living and to those who died.

Sazhi Umalatova, Chairman of the Congress of National Deputies of USSR and deputy chairman of the movement "UNION" Ivan A. Shashvishashvili presented these medals.



The medals were given out to the first 100 who showed courage during those terrible days of bloodshed and who risked and gave their lives to defend the Constitution.

Among those receiving the medals were:

- Officers of a Rocket Brigade of Moscow District, who came to help the embattled deputies and patriots of the Supreme Soviet on October 3, 1993;
- Victor Morozov, defender of Supreme Soviet who was shot 5 times;
- Igor Ostapenko, Senior Lieutenant of the Navy (he was killed) headed a company of sailors who rushed from their barracks to help the defenders, were encircled by gun carriers. These sailors fought their last battle ... they were all liquidated;
- Colonel Leonid A. Kluchnikov, head of his army division, together with his son during the night of

October 4th, were taken prisoners by OMON goons and executed;

- Colonel Vladimir Yermakov,
 Commander of the Second Battalion,
 during the defense, was killed
 outright by tank fire;
- Nurse Ludmila Yermakova, wife of Colonel Yermakov, while she was attending to the wounded, was told that her husband was killed, nevertheless, she kept on treating the wounded and the dying;
- Natasha Petuchova, Secret Service Officer, on October 3rd near Ostantkino Tower, she was seriously wounded. Only a German correspondent Rory Pek saved her and tens of others, but Rory Pek himself was killed by a Yeltsin sniper. The faith of the others that were saved by Rory Pek, and as they were being driven to a hospital, OMON encircled them and all of them were murdered in the holding cells of OMON in the 3rd Division of the militia;
- Colonel Markov, Commander of a brigade, one of the commanders defending the House of Soviets;
- Senior Lieutenant Igor Brumel, showed his courage while on duty in Moldavia, Predneister Republic, an Engineer, headed one of the companies inside the House of Soviets, killed on duty;
- Correspondent of newspaper "For USSR" Grigory Rudenko, the only representative of the Kiev Organizational Bureau of Revolutionary Communist Youth of Ukraine.

During the closing ceremony of this presentation, Sashi Umalatova said that the continuation of the awards will be held on the day of Great October Revolution, November 7th.

After the official presentation, a concert took place by artists-defenders of the House of Soviets. The defender of the Supreme Soviet,

Peoples Artist of Ukraine Natalie Ovdienko told the audience: 'I was, I am and I will always be a Soviet citizen! I serve Soviet culture! I serve only the Soviet Union!'"

HOW DID IT HAPPEN?

Our friend, subscriber and correspondent, author, leading fighter for socialism, Ernie Trory has sent us the first copy of his 84-page book, which we are extremely glad to review. Not only are we reviewing the book (which is a must-reading for everyone who believes in Socialism) but we are going to stock the book in quantity and ask our readers/members to order this very valuable informative book from our office.

Our Northstar Compass has since its inception tried to portray events in the former Soviet Union as they really are, utilizing the informational materials that we receive from there, which are leading the struggle against the restoration of capitalism and the fulfilling by Yeltsin the plans of transnational corporations – his masters!

This "How Did It Happen" book, is very easily read and understood. Trory outlines the root causes of the debacle that transpired in former USSR, analyzing from a Marxist point of view all the currents, outward and hidden which went towards this disintegration.

Trory explains the warning by Stalin as to what can transpire if teachings of Marx-Lenin are not heeded; an excellent explanation of the Law of Value; the Inevitability of Imperialist Wars; touches on the political economy in a very forthright manner, besides explaining the hard to understand theory of Dialectics.
